OAKLAND NOTES

The Oakland Athletics have lost two straight games after a season-best three-game winning streak...are 6-16 at home this season, the worst record after 22 home games in Oakland history...are 8-18 in May, which is the most A's losses in any month since May 2009 when they went 11-18...are 1-2 on this seven-game homestand against Detroit (1-2) and New York (four games).

• The A's have lost two of three games against Detroit and have not won a series since taking two of three at Texas May 1-3...are 2-15 in one-run games.

• The A's starting pitchers have gone five consecutive games without an earned run for the first time since at least 1914.

• Scott Kazmir left the game after three innings pitched with left shoulder tightness.

- Sean Doolittle made his first appearance of the season since being reinstated from the 15-day disabled list yesterday...
- Brett Lawrie (0-for-4, 2 k) is batting .300 (27-for-90) in May after hitting .229 in April.
- Josh Reddick (0-for-2, 2 bb) is batting .400 (22-for-55) at home...was walked twice for the fourth time this season (last: 5/11 vs Boston).
- Stephen Vogt (2-for-4, r, 3b) has hit safely in each of his last nine regular season games against Detroit...is 14-for-33 (.424) over that span...has made 34 of his 37 starts in games in which the opponent starts a right-handed pitcher...hit his second triple of the season (last: April 12 vs Seattle).
- Ben Zobrist (1-for-4) is 3-for-7 (.429) since he was reinstated from the 15-day disabled list on Monday.

- The Detroit Tigers have won their last two games to snap a three-game losing streak...are 2-1 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (2-1) and Los Angeles-AL (four games).
- Alex Wilson made the first start of his career against the Athletics...did not allow a hit in three scoreless innings.
- Al Alburquerque has not allowed a run in his last 11 outings (12 ip).
- Kyle Ryan made his first appearance of the season after being recalled from Triple A Toledo prior to today's game.
- Miguel Cabrera (0-for-4, bb, 3 k) snapped a 13 game hitting streak...is batting .470 (20-for-54) in his last 14 games.
- Yoenis Cespedes (2-for-3, 3 rbi, r, hr, bb, k) has mulitple hits in six of his last 13 games...is batting .362 (17-for-47) over that span.
- Anthony Gose (1-for-3, bb, k) extended his hitting streak to seven games with a single in ninth inning... is batting .444 (12-for-27) over that span.
- Ian Kinsler (1-for-5, r, 2b, 2 k) snapped an 0-for-22 streak with a double in the top of the fifth inning.
- Dixon Machado (1-for-3, bb, k) recorded his first major league hit with a single in the top of the sixth inning.
- J.D. Martinez (0-for-4, k) is 0 for his last 11.
