OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost four in a row after winning four straight...are now 9-7 over the last 16 games after going 2-14 over the previous 16 contests... have gone three consecutive games without an error for just the second time this season (previous: 4 games, April 13-17)...are 0-1 on this three-game homestand against the Texas Rangers.
- A's starting pitchers are 8-5 with a 1.93 ERA (22 er in 102.1 ip) over the last 16 games...have a 3.15 ERA (126 er in 359.2 ip) for the season.
- Sonny Gray has allowed two or fewer runs in 11 of his 13 starts this season...is 3-1 with a 1.33 ERA (4 er in 27.0 ip) and a .188 (18-for-96) opponents batting average over his last four starts...is 3-2 with a 1.62 ERA (8 er in 44.1 ip) and a .181 (28-for-155) opponents batting average in six starts at home...is 4-2 with a 1.67 ERA (10 er in 54.0 ip) in eight starts against American League West competition.
- Billy Burns (0-for-5) snapped his career-best 12-game hitting streak...was 18-for-52 (.346) during the streak, which matched both Oakland's season-high and the longest by a Major League rookie this year.
- Josh Reddick (1-for-3, 2b) has hit safely in each of his last seven games against the Rangers dating back to last year and is 14-for-27 (.519) with three home runs and 13 RBI over that stretch.
- Stephen Vogt's (1-for-3, rbi, bb) RBI single in the eighth inning was just his second hit in his last 23 at-bats (7 games).

TEXAS NOTES

- The **Texas Rangers** are 20-12 on the road this season...have won 10 of their last 12 road contests and 16 of their last 21...are 4-4 against the Athletics in 2015...are 3-1 on this seven-game road trip to Kansas City (2-1) and Oakland (1-0).
- Nick Martinez snapped his two-start losing streak...is 3-1 with a 1.79 ERA (8 er in 40.1 ip) in seven games (six starts) against the A's in his career...is 3-0 with a 1.52 ERA (4 er in 23.2 ip) in four career starts at the O.co Coliseum.
- Shin-Soo Choo (2-for-4, k) recorded his 14th multiple hit game of the season...is batting .295 (13-for-44) over his last 11 games.
- Delino DeShields (1-for-4, r, 3b, bb, 2 k) snapped an 0-for-12 streak with his third-inning triple...the streak began after a leadoff triple on Friday in Kansas City.
 Prince Fielder (1-for-4, rbi) has hit safely in his last seven games against the A's...is 12-for-26 with a home run, two doubles, five RBI, four walks and a hit-by-
- pitch during that stretch...is batting .377 (40-for-106) with 8 homers and 27 RBI over his last 26 games.
 Leonys Martin (2-for-4, k) recorded his 11th multiple hit game of the season...has multiple hits in five of his last nine contests...is 14-for-38 (.368) during that stretch.
- Mitch Moreland (1-for-4, r, hr, rbi, 2 k) hit his ninth home run at the O.co Coliseum since 2010, which is the second-most by any Athletics opponent (Mike Trout, 10)...now has 12 career homers against the A's, five more than his next-highest total against an opponent (Seattle, 7).
