OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** had their season-high two-game home winning streak snapped...are 3-3 on this seven-game homestand against Detroit (1-2) and New York (2-1).
- The A's starting pitchers are 4-2 with a 1.42 ERA (8 er in 50.2 ip) over the last eight games...have committed at least one error in 22 of the last 27 games (31 errors total).
- Jesse Hahn is 1-2 with a 2.84 ERA (12 er in 38.0 ip) in six starts at home... is 1-4 with a 4.85 ERA (21 er in 39.0 ip) in seven starts at night.
- Billy Burns (2-for-5, r, k) extended his hitting streak to five games...is 8-for-21 (.381) over that span...had his third consecutive multiple-hit game, which was his 11th of the season.
- Billy Butler (1-for-3, rbi, k) is batting .209 (28-for-134) with one home run and 14 RBI over his last 33 games.
- Brett Lawrie (2-for-4, k) is batting .304 (31-for-102) with two home runs and nine RBI in May after hitting .229 with two home runs and 11 RBI in April.
- Josh Reddick (3-for-4, rbi) snapped an 0-for-11 hitless streak with a single in the bottom of the first inning...is batting .361 (25-for-65) at home this season... had his third three-hit game of the season (last: May 2 at Texas).
- Marcus Semien (2-for-5, r, rbi) is 7-for-37 (.189) over his last 10 games...had his 17th multiple hit game of the season.
- Stephen Vogt (1-for-4) is 11-for-28 (.393) over his last eight games...has reached base safely in all 24 of his home games and is batting .343 (24-for-70) in Oakland

NEW YORK NOTES

- The **New York Yankees** are 5-12 in their last 17 games and 2-8 in their last ten games on the road...are 2-11 in their last 13 games at the O.co Coliseum...are 1-2 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (1-2) and Seattle (three games).
- The Yankees have homered in six straight games...have 11 home runs over that span.
- Nathan Eovaldi is 0-1 with a 5.60 ERA (11 er in 17.2 ip) in three career starts against Oakland.
- Dellin Betances has not allowed a run in 24 games this season (27.1 ip).
- Carlos Beltran (2-for-4, hr, 3 rbi, r, k) has hit safely in 16 of the past 17 games...is batting .308 (28-for-91) with nine runs, seven doubles, four home runs and 14 RBI in 24 games in May.
- Ramon Flores (0-for-4) made his major league debut, a start in left field.
- Chase Headley (3-for-5, rbi, r) had his third three-hit game of the season.
- Brian McCann (1-for-3, rbi, r, bb) extended his hitting streak to eight games with an RBI single in the top of the first...is batting 10-for-26 (.385) with seven runs, one double, four homers and 12 RBI over that span...has eight consecutive games with an RBI, all as a catcher, the first time that has happened by a Yankee since Yogi Berra in 1956.
- Alex Rodriguez (1-for-4, 2 k) extended his hitting streak to nine games...is batting 13-for-32 (.406) over that span.
