Career Highlights

- ♦ Switch-hitting catcher entering 1st season with the Red Sox... Was acquired from the Nationals on 3/30/15 in exchange for cash considerations.
- In his 4th season in big league spring training camp (also 2012-15 with WSH).
- ♦ Switch-hitter has played 34 big league games, all with the Nationals over the last 3 seasons (2012-14)... Has thrown out 6 of 15 (40%) potential base stealers in the major leagues... WSH went 16-10 (.615) in his 26 ML starts.
- **Lesson** Has caught 48% (187 of 389) of attempted base stealers between the major and minor leagues over the last 5 seasons.
- Over his 8 minor league seasons, he has thrown out 45% (245 of 543) of attempted base stealers.
- ♣Named by *Baseball America* as the best defensive catcher in the Nationals' farm system following the 2008, 2009, 2011, and 2012 seasons.
- ♦ Signed with the Nationals on 1/17/07 after participating in a private workout in his native Venezuela in front of General Manager Mike Rizzo.

2014: Appeared in an ML career-high 20 games over 4 stints with the Nationals, making 17 starts... Spent most of the season with Triple-A Syracuse.

- ♣Threw out 5 of 8 potential base stealers with Washington and also caught 12 of 21 would-be base stealers (57%) with Syracuse.
- ♦ Was set to begin the season with Double-A Harrisburg, but was summoned to WSH on 4/2 after Wilson Ramos injured his left hand on Opening Day.
- ♣Hit .182 (8-for-44), 2B, HR, 3 RBI, 5 BB, and 5 R in 13 games before being optioned to Triple-A Syracuse on 5/16.
- ♣Hit his 1st ML home run on 4/14 at MIA, a 2-run shot off RHP Kevin Slowey.
- ♣Had a 2nd stint with WSH from 6/11-25...Returned again from 8/5-7 to replace Ramos (paternity leave).
- Hit .229 with 9 2B, 5 HR, 25 RBI, 23 BB, and 26 R in 51 games for Syracuse.
- Returned to the Nationals when rosters expanded on 9/1.
- 📤 Played in 46 games for Aguilas del Zulia of the Venezuelan Winter League, hitting .211, 8 2B, 3B, 2 HR, 14 RBI.

2013: Spent first full season at Double-A with WSH's Harrisburg affiliate...Was a September call-up to the Nationals.

- Hit .177 (55-for-310) in 95 games for Harrisburg but posted 47 walks compared to 57 strikeouts.
- Walked once every 7.7 PA with the Senators.
- ♦ Was batting .221 before a 4-for-79 slide over the last 25 games of the season…15 of his 16 extra-base hits came before the All-Star break.
- ♦ Including a 3-game rehab stint with Single-A Auburn, threw out 27 of 70 (39%) would-be base stealers
- Appeared in 2 September contests for Washington, going 0-for-1.
- 📤 Following the season, played for Zulia in the Venezuelan Winter League, batting .353 (42-for-119) in 38 games.

2012: Saw first Triple-A and major league experience in 6th pro season.

- ♦ Made MLB debut on 5/14 vs. SD, but suffered a high right ankle sprain in a 4th-inning home plate collision with Chase Headley.
- Lendured 6-week stint on the DL, but in 1st game upon return, notched 1st big league hit, a 7th-inning single off eventual Cy Young Award winner R.A. Dickey on 7/19 vs. NYM.
- On 7/27 at MIL, gunned down Jonathan Lucroy to register the 1st caught stealing of his ML career.
- Washington went 7-2 in his 9 starts.
- Combined to hit .322 (65-for-202) with 19 2B, 3 HR, and 26 RBI in 64 minor league games between Short-A Auburn (rehab), Double-A Harrisburg, and Triple-A Syracuse.
- Played 32 games for Zulia in the Venezuelan Winter League.

♣Following the season, was named by Baseball America as the best defensive catcher in the Nationals' farm system for the 4th time.

2011: Spent entire season with High-A Potomac and set a career-high with 28 extra-base hits, including a career-best 21 doubles and 6 homers.

- ♣Also registered career-highs in RBI (43) and games (109)...Hit a then-career-best .251 (93-for-370).
- ♣Threw out 53% (60 of 113) of attempted base stealers, the best mark in the Carolina League...Also topped the CL with 104 appearances at catcher.
- ♣Had 6 homers after totaling 4 roundtrippers over his first 4 pro campaigns (2007-10).
- Despite receiving 31 more PA than the season prior, struck out 10 fewer times.
- Went 4-for-14 (.286) in 5 playoff games for the P-Nats.
- Named a Carolina League Post-Season All-Star.
- Played for Zulia in the Venezuelan Winter League, appearing in 14 games (11 at C).
- ♣After the season, tabbed the best defensive catcher in WSH's farm system and the best defensive catcher in the Carolina League by *Baseball America*.

2010: Returned to Single-A Hagerstown and named to the mid-season South Atlantic League All-Star team.

- Tallied a career-best 50 walks in 98 games en route to .345 OBP.
- Topped the SAL in caught stealing percentage (51%, 61 of 119).
- Hit .321 (25-for-78) with a .415 OBP against left-handed pitchers.
- Made Venezuelan Winter League debut, playing 2 games for Zulia.

2009: Played for both Single-A Hagerstown and Short-A Vermont.

- Began the year with 23 games for the Suns before the start of the New York-Penn League season.
- Combined to bat .238 (58-for-244) with 13 doubles and the first 2 home runs of his professional career.
- Threw out 43 of 106 (41%) attempted base stealers over the 2 stops.
- Connected for 1st pro home run, a 7th-inning solo shot, on 8/23 at Tri-City.
- Following the season, cited as the best defensive catcher in the Nats chain by Baseball America.

2008: Returned for a 2nd season with the Rookie-level Gulf Coast League.

- ♣Hit .189 (14-for-74) but tallied 11 RBI in 26 games.
- Gunned down 37% of attempted base stealers (11 of 30).
- Went 2-for-6 with a pair of doubles in the playoffs as the Nationals lost the GCL Championship series.

2007: Made pro debut with the Rookie-level Gulf Coast League Nationals.

- Drew 17 walks in 31 games.
- ♣Made pro debut on 6/19 vs. the GCL Dodgers...Walked twice and scored 2 runs.
