OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** won a series for the first time since since taking two of three at Texas, May 1-3... have won four of their last five day games after losing 13 of the first 14...went 4-3 on this seven-game homestand against Detroit (1-2) and New York (3-1)...snapped a streak of five consecutive losing homestands dating back to last year, which matched the longest such streak in Oakland history (last four of 1978, first of 1979)...leave tomorrow for a six-game road trip to Detroit (three games) and Boston (three games).
- The A's starting pitchers are 5-2 with a 1.23 ERA (8 er in 58.2 ip) over the last nine games.
- Jesse Chavez tossed a career high tying eight innings (third time: last May 26 vs Detroit)...has not allowed an earned run over his last two starts...is 2-5 despite
 a 2.37 ERA (14 er in 53.0 ip) in his seven starting assignments.
- Billy Burns (3-for-4, 2 r) extended his hitting streak to six games...is 14-for-34 (.412) over his past eight games...had his fourth consecutive multiple-hit game, which was his 12th of the season.
- Max Muncy (2-for-3) recorded his third multiple-hit game of the season.
- Stephen Vogt (1-for-3, r, hr, 3 rbi) extended his hitting streak to seven games...is 10-for-25 (.400) over that span...has reached base safely in all 25 of his home games and is batting .342 (25-for-73) in Oakland.

NEW YORK NOTES

- The **New York Yankees** are 5-13 in their last 18 games and 2-9 in their last 11 games on the road...are 2-12 in their last 14 games at the O.co Coliseum...are 1-3 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (1-3) and Seattle (three games).
- Adam Warren tossed a career high tying seven innings (twice: last May 13 at Tampa Bay)...has pitched at least six innings in each of his last four starts after tossing fewer than six innings in each of his first nine starts this season...allowed a stolen base for the first time in his last 106.2 inning pitched (57 appearances) in the 6th inning.
- Ramon Flores (1-for-3) recorded his first major league hit with a single in the second inning.
- Alex Rodriguez (2-for-4, k) extended his hitting streak to a season-high 10 games...is batting 15-for-36 (.417) over that span.
