OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics snapped their four-game winning streak, which tied a season high (previous: May 31-June 4)...lost for just the third time in their last nine grames...lost for just the fifth time in their last 13 day games...fell to 3-1 in interleague play...have committed six errors in their last five games and have a Major League leading 65 for the season...are 1-1 on this five-game homestand against the San Diego Padres (1-1) and the Los Angeles Angels (three games).
- A's starting pitchers are 4-2 with a 1.60 ERA (10 er in 56.1 ip) over the last eight games... are 12-7 with a 2.00 ERA (36 er in 162.1 ip) over the last 25 games and have allowed one run or fewer 14 times over that stretch...have a 3.00 ERA (140 er in 419.2 ip) for the season.
- Kendall Graveman is 2-2 with a 2.27 ERA (10 er in 39.2 ip) in six starts since his return from Triple-A Nashville on May 23...has tossed seven or more innings and allowed two runs or fewer in each of his last three starts but is 0-2 with a no decision in those three games (4 er in 22.0 ip, 1.64 ERA)...made his first career interleague appearance.
- Billy Burns (1-for-4, k) has hit safely in each of his last nine games (14-for-39, .359) and in 21 of his last 22 (32-for-96, .333).
- Josh Phegley (1-for-2, r, hr, rbi) is batting .327 (17-for-52) over his last 17 games after hitting .219 over his first 11 contests...hit his first home run against a right-handed pitcher this season.
- Eric Sogard (0-for-3) snapped his seven-game hitting streak...was 9-for-30 (.300) with six RBI during the streak, which was the second longest of his career (14, July 19-Aug. 9, 2013).
- Stephen Vogt (1-for-4, 2b, 2k) has now reached base safely in all 30 of his home games, which is the second longest season-opening streak in Oakland history (33, Rickey Henderson, 1993)...is batting .329 (29-for-88) at home.

• The San Diego Padres snapped their four-game losing streak...improved to 4-8 in their last 12 games...are 4-8 this season in interleague play...have won five of their last eight games in an American League ballpark dating back to August 6, 2014...are 1-1 on this eight-game road trip to Oakland (1-1), Arizona (three games) and San Francisco (three games).

Kennedy

- lan Kennedy is 2-2 with a 3.77 ERA (12 er in 28.2 ip) in five starts on the road compared with 2-3 and a 6.82 ERA (26 er in 34.1 ip) in seven starts at home... is 5-11 with a 5.49 ERA (63 er in 103.1 ip), 96 strikeouts and 35 walks in 17 career interleague starts.
- Brandon Maurer has not allowed a run since May 27 (9 g, 9 ip) and has allowed just one run since May 2 (21 g, 23 ip).
- Yonder Alonso (1-for-3, 2b, bb) is hitting .387 (29-for-75) on the road this season.
- Matt Kemp (2-for-4, r, hr, rbi, k) has hit safely in nine of his last 10 road games...is batting .295 (13-for-44) with two home runs and 11 RBI during that stretch.
- Melvin Upton Jr. (1-for-4, 3b, r, k) tripled for the first time this season (previous: July 5, 2014 vs. Arizona).
- Will Venable (2-for-4, k) recorded his 13th multiple hit game of the year...has at least one hit in 21 of his last 37 games...is batting .293 (39-for-133) during the streak.
- Pat Murphy recorded his first win as a Major League manager.
