OAKLAND NOTES

The Oakland Athletics have won back-to-back games at home for the first time this year...have won five of the last seven games after losing 14 of the previous 16 contests...have won 16 of their last 21 games against the Yankees...are 3-2 on this seven-game homestand against Detroit (1-2) and New York (2-0).

- The A's starting pitchers are 4-1 with a 1.00 ERA (5 er in 44.2 ip) over the last seven games.
- Sonny Gray is 3-2 with a 1.67 ERA (7 er in 37.2 ip) in six starts in May after going 3-0 with a 1.98 ERA in five starts in April.
- Billy Burns (2-for-5, r, 2b, 2k) Had his tenth multiple hit game of the season, the most among American League rookies.
- Billy Butler (1-for-3, r, 2b, rbi, bb) snapped an 0-for-10 streak with a RBI double in the third inning...is batting .206 (27-for-131) with one home run and 13 RBI over his last 32 games.
- Brett Lawrie (1-for-4, r, hr, 2 rbi, 2 k) homered in consecutive games for the first time since June 5-6, 2014...is batting .296 (29-for-98) with two home runs and nine RBI in May after hitting .229 with two home runs and 11 RBI in April.
- Josh Phegley (3-for-4) recorded hist first three-hit game for the first time since Sep. 14, 2013... is 9-for-24 (.375) with three walks over his last seven games after going 3-for-23 (.130) over his previous eight contests.
- Stephen Vogt (2-for-3, 2b, 2 rbi, bb) is now 10-for-24 (.417) over his last seven games...has six home runs and 20 RBI in May, both of which are his most ever in a month.

- The New York Yankees are 4-12 in their last 16 games and 1-9 in their last ten games on the road...are 1-11 in their last 12 games at the O.co Coliseum...are
 0-2 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (0-2) and Seattle (three games).
- Chris Capuano has tossed fewer than six innings in each of his three starts...has recorded the loss in three consecutive starts for the first time since July 26-August 6, 2012.
- Carlos Beltran (1-for-4) has hit safely in 16 of the past 17 games...is batting .299 (26-for-87) with eight runs, seven doubles, 3 home runs and 11 RBI in 22 games in May.
- Stephen Drew (0-for-4) is hitless in his last 19 at bats.
- Brian McCann (1-for-4, r, hr, rbi, k) is the first Yankee to homer in four straight games while playing catcher since Mike Stanley from July 20-25, 1993...is 9-for-23 (.391) with six runs, one double, four homers, 11 RBI and six walks over his last seven games...has at least one RBI in each of those contests.
