OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** snapped a season-high six-game losing streak...are 1-1 on this six-game homestand against Boston (1-1) and Chicago-AL (three games).
- The A's hit a season-high three home runs for the fifth time this season (last: May 10 at Seattle)...have committed at least one error in each of their last ten games, including a season-high four on Saturday...have 14 errors during that stretch and 35 overall.
- Drew Pomeranz pitched more than six innings for the seventh time in 47 career starts and second time this season....is 2-0 with a 2.37 ERA (5 er in 19.0 ip) in three starts at home.
- Coco Crisp (0-for-4, bb) is now 0 for his last 38 which is the longest hitless streak of his career...is tied for the second longest hitless streak in Oakland Athletics history.
- Josh Reddick (4-for-5, 2r, 3rbi) is batting .368 (32-for-87) with all six of his home runs and 24 of his 25 RBI against right-handed pitching.
- Marcus Semien (3-for-5, 2r, 1rbi) is batting .353 (29-for-82) with ten multiple hit games over his last 20 games after hitting .236 over his first 15 contests.
- Eric Sogard (2-for-4, 2b, 3rbi) drove in a season-high three runs after driving in four all season...is 11-for-30 (.367) over his last eight games...recorded his eighth multiple hit game of the season.
- Stephen Vogt (1-for-3, 2r, 2 rbi, so) is batting .314 (11-for-35) with five home runs and 14 RBI in 11 games in May.

BOSTON NOTES

- The **Boston Red Sox** have lost eight of their last 11 and have been outscored 55-29 over that stretch...are 2-3 on this 10-game road trip to Toronto (1-2), Oakland (1-1) and Seattle (four games).
- Justin Masterson allowed two home runs tonight after allowing just two home runs over his first six starts and 33.0 ip...is 0-6 with a 7.26 ERA (32 er 39.2 ip) in seven starts and eight career games in Oakland.
- Mookie Betts (0-for-4) snapped a career-best nine-game hitting streak...is .305 (18-for-59) in his last 14 games.
- Mike Napoli (1 for 3, 1rbi) drove in a run in the seventh inning.
- David Ortiz (0-for-4, 3 so) snapped a streak of reaching base safely in each of his last 12 games...is batting .286 (14-for-49) over his last 13 games.
- Dustin Pedroia (2-for-3, r) has now reached base in each of his last 17 games...has recorded at least one hit in 14 of his last 15 contests...is batting .317 (20-for-63) over that stretch.
