#71 Sam Freeman #51 Wandy Rodriguez



CAREER: The DFW-area native was acquired in a trade with St. Louis at the end of spring training this year...the left-hander has seen action in each of the last three seasons with the Cardinals, setting career highs in most categories over 44 appearances in 2014...Freeman made a postseason roster in two of the last three seasons for the Cardinals (2012 Wild Card and 2014 ALDS)... has made 57 appearances with St. Louis the past two seasons, going 3-0 with a 2.50 ERA (14 ER/50.1 IP), the 8thlowest ERA in MLB in that span among left-handed relievers with at least 50.0 innings...has held right-handed batters to a .188 (29-154) average over the past three seasons (2012-2014), 5thlowest among all left-handed pitchers in majors (min. 100 batters faced)...born in Houston, Freeman graduated from Hebron High School in Carrollton, Texas, and still resides in Lewisville, a suburb of Dallas. He pitched at North Central Texas College in Gainesville and was selected by St. Louis in the 32nd round of the 2008 June draft out of the University of Kansas.

POSTSEASON: Was on Cardinals postseason rosters for 2012 N.L. Wild Card Game at Atlanta and 2014 NLDS vs. Los Angeles-NL...was replaced on club's NLCS roster last year by A.J. Pierzynski...lone postseason outing came in Game 1 of 2014 NLDS at LAD, walking both batters faced in relief of Adam Wainwright in Cards' eventual 10-9 win over Clayton Kershaw... in 2013, traveled with ML team during postseason run to World Series, but was not on any official playoff roster.

EXTRA EFFORT: Each of Freeman's 3 MLB wins have come for St. Louis in extra-inning games...wins came 8/13/13 vs. PIT (pitched 14th inning), 6/4/14 at KC (10th), and 9/18/14 vs. MIL (13th).

2014: Went 2-0 with a 2.61 ERA (11 ER/38.0 IP) over 44 relief outings with St. Louis, setting MLB career highs in most categories, including games, innings, strikeouts (35) and games finished (9)...his 2.61 ERA ranked 15th in MLB among pitchers with 40-or-more appearances...had 2 stints with Cardinals: 5/13-17 and 5/24-end of season...scoreless in 35 of 44 appearances...had career-high 11 holds, T4th on staff... allowed one of 8 inherited runners to score (12.5%)...still does not have a save opportunity in his ML career...first batters hit .243 (9-37) with 7 BB...his groundball percentage was 60.0%, 14th in N.L. among pitchers with 35.0+ IP...opponents slugged just .299, as he permitted only 5 extra-base hits all season... had a 1.31 ERA (3 ER/20.2 IP) in 25 appearances with Yadier Molina behind the plate...posted 3.0 scoreless innings in extra frames, with opponents going 0-for-8, as both of his wins came in extras (6/4 at KC, 9/18 vs. MIL)...held right-handed batters to a .195 (17-87) average with 2 extra base hits (both doubles), 11th-lowest average against among ML lefty relievers...had a career-high 8.0 inning scoreless streak over his first 8 games with St. Louis, 5/13-6/10...career-high 4 K's on 8/11 at MIA, tying career high with 2.0 IP...both HR allowed came 8/8 at BAL... appeared in 16 G for Memphis, allowing 4 of his 7 ER in one outing (4/9 at Omaha)...no ER over 8 G/9.2 IP between 4/24-5/21 w/ Memphis.

2013: Made 13 appearances over 2 stints with Cardinals: 8/8-15 and 8/29-end of season...scoreless in 11 of 13 outings...did not allow a run in first 7 G/7.2 IP for STL covering 8/8-9/4...first ML win on 8/13 vs. PIT, a 14-inning walk-off victory for Cards... faced 50 batters and did not allow a HR...spent bulk of season with Memphis, ranking among team leaders in games (49) and wins (T2nd, 7)...led staff with 10 holds...making 49 relief appearances...did not allow a run over 15 games and 25.0 innings from 5/28-7/9, opponents batting .157 (14-89) w/ 32 SO in that span...2012: Saw first ML action over 2 stints with St. Louis: 6/1-29, 9/1-end of season...recalled from Memphis by Cardinals on 6/1 and made ML debut that night at NYM (0.2 IP, 1 H, 1 R-ER, 2 BB, 1 SO) in 8-0 STL loss...appeared in 13 of team's 26 games during his June stint, going 0-1 with a 6.00 ERA (8 ER/12.0 IP)...during September stint, was 0-1, 4.50 (4 ER/8.0 IP) in 11 G...began year with Springfield (AA) before promotion to Memphis on 5/14...had 15 G with Springfield, going 1-3, 1.56...pitched for Surprise in the Arizona Fall League (7 G, 7.0 IP, 3 R-ER)...2011: Combined to go 2-2, 3.16 (24 ER/68.1 IP) in 59 games with Palm Beach (High-A) and Springfield, his first action since elbow surgery the previous year...his 59 appearances ranked 4th among minors lefty pitchers, T13th overall...his 3.16 ERA was 5th-lowest among minors pitchers with 59+ appearances...led Springfield with 25 games finished while going 3-for-3 in save opportunities...scoreless in 41 of 52 at Double-A, including 13 straight scoreless outings from 5/20-6/17 (14.1 IP)...2010: Invited to major league camp in spring as a non-roster invitee but missed the entire season after having left elbow ulnar collateral ligament reconstruction surgery on 3/10...2009: Went a combined 2-2, 2.41 (15 ER/56.0 IP) in 41 relief appearances with Palm Beach and Springfield...the 41 games ranked 4th among Cards minors lefties...selected to Florida State League All-Star Game, but was called up to Springfield on 6/12 and did not appear in that contest...at Palm Beach, lefties hit .147...sidelined 7/25-end of season with a left elbow sprain...2008: After signing, pitched for Johnson City in Appalachian League...made pro debut on 6/18 at Bristol (1.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R-ER, 1 BB, 3 SO)...had 2.50 ERA (5 ER/18.0 IP) last 14 G in Appy League before finishing reg. season with High-A debut on 8/28 vs. St. Lucie (2.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 4 SO)...also pitched twice for Palm Beach in FSL playoffs (2.1 IP, 2 SO).

PERSONAL/AMATEUR: Samuel Douglas Freeman...he and wife Jamie reside in Lewisville, Texas...Sam played baseball and football at Hebron HS in Carrollton...was a first team all-district selection as a senior...played college baseball at the University of Kansas after two years at North Central Texas College.

CAREER: The 36-year-old left-hander signed a minor league contract with the Rangers on April 6 after being released by the Braves at the end of spring training...is in his 17th professional season...prior to this season, had never pitched for an American League club...has won 10-or-more games 5 times in his career, including 4 straight from 2009-12, and has cleared 190.0 innings on 4 occasions...has pitched in the majors in each of the last 10 seasons, compiling a career record of 91-94 with a 4.06 ERA in 258 games/248 starts with Houston (2005-12) and Pittsburgh (2012-14)...spent the first 14 years of his career in the Astros organization before being traded to the Pirates on July 24, 2012, pitching for Pittsburgh and bench coach Jeff Banister until his release last June ... entering this year, ranked 9th all-time in Astros history (1962-2015) with 1093 strikeouts, most among left-handed pitchers, and 10th in club history in wins (80) and starts (218)...was named the Astros Pitcher of the Year in both 2009 and 2011 by the Houston Chapter of the Baseball Writers Association of America.

ALL SENIOR CIRCUIT: Prior to this season, Rodriguez opened his career with 248 starts for National League teams... the only other active pitchers to have made that many starts in the N.L. before starting for an A.L. club are Jason Marquis and Randy Wolf...Wolf (opened season in minors w/ TOR) made 366 starts in N.L. before 2 starts with Baltimore in 2012...Marquis made 267 starts in senior circuit before 7 starts with Minnesota in 2012.

POSTSEASON: His only career postseason action came in Astros' run to the 2005 World Series...went 0-1 with a 3.86 ERA (2 ER/4.2 IP) in 3 games that postseason, all in relief...took loss in World Series Game 1 at Chicago-AL, entering after Roger Clemens' exit after 2.0 innings.

AT THE PLATE: Has a career .133 (59-445) batting average with no home runs and 21 RBI as a hitter...has 53 career sac bunts, 10 walks, and 130 strikeouts...his 10 career extra-base hits have all been doubles, the last on 9/26/11 vs. STL...opened the 2012 season with an 0-for-39 span and has a .088 average (8-91) since the start of 2012.

2015: Rangers announced the signing of Rodriguez to a minor league contract prior to the club's season opener on 4/6 at OAK, assigning him to Round Rock (AAA)...he had signed a minor league deal with Atlanta on January 13, and was released on April 3 after Braves acquired Trevor Cahill from Diamondbacks... went 2-0 with a 3.13 (8 ER/23.0 IP) in 6 Grapefruit League games/starts for the Braves...this spring, held opponents to a ...250 average with 8 walks and 23 strikeouts.

2014: Went 0-2 with a 6.75 ERA (20 ER/26.2 IP) in 6 games/ starts for Pittsburgh last season...opened season as Pirates 3rd starter...went 0-2, 7.65 (17 ER/20.0 IP) in 4 games/starts for Bucs in April, then was on the DL 4/20-5/14 with right knee inflammation...after 2 starts with Altoona (AA) on rehab, was activated for start on 5/15 at MIL...allowed 8 R/3 ER over 2 starts and 6.2 IP after return from DL...last MLB appearance was 5/21/14 vs. BAL for the Pirates...has lost his last 4 decisions since last ML win on 5/26/13 at MIL while with Pirates...was designated for assignment by Pittsburgh on 5/22, released from roster on 5/30, and given unconditional release on 6/1.

WINTER BALL: After the 2014 season, made 5 total starts (regular season and playoffs) for the Aguilas in Dominican Winter League, posting no record with a 2.55 ERA (5 ER/17.2 IP) and 5 BB against 20 strikeouts.

2013: In his only full season with Pittsburgh, made just 12 starts due to persistent left forearm tightness...snapped stretch of making 20+ starts in 8 straight seasons from 2005-12... Pirates' no. 2 starter to begin the year, earned win in 1st outing 4/3 vs. CHC w/ 6.2 shutout innings...left start 4/8 at ARI with a left hamstring strain, missing next scheduled start on 4/14... returned on 4/9 vs. ATL and faced minimum in 7.0 shutout innings...made 6 starts in May: 4-2, 3.16 (13 ER/37.0 IP) with 5 BB and 28 SO...last win was 5/26 at MIL...left start 6/5 at ATL, final outing of the year, with tightness in left forearm... placed on DL on 6/11 (retro to 6/6)...had minors rehab outings in June and September (for Indianapolis during International League playoffs), and simulated games in August, but was shut down for season on 9/14 due to continuing pain and discomfort in the left forearm...pitched for eventual champion Dominican Republic club during the World Baseball Classic in March, a pair of starts against Puerto Rico on 3/10 in the pool play final in San Juan (ND, 3.1 IP, 1 R-ER) and 3/16 in second round final at Marlins Park (W, 6.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R)...2012: Combined to go 12-13 with a 3.76 ERA in 34 games/33 starts with Houston and Pittsburgh... tied career highs in starts and innings (205.2), 13th in N.L. in innings...made first and only career Opening Day start for Houston on 4/6 vs. COL, but came away with a no-decision (6.1 IP/3 R/0 ER)...with 4.0-inning start on 7/18 at SD, ended streak of 48 consecutive starts of 5.0-or-more innings...it was longest active streak in N.L. at the time and 3rd in MLB (behind Sabathia and Verlander)...lost his final 3 starts with Houston before being acquired by Pittsburgh on 7/24...Made debut with Pirates on 7/28 at HOU...lost career-high 6 straight decisions from 7/13-8/15...pitched 2.0 innings of relief in 19-inning game on 8/19 at STL and picked up his first win with Pirates; was his first relief appearance since 10/1/06...pitched 16.0 consecutive

scoreless innings between 8/29-9/10...was 5-1, 2.86 (50.1 IP/16 ER) in his last 9 games beg. 8/19...2011: Recorded double digit wins for the 4th time in his career...ranked 5th among all N.L. lefties with a 3.49 ERA...did not allow a run in 7 of his 30 starts...went 1-3 with a 5.40 ERA in his first 5 starts and 10-8 with a 3.13 ERA in his final 25 assignments...was on DL from 5/28-6/12 with a left elbow joint effusion...became Houston's all-time career leader in strikeouts by a left-handed pitcher on 8/2, surpassing Bob Knepper (946)...career-high 13 strikeouts on 8/29 vs. PIT...whiffed CIN's Joey Votto for his 1000th career strikeout on 9/21...2010: Posted double digit win total for the 3rd time in his career...beginning 6/25, went 8-2 with N.L.best 2.03 ERA (27 ER/119.2 IP)...had N.L.-best 1.34 ERA in August...had double-digit K's in 2 straight 9/11-17, first Astros pitcher to do that since Roger Clemens in Sept. 2004...on 9/17 vs. CIN, became first Astros pitcher to post 10+strikeouts and 6+ walks in the same game since Nolan Ryan on 5/22/87 vs.

RODRIGUEZ

STL...2009: Established career highs in wins (14), starts (33 tied in 2012), innings (205.2 - tied in 2012) and strikeouts (193) while posting a career-best 3.02 ERA...led all Astros pitchers in wins, ERA, strikeouts and innings pitched...went 9-3 with a 2.08 ERA (108.0 IP/25 ER) in 16 starts at home and 5-9 with a 4.05 ERA in 17 starts on the road...among N.L. lefties, ranked 2nd in wins, 3rd in ERA, T1st in strikeouts and 4th in innings...posted a 1.69 ERA (32.0 IP/6 ER) over his first 5 starts...surrendered a home run on 5/20 vs. MIL, his first since 8/10/08 at CIN, snapping his streak of 88.1 innings without allowing a home run; was the longest homerless streak by a Houston pitcher since Juan Agosto had a 91.2-inning homerless streak from 7/4/89-7/2/90...won a career-high 6 straight decisions from 6/21-8/9 (single-season high, was also matched in 2012-13)...was named the N.L. Pitcher of the Month for July after finishing the month with a 0.75 ERA...set a Houston club record with his 0.75 July ERA, besting Andy Pettitte's 0.90 ERA from July 2005... tossed a career-high 18.0 consecutive scoreless innings from 7/2-21...2008: On the 15-day DL on 4/20 with a strained left groin and missed 6 starts...made one rehab start with Corpus Christi (AA)...posted the 4th-lowest ERA (2.30) in June among N.L. starters...missed 2 starts in September due to a strained right oblique...2007: Posted the 5th-lowest home ERA (2.94) in the N.L...ranked 6th among N.L. left-handed pitchers in strikeouts...posted his 1st career shutout on 7/6 vs. NYM... averaged 7.78 strikeouts per 9, which ranked 4th among N.L. lefties...2006: Went 4-0 with a 2.53 ERA in 5 starts during the month of April, then had just 5 wins the rest of the way...tossed 7.0 shutout innings on 3 days of rest on 6/6 vs. CHC...gave up 5 runs in 2.2 IP during his 6 relief appearances...2005: Became the 7th rookie in Houston club history to win 10 games...ranked 2nd among N.L. rookies in wins (10), 3rd in starts (22) and 4th in innings (128.2) and strikeouts (80)...was recalled from Triple-A Round Rock on 5/23 and made ML debut that day in Chicago; singled off lefty Glendon Rusch for 1st hit in 2nd at bat...earned first big league win on 5/28 at MIL (6.0 IP/4 R)...made one start for Corpus Christi during the MLB All-Star break...2004: Spent entire season with Round Rock (AA) in the Express' final season as a Double-A club...was named the club's Pitcher of the Month in June after going 3-0 with a 2.86 ERA...was named the Texas League Pitcher of the Week for 8/9-15...tossed 8.0 shutout innings on 8/14 vs. El Paso...played for Aguilas in the Dominican Winter League, where the team claimed the league title...2003: Spent entire season with Single-A Salem...was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week for the week of 8/7-13 after tossing a one-hit shutout...2002: Spent entire season with Lexington and led club in wins and strikeouts...was named the Topps Player of the Month for June...2001: Ranked 2nd in the Appalachian League in ERA while pitching entire season with Martinsville...2000: Went 5-3 with a 2.45 ERA (147.0 IP/40 ER) in 26 combined games (23 starts) between the Dominican Summer League Astros and the Dominican Summer League Padres... **1999:** Began professional career with the Dominican Summer League Astros and split time between the bullpen and the starting rotation.
