OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** have lost eight of their last nine games and are a season-high 11 games under .500...is the first time being more than 10 games under .500 since finishing the 2011 season 14 games under (74-88)...are 1-3 on this six-game homestand against Boston (1-2) and Chicago-AL (0-1).
- The A's have comitted an error in each of the last 12 games...faced a left-handed starter for the second consecutive game...are 1-7 in games started by a lefty...snapped an 0-for-21 hitless streak with runners in scoring position after an RBI triple from Reddick in the fourth inning.
- Jesse Hahn is 0-2 with a 6.23 ERA (15 er in 21.2 ip) in four starts since missing his turn in the rotation on April 23.
- Billy Butler (2 for 5, rbi) is batting .179 (15-for-84) over his last 20 games after hitting .377 over his first 16 contests.
- Brett Lawrie (1 for 4, r, bb) is 5-for-27 (.185) over his last seven games.
- Josh Phegley (1 for 4, hr, rbi, r, bb) has made eight of his 11 starts against a left-handed starting pitcher...is 7-for-21 (.333) against lefties.
- Josh Reddick (2 for 4, 3b, 2b, 3 rbi, r, bb) is batting .475 (19-for-40) at home...is 8-for-17 (.471) on this six-game homestand after going 2-for-23 over his previous six contests...hit his second triple of the season in the fourth inning (last: April 26, 2015 against Houston).
- Marcus Semien (1 for 5) is batting .344 (31-for-90) with 10 mulitple hit games over his last 22 games after hitting .236 over his first 15 contests.
- Eric Sogard (3 for 3, rbi, r, bb) is 14-for-37 (.378) over his last nine games...made his fifth start of the season against a left-handed pitcher...is 3-for-19 (.158) against lefties.

Josh Phegley (1)

- The Chicago White Sox have won seven of their last 10 games...won their third straight road game for the first time since July 24-26, 2014...are 3-1 on this six-game road trip to Milwuakee (2-1) and Oakland (1-0)...will return to Chicago to begin a seven-game homestand against Cleveland (four games) and Minnesota (three games).
- The White Sox are 2-7 in their last nine games against Oakland at O.co Coliseum.
- Carlos Rodon made his second career start on Friday, his first against Oakland...is 1-0 with a 6.30 ERA (7 er in 10.0 ip) in those starts.
- Zach Duke earned his first save of the season (last: July 24, 2011 against Colorado).
- Jose Abreu (1 for 3, 2 r, 2 hbp) is on a 10-game hitting streak...is batting .333 (13-for-39) over that span.
- Melky Cabrera (1 for 4, rbi, r, bb) is batting .138 (4-for-29) over his last seven games.
- Adam Eaton (2 for 5, 2b, 2 r) has hit safely in his last four games...is batting .444 (8-for-18) over that span.
- Adam LaRoche (1 for 3, 2b, 3 rbi, r, bb) has hit safely in five straight games and has reached base safely in 12 straight games...is batting .333 (11-for-33) with 12 walks over his last 12 games.
- Alexi Rameriez (1 for 4) is on a nine-game hitting streak...is batting .343 (12-for-35) over that span.
