#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The **Oakland Athletics** have lost a season-high six in a row...are batting just .221 (49-for-221) with 17 runs scored and 13 walks during the losing streak... have lost more than five straight games for just the second time in the last four years (previous: 9, May 22-June 1, 2012)...are 10 games under .500 for the first time since finishing the 2011 season 14 under (74-88)...are 0-1 on this six-game homestand against Boston (0-1) and Chicago-AL (three games).
- The A's have committed at least one error in each of their last nine games, including a season-high four on Saturday...have 13 errors during that stretch and 34 overall...the errors have led to 20 unearned runs.
- Scott Kazmir is 1-0 with a 0.90 ERA (2 er in 20.0 ip) in three starts at home this season.
- Edward Mujica made his Athletics debut in the top of the eighth inning...was acquired from the Red Sox on Saturday.
- Billy Butler (3-for-5, r, 2b, rbi) recorded his second three-hit game and 10th multiple hit contest of the year...has a .323 (64-for-198) career average against Boston.
- Ike Davis left the game in the fourth inning with a strained left quad.
- Brett Lawrie (2-for-5) snapped an 0-for-11 streak with his second-inning single...recorded his eighth multiple hit game of the season.
- Josh Reddick (2-for-4, r, 2 bb) snapped an 0-for-10 streak with his first-inning single.
- Eric Sogard (2-for-5) is 9-for-25 (.360) over his last seven games...recorded his seventh multiple hit game of the season.
- Stephen Vogt (1-for-4, 2b, 2 rbi) is batting .313 (10-for-32) with four home runs and 12 RBI in 10 games in May.

#### **BOSTON NOTES**

- The Boston Red Sox have won two in a row...are 3-7 in their last 10 games...are 2-2 on this 10-game road trip to Toronto (1-2), Oakland (1-0) and Seattle (four games).
- Rick Porcello's 14-inning scoreless streak was snapped by Billy Butler's RBI single in the third inning...the streak dated back to the third inning of his April 29 start against Toronto.
- Mookle Betts (2-for-5, 2 rbi, bb) extended his career-best hitting streak to nine games with his fifth-inning RBI single...is 12 for 35 (.343) with four doubles, a triple, three homers and six RBI during the streak.
- David Ortiz (2-for-5, 2b, rbi) has reached base in each of his last 12 games...is batting .318 (14-for-44) with a .373 OBP during that stretch...recorded his second three-hit game and eighth multiple hit contest of the season.
- Dustin Pedroia (1-for-4, r, rbi, 2 bb) has now reached base in each of his last 16 games...has recorded at least one hit in 13 of his last 14 contests...is batting .300 (27-for-90) over his last 24 games.
- Blake Swihart (2-for-5, 2 r, 2b) recorded his first career multiple hit game.
