OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** snapped a four-game losing streak...are now 10-7 over the last 17 games after going 2-14 over the previous 16 contests...are 1-1 on this three-game homestand against the Texas Rangers.
- A's starting pitchers are 8-5 with a 2.12 ERA (25 er in 106.0 ip) over the last 17 games...snapped a season-high three-game errorless streak, and have now
 made 58 errors this season...had the first walk-off win of the season.
- Jesse Hahn is 0-3 with a 4.83 ERA (17 er in 31.2 ip) in six starts against American League West competition...Hahn hit three batters, which ties an Oakland record for hit batters in a single game (ninth time, last: Barry Zito, April 15, 2005).
- Pat Venditte has not allowed a run in four appearances (5.2 ip).
- Billy Butler (1-for-4, rbi, 2 k) is batting .182 (6-for-33) in June after hitting .241 in May.
- Sam Fuld (1-for-4, 2 k) is 8-for-80 (.100) over his last 34 games.
- Brett Lawrie (0-for-4, rbi, 2 k) is batting .220 (22-for-100) at home compared to .322 on the road.
- Josh Reddick (2-for-5, rbi, r, k) has hit safely in each of his last eight games against the Rangers dating back to last year and is 16-for-32 (.500) with three home runs and 14 RBI over that stretch...had his fifth career game-ending RBI.
- Stephen Vogt (1-for-2, 2b, r, k, 2 bb) has reached base safely in all 27 of his home games...is 9-for-22 (.409) against Texas this season...is a .344 (22-for-64) career hitter against the Rangers.
- Ben Zobrist (1-for-4, rbi, k) had an rbi to give the A's the lead in the first inning...eight of his 15 RBI have put the A's ahead.

TEXAS NOTES

- The **Texas Rangers** are 20-13 on the road this season...have won 10 of their last 13 road contests and 16 of their last 22...are 4-5 against the Athletics in 2015...are 3-2 on this seven-game road trip to Kansas City (2-1) and Oakland (1-1).
- Yovani Gallardo is 0-3 with a 5.32 ERA (14 er in 23.2 ip) in four career starts against Oakland...is 2-0 with a 1.80 ERA (5 er in 25.0 ip) over his last four starts.
- Robinson Chirinos (0-for-3, bb, k, r) is 0 for his last 11.
- Shin-Soo Choo (1-for-4, r, hbp) is batting .292 (14-for-48) over his last 12 games.
- Prince Fielder (0-for-3, hbp, rbi, 2 k) snapped a seven-game hitting streak against the A's...is 12-for-29 (.414) with a home run, two doubles, six RBI and four walks in his last eight games against Oakland...is batting .367 (40-for-109) with 8 homers and 28 RBI over his last 27 games.
- Joey Gallo (2-for-4) extended his hitting streak to four games...had his second multiple-hit game of the season (last: 3 hits on June 2 vs. Chicago-AL)
- Leonys Martin (2-for-2, 2b, hbp, rbi, bb) recorded his 12th multiple hit game of the season...is 16-for-40 (.400) over his last 11 games.
- **Mitch Moreland** (2-for-5, 2 rbi, r, k) extended his hitting streak to six games...is batting .417 (10-for-24) over that stretch.
