OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** have lost nine of their last ten games and are a season-high 12 games under .500...are 5-13 at home which matches the 1994 A's for worst record after 18 home games in Oakland history...are 1-4 on this six-game homestand against Boston (1-2) and Chicago-AL (0-2).
- The A's have comitted an error in each of the last 13 games which is the lognest streak since a 13-game streak from April 7-21, 1983...faced a left-handed starter for the third consecutive game.
- · Jesse Chavez is now 0-1 with a 4.15 ERA (6 er in 13.0 ip) and .313 (15-for-48) opponents average in four games, two starts, at home.
- Billy Butler (2 for 4, bb, r, 2 rbi) recorded his 12th multiple hit game of the season...is batting .193 (17-for-88) over his last 21 games after hitting .377 over his first 16 contests...has 19 home runs and 94 RBI in 136 career games against Chicago which are his most against any team.
- Brett Lawrie (1 for 3, 2b, bb) is batting .321 (18-for-56) in May after hitting .229 in April...however, has no home runs and three RBI in May after hitting two home runs and driving in 11 runs in April.
- Marcus Semien (2 for 4, r, so) is batting .351 (33-for-94) with 11 mulitple hit games over his last 23 games after hitting .236 over his first 15 contests.

CHICAGO NOTES

- The Chicago White Sox have won a season-high four straight games and eight of their last 11 games...won four consecutive road games for the first time since August 12-28, 2013...are 4-1 on this six-game road trip to Milwuakee (2-1) and Oakland (2-0)...will return to Chicago to begin a seven-game homestand against Cleveland (four games) and Minnesota (three games).
- John Danks is 7-3 with 2.40 ERA (22 er in 82.2 ip) in 13 career starts against the A's.
- Jose Abreu (2 for 4, 2b, rbi, so) exteded his hitting streak to 11 games...is batting .349 (15-for-43) over that span.
- Melky Cabrera (3 for 5, 2 r, rbi) recorded his ninth multiple hit game and third game with three hits or more this season...is batting .206 (7-for-34) over his last eight games.
- Avisail Garcia (3 for 3, 2b, 2 rbi, bb) has hit safely in 18 of his last 20 games and is batting .366 (30-for-82) over his last 20 games.
- Alexi Rameriez (1 for 4) is on a ten-game hitting streak...is batting .333 (13-for-39) over that span.
