THIS DATE IN TIGERS HISTORY

1939 - For the first time in his career, Charlie Gehringer hits for the cycle in a 12-5 win vs. the St. Louis Browns. Gehringer does it in order - single, double, triple, home run.

2004 - Carlos Peña goes 6-for-6 with two home runs, five RBI and four runs in a 17-7 victory over Kansas City.

RECENT RESULTS: The Tigers snapped a three-game losing streak with a 1-0 win on Tuesday night at O.co Coliseum. Four Tigers pitchers combined on the seven-hit shutout. David Price started for Detroit and worked 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing five hits with one walk and three strikeouts. Joakim Soria picked up his 14th save of the season with 1.1 shutout innings. Anthony Gose and Andrew Romine each had a pair of hits in the win with Gose scoring the only run of the game. Rajai Davis had the only RBI of the contest with a sacrifice fly in the first inning. The Tigers and Athletics play the rubber game of their three-game series this afternoon. Following today's game, the Tigers remain on the road for a four-game set vs. the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim.

SIMON PLACED ON BEREAVEMENT LIST, RYAN RECALLED: Following last night's game, the Tigers announced that they have placed righthanded pitcher Alfredo Simon on the bereavement list. The Tigers also announced that they have recalled the contract of lefthanded pitcher Kyle Ryan from Triple A Toledo. In nine starts with the Mud Hens, Ryan posted an 0-5 record with a 4.67 ERA (54.0IP/28ER). The starter for today's game will remain TBA.

FIRST ALL-STAR BALLOT UPDATE: The first balloting update for the 86th All-Star Game, to be played on Tuesday, July 14th at Great American Ball Park in Cincinnati, was announced yesterday afternoon. Miguel Cabrera, who is a nine-time All-Star and is looking to start the All-Star Game for the third straight year, leads all American League first basemen with 1,347,351 votes. Jose Iglesias, who is looking to make his first career All-Star appearance, ranks second among AL shortstops with 826,382 votes. Tigers are also among the leaders at second base (Ian Kinsler, third place) designated hitter (Victor Martinez, fifth place) and outfield (Yoenis Cespedes, fifth place; J.D. Martinez, 14th place).

ONE RUN IS ENOUGH: The Tigers picked up their second 1-0 win of the season in last night's game at Oakland. The victory marked the first time in franchise history the Tigers have defeated the Athletics 1-0 in Oakland. The last team to defeat the Athletics 1-0 in Oakland was Kansas City on August 1, 2014.

CABRERA EXTENDS HITTING STREAK TO 13 GAMES: Miguel Cabrera stretched his hitting streak to 13 games as he went 1x4 in last night's game. Over his 13-game streak, Cabrera is hitting .400 (20x50) with 10 runs scored, three doubles, one triple, five home runs and 11 RBI. Cabrera's hitting streak is the longest by a Tigers player this season and is the second-longest active hitting streak in the American League.

DAVIS, CABRERA ON TARGET VS. KAZMIR: Rajai Davis and Miguel Cabrera have each had success against this afternoon's starter for Oakland, Scott Kazmir. Davis is batting .476 (10x21) with three doubles, one triple, one home run and six RBI vs. Kazmir, while Cabrera is hitting .308 (8x26) with two doubles, one triple, two home runs and six RBI. Among active players with at least 20 at bats against Kazmir, Davis' .476 batting average ranks fourth.

ON THE ROAD: The Tigers are 1-1 on their current seven-game road trip. The Tigers are 13-8 on the road this season and have won six of their last 10 games away from Comerica Park. Detroit's .619 road winning percentage ranks third in the American League, while their 13 road wins ranks tied for third.

REPLAY RUNDOWN: The Tigers have been involved in 20 instant replay challenges so far this season. Detroit has challenged eight plays with four calls being overturned and four plays standing as called. Opponents have made 11 challenges with six plays standing as called and five calls being overturned. There has been one crew chief initiated review with that play being overturned.

NOTES ON THE SKIPPER: Brad Ausmus is in his second season at the helm for the Tigers after being named the 37th manager in Tigers history on November 3, 2013. -Led the Tigers to a 90-72 record and a postseason berth in his first year as manager, joining Hughie Jennings (1907), Mickey Cochrane (1934) and Jim Leyland (2006) in accomplishing the feat.

-Became the 14th manager in Tigers history to have also played at the major league level for Detroit, joining Alan Trammell, Dick Tracewski, Billy Martin, Bob Swift, Billy Hitchcock, Fred Hutchinson, Mickey Cochrane, Del Baker, Bucky Harris, George Moriarty, Ty Cobb, Hughie Jennings and Bobby Lowe.

-Managed Team Israel in the 2013 World Baseball Classic. -Spent 18 seasons as a catcher at the major league level with the Padres (1993-96), Tigers (1996, 1999-2000), Astros (1997-98, 2001-07) and Dodgers (2009-10) ... made eight postseason appearances as a player, including two trips to the National League Championship Series and one to the World Series.

-Ranks second all-time among catchers with 12,839 putouts, while he is ninth with 1,766 games started and 15,082.2 innings played.

RONDON INJURY REHAB: Righthanded pitcher Bruce Rondon made an injury rehab appearance with Triple A Toledo last night, throwing a scoreless inning of relief with one hit allowed. In three injury rehab appearances with the Mud Hens, Rondon has a 1-0 record with a 3.38 ERA (2.2IP/1ER), three hits allowed and one strikeout. Rondon has been sidelined since April 1 with bicipital tendinitis.

BERNARD, THOMPSON EARN MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLY HONORS: Wynton Bernard, an outfielder for Double A Erie, and Jeff Thompson, a righthanded pitcher for Single A West Michigan, each earned weekly honors from their respective leagues. Bernard was named the Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting .462 (12x26) with seven runs scored, five doubles, one home run and five RBI in six games. Thompson was selected as the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week after compiling a 2-0 record with a 0.00 ERA (11.2IP/0ER), six hits allowed, four walks and 14 strikeouts in two starts on the week.
