OAKLAND NOTES

 The Oakland Athletics have lost two straight after snapping their season-high tying four-game winning streak...are 1-2 on this five-game homestand against the San Diego Padres (1-1) and the Los Angeles Angels (0-1)

• A's starting pitchers are 4-2 with a 2.17 ERA (15 er in 62.1 ip) over the last nine games...are 12-7 with a 2.19 ERA (41 er in 168.1 ip) over the last 26 games and have allowed one run or fewer 14 times over that stretch...have a 3.07 ERA (145 er in 425.2 ip) for the season.

• The A's have committed a season-high tying four errors...have committed 10 errors in the last six games and now have 69 for the season...allowed eight runs in the seventh inning, the most they have allowed in an inning this season.

• Sonny Gray is 4-1 with a 1.99 ERA (9 er in 40.2 ip) over his last six starts... is 5-2 with a 2.00 ERA (15 er in 67.2 ip) in 10 starts against American League West competition.

• Billy Burns (3-for-5, rbi, 2 r, sb) has hit safely in each of his last 10 games (17-for-44, .386) and in 22 of his last 23 (35-for-101, .347).

• Brett Lawrie (2-for-4, r, 2 k) is batting .364 (20-for-55) in the month of June.

• Stephen Vogt (2-for-4, hr, 2b, 3 rbi, 2 r, bb, k) has now reached base safely in all 31 of his home games, which is the second longest season-opening streak in Oakland history (33, Rickey Henderson, 1993)...is batting .337 (31-for-92) at home.

• Ben Zobrist (2-for-5, hr, 2b, 3 rbi, r) is batting .500 (10-for-20) with 11 runs, four doubles and eight RBI over his last six games.

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels are 6-8 in their last 14 road games...are 1-3 this season when facing A's starter Sonny Gray...scored eight runs in the seventh inning, the second most runs they have scored in an inning this season...are 2-1 on this five-game road trip to the Arizona Diamondbacks (1-1) and Oakland Athletics (1-0).
- Matt Shoemaker is 1-1 with a 3.49 ERA (11 er in 28.1 ip) over his last five starts...is 1-2 with a 5.61 ERA (16 er in 25.2 ip) in six career games (five starts) against the A's...allowed his first home run in four starts (last: twice, May 21 at Toronto) to Ben Zobrist in the 1st inning.
- Erick Aybar (2-for-4, 2b, 2 r, rbi, bb) snapped an 0-for-11 hitless streak with a single in the top of the seventh.
- Johnny Giavotella (2-for-2, 2b, sf, 3 rbi, r, bb) is batting .333 (26-for-78) over his last 24 games.
- Albert Pujols (2-for-5, hr, 5 rbi, 3 r) is batting .351 (28-for-79) with 12 home runs and 25 RBI over his last 21 games...hit the 13th grand slam of his career in the seventh inning off of Edward Mujica...it is the fastest he has reached 20 home runs in a season since 2009.
- Mike Trout (1-for-4, 2b, rbi, 2 r, k) is batting .360 (18-for-50) with four home runs and 10 RBI over his last 12 contests.
