OAKLAND NOTES

The Oakland Athletics set a new season-high in runs scored (previous: 14, April 10 vs. Seatte)...set a new season-high in hits (previous: 18, April 22 at Los Angeles-AL)...tied a season-high for runs in an inning (previous: May 1 at Texas)...have won four straight, which ties the team's season high (previous: May 31-June 4)...have won six of their last eight games...have out-scored the opposition 304-266 this season...improved to 3-0 in interleague play...are 1-0 on this five-game homestand against the San Diego Padres (1-0) and the Los Angeles Angels (three games).

• A's starting pitchers are 4-1 with a 1.46 ERA (8 er in 49.1 ip) over the last seven games...are 12-6 with a 1.97 ERA (34 er in 155.1 ip) over the last 24 games and have allowed one run or fewer 14 times over that stretch...have a 3.01 ERA (138 er in 412.2 ip) for the season.

- Jesse Chavez set a career-high with 11 strikeouts...is 1-2 with a 1.75 ERA (7 er in 36.0 ip) in six games at home...is 3-6 with a 2.75 ERA (22 er in 72.0 ip) in his 10 starting assignments.
- Billy Burns (3-for-4, 3 r, 2b) has hit safely in each of his last eight games (13-for-34, .382) and 20 of his last 21 (31-for-91, .340)...put together his fourth three-hit game and his 17th multiple hit contest of the year.
- Billy Butler (4-for-5, 2 r, hr, 3 rbi) recorded his first four-hit contest and his 15th multiple hit game of the season...now has two home runs and 20 RBI over his last 49 games after collecting three home runs and 12 RBI over his first 16 contests...is a .310 (117-for-378) career hitter in interleague play with 15 home runs and 57 RBI in 120 games.
- Mark Canha (2-for-5, r, rbi) is batting .345 (12-for-34) with two doubles, two home runs and six RBI in eight games in June.
- Sam Fuld (1-for-1, 2 rbi) is 7-for-18 (.389) over his last eight games after going 7-for-76 (.092) over his previous 33 contests.
- Brett Lawrie (2-for-4, r, 2b, 2 rbi, bb, 2k) is 29-for-88 (.330) over his last 24 contests...has a .341 (47-for-138) career average in interleague play with five home runs and 23 RBI in 36 games...is batting .224 (24-for-107) at home compared with .331 (43-for-130) on the road.
- Ben Zobrist (3-for-4, 3 r, 2b, 3b, 3 rbi) put together his third three-hit game and his eighth multiple hit contest of the season...hit his first triple of the year (last: June 28, 2014 at Baltimore).

• The **San Diego Padres** have lost four in a row...fell to 3-8 in their last 11 games...are 3-8 this season in interleague play...are 0-1 on this eight-game road trip to Oakland (0-1), Arizona (three games) and San Francisco (three games).

• Odrisamer Despaigne made his first career start against the Athletics...is 4-7 with a 3.51 ERA (36 ER in 92.1 ip), 66 strikeouts and 27 walks when making his first career start against an opponent...has taken the loss in four of his last five decisions (8 starts).

 Alexi Amarista (1-for-3, hr, rbi) extended his season-best hitting streak to seven games...is hitting .391 (9-for-23) with a double, a homer, two RBIs and a walk during the streak...made his first career appearance as a pitcher.

• Matt Kemp (1-for-4, k) has hit safely in eight of his last nine road games...is batting .275 (11-for-40) with a home run and 10 RBI during that stretch.
