**LEADING OFF:** Today the Angels play the 'rubber match' at **Oakland** and the third game (1-1) of a six-game Bay Area road trip to **Oakland** (April 28-30; 1-1) and **San Francisco** (May 1-3)...Halos are in a stretch of 25 consecutive days in **California** (April 20-May 14)...LAA went 4-3 on the seven-game home stand vs. **Oakland** (2-2) and **Texas** (2-1)...Following this trip, Angels will host a nine-game home stand vs. **Seattle** (May 4-6), **Houston** (May 7-10) and **Colorado** (May 12-13).

<u>ALL BAY</u>: Mike Trout's 10 career home runs in Oakland are most by any visiting player (since his 2011 debut)... Trout has nine home runs and 18 RBI his last 17 games at O.Co Coliseum (STATS)...Erick Aybar is batting .338 (79/234) in his career at O.Co Coliseum – T4th best all-time (min .120 PA).

<u>PUJOLS PULLED:</u> Albert Pujols was lifted from the game last night after a base hit in the 6th inning (left hamstring tightness)...Day to day (not in lineup).

<u>ONE HIT WONDER</u>: Last Thursday's 2-0 shutout win over **Oakland** marked just the third time in club history the Angels won with one hit (**Chavez** started).

MIRROR IMAGES: Since 2002, the Angels and A's have faced off 255 times with Angels holding the slight advantage (128-127)...In the same span, the Angels (6 times) or Athletics (5 times) have won 11 of the 13 A.L. West crowns (STATS LLC).

<u>HOT KOLE:</u> Kole Calhoun has tallied 18 hits in his last 48 at-bats (.375) including a double, triple, three home runs and nine RBI...Angels are 32-5 in the last 37 games when Calhoun scores a run (STATS LLC).

<u>OFFENSE SLOWED:</u> Angels have been limited to three runs or fewer in seven of last 11 games and in 12 of 21 overall tilts...2015 team OPS of .641 ranks 24<sup>th</sup> in MLB (12<sup>th</sup> in A.L.)...Halos ranked fourth in A.L. with a .728 team OPS in 2014 and led all of baseball with 773 runs scored last season.

<u>PUJOLS' PURSUIT</u>: Albert Pujols' 523 career HRs have placed him in sole possession of 18th all-time passing **Ted**<u>Williams</u>, <u>Willie McCovey</u> & Frank Thomas (521)...17<sup>th</sup> on the all-time list is Jimmie Foxx (534 HRs)...Pujols is also 23<sup>rd</sup> all-time with 564 doubles...Ivan Rodriguez (572) sits in 22<sup>nd</sup> place on doubles list...According to STATSPASS, Pujols passed Goose Goslin (1,609 RBI) April 13<sup>th</sup> for the 32<sup>nd</sup> all-time...Chipper Jones is 31<sup>st</sup> on with 1,623 RBI is (Pujols at 1,612).

<u>GAME OF CRON</u>: On Sunday, **C.J. Cron's** four hits set a single-game career-high...He has recorded nine hits in his last 18 at-bats and has three doubles his last seven games.

ABOUT FACE: Thru 21 games in 2014, David Freese tallied 13 hits, one double, one home run and six RBI...Thru 21 games in 2015, owns 17 hits, four doubles, four home runs and a team-leading 15 RBI.

THE MANAGER: Mike Scioscia is the longest tenured skipper in the Majors (16<sup>th</sup> season) and the only active manager to collect over 1,000 victories with a single club (one of four all-time to win at least 1,300 games with original club as manager)...His current .547 (1,341-1110) winning percentage and 1,341 wins are both tops in franchise history...He is one of 15 former catchers currently managing in the Majors.

@ OAKLAND: 2015 series is knotted 3-3...Angels have won 10 of last 14 overall matchups...Halos claimed 2014 series 10-9 (3-6 on road, 7-3 at home)...Halos have won nine of last 12 games vs. A's at Angel Stadium...Since 2008, LAA leads series 71-68...Since 2002, the Angels and A's are nearly deadlocked over 255 games (LAA leads 128-127).

ON DECK: @ SF: Angels have won last four games at AT&T Park (first meeting here since 2009; LAA sweep)... Halos have won six of last seven games vs. Giants (last met in 2012 with Angels taking two of three at home)... The Rally Monkey debuted in a comeback win vs. SF on June 6, 2000... LAA is 11-14 all-time vs. SF (6-8 on road).

BACK TO INTERLEAGUE: The Halos play a weekend set at San Francisco for their initial Interleague matchup of 2015...Club went 12-8 during IL in 2014, seventh winning mark vs. N.L. in last eight seasons.

THIS N' THAT: Johnny Giavotella is batting .341 (19/60) over his last 14 games...He has six RBI over his last seven contests...Angels have held opponents to three runs or fewer in 10 games thus far (10-0 in such games to lead MLB)...Trout ranks tied for first in A.L. with 18 runs (has led A.L. in runs each of last three seasons)...Trout's go-ahead HR in 7th inning Sunday marked eighth time in his career to hit a game-tying or go-ahead home run in seventh inning or later career (twice this season)...Since 2011, Huston Street has converted 134 of his 144 save chances for 93%, tops in MLB in span (8 for 8 in 2015)...Trout's 29.7 WAR (per Baseball-Reference) is sixth-highest total ever for any player through his age-23 season.

# THIS DATE IN ANGELS HISTORY

#### April 30

(2008) A day after Joe Saunders moves to 5-0, Ervin Santana becomes the third pitcher in club history to go 5-0 in April...The duo becomes just the second tandem in MLB history to boast two players with 5-0 records in April (also 1998 Texas Rangers with Aaron Sele and Rick Helling); (1966) Angels collect 11 hits and 24 total bases in the eighth inning at Boston en route to a 16-9 victory...In the inning, Rick Reichardt hits two home runs, the only Angel ever to post two HRs in one inning; (2002) Angels scored 21 runs on 22 hits defeating the Indians 21-2 at Jacobs Field...21 runs marked the second most in club history (26).

### TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER - RHP GARRETT RICHARDS 1-1. 3.75 ERA

Owns a 15-8 career record against A.L. West opponents

- Making third start of the season and second at home...Missed Angels first 11 games of the season on the disabled list recovering from left patellar tendon injury suffered last August.
- LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win in last start Friday vs. Texas after tossing seven innings and allowing two earned runs on three hits with three walks and five strikeouts...Marked first win since August 15, 2014 at Texas...Became fourth pitcher in Angels history to win five consecutive starts against the Rangers.
- HE'S BACK: Made season debut on April 19 at Houston in first big league game since August 20, 2014 at Boston.
- <u>VS. OAKLAND</u>: In 11 career games (seven starts) against the A's, is 1-3 with a 5.62 ERA (41.2 IP 26 ER)...In three starts last season against Oakland, went 1-1 with a 6.75 ERA (14.2 IP 11 ER)...Earned the win in last start against Oakland on June 9, 2014 (7 IP, 1 ER, 4 H, 0 BB, 4 SO), which snapped an Angels eight game losing streak in games Richards had appeared in vs. Oakland...As a starter, is 1-3 with a 6.32 ERA (37 IP - 26 ER) in his seven starts against the Athletics.
- AT O.CO COLISEUM: In six games (four starts) at the Coliseum, is 0-2 with a 5.95 ERA (19.2 IP 13 ER)...Last start in Oakland was shortest of career, allowing five earned runs on five hits across 0.2 innings on May 30, 2014...Allowed seven earned runs in 5.2 innings in first start at the Coliseum on April 30, 2013...In other two starts in Oakland (7/27/13 & 9/17/13), allowed one run across 12 innings pitched.
- SALT LAKE REHAB: Made one rehab appearance with Triple-A Salt Lake on Tuesday, April 14 at Fresno...Charged with the loss after allowing five earned runs on seven hits across five innings pitched with four walks and five strikeouts.
- 2014 REGULAR SEASON: Went 13-4 with a 2.61 ERA (168.2 IP 49 ER) and 164 strikeouts across 26 starts, setting career bests in nearly every major pitching category...Had 2014 season cut short on August 20 at Fenway Park after tearing his left patellar tendon while covering first base.
- Was one of five players selected to ballot for "Final Vote" for All-Star Game (won by Chicago White Sox LHP Chris Sale).
- During 14 game stretch from June 4 August 15, went 9-2 with a 1.79 ERA (100.1 IP 20 ER) and 100 strikeouts.
- 2014 LEAGUE LEADER RANKINGS: At time of injury, ranked second in the A.L. with a .201 batting average against (124for-617), third in road ERA (2.11), tied for third in winning percentage (.765), tied for fourth in wins (13), tied for fifth in starts (26), seventh in strikeouts (164), tied for seventh in night game ERA (2.75), eighth in ERA (2.61), eighth in innings pitched (168.2) and 10th in strikeouts per nine innings (8.8)...Allowed just 0.267 home runs per nine innings (168.2 IP - 5 HR), which led Majors at time of injury.
