OAKLAND NOTES

• The Oakland Athletics have lost seven of their last eight games... are 1-2 on this six-game homestand against Boston (1-2) and Chicago-AL (three games).

 The A's went 0-for-14 with runners in scoring position, which is tied for the third most hitless at bats in Oakland history since 1974 when the stat was first recorded (last: Aug. 8, 2010 against Texas)...the Oakland record is 0-for-16 (Sept. 15, 2006 against the White Sox)...have comitted an error in each of the last 11 games.

- Sonny Gray lost a start for the first time this season...snapped five-game winning streak (including final start of 2014)... has allowed one earned run or fewer in six of his first eight starts.
- Billy Butler (1 for 4) made his 34th start of the season at designated hitter, which matches Alberto Callaspo's team-leading total from last year... is batting .165 (13-for-79) over his last 19 games after hitting .377 over his first 16 contests.
- Coco Crisp (1 for 3) snapped an 0-for-39 hitless streak with a single in the bottom of the fifth inning...the 0-for-39 streak is the second longest in Oakland history.
- Josh Phegley (1 for 2, 2b) snapped an 0-for-7 streak with his 10th career double in the third inning (last: Sept. 28, 2014).
- Josh Reddick (0 for 4) had his nine-game home hitting streak snapped, which is tied for the longest season-opening streak in Oakland history (four times, previous: Jason Giambi in 1998).
- Marcus Semien (1 for 3, 3b, bb) is batting .353 (30-for-85) with 10 multiple hit games over his last 21 games after hitting .236 over his first 15 contests...hit his fourth career triple in the bottom of the third inning, and it is his second consecutive game with a triple...has made five errors in his last five games.
- Eric Sogard (0 for 4) is 11-for-34 (.324) over his last nine games.

BOSTON NOTES

- The Boston Red Sox have won three of their last four games... are 3-3 on this 10-game road trip to Toronto (1-2), Oakland (2-1) and Seattle (four games).
- Wade Miley made his seventh start of the season and his fifth on the road...earned his second win of the season...has a 2.68 era (88 r in 294.2 ip) in 40 away games since the start of 2013.
- Mookie Betts (0 for 4) is .286 (18 for 63) in his last 15 games.
- Jackie Bradley Jr. (0 for 4) is 0 for his last 26...snapped a four-game hitting streak against Oakland.
- Brock Holt (0 for 4) is 0 for his last 14.
- Sandy Leon (0 for 2) made his first appearance in a game against Oakland.
- Daniel Nava (2 for 3, rbi) snapped an 0-for-20 hitless streak with a single in the top of the second inning.
- David Ortiz (0 for 4) is batting .264 (14-for-53) over his last 14 games...is batting .327 (36 for 110) with 12 doubles and seven home runs in his last 29 games against Oakland (since Sept. 12, 2010).
- Dustin Pedroia (2 for 4) is on a seven-game hitting streak...has reached base in each of his last 18 games...is batting .328 (22-for-67) over that stretch...has recorded at least one hit in 15 of his last 16 contests.
- Hanley Ramirez (2 for 4, r) is batting .303 (20 for 66) with six home runs on the road.
