OAKLAND NOTES

• The **Oakland Athletics** snapped their two-game losing streak...improved to 5-7 against the Angels this season...won for just the sixth time in their last 20 games against the Angels...have won nine of their last 13 day games after losing 13 of their first 14...have seven errors in the last three games, 11 in the last seven and 70 for the season...are 2-2 on this five-game homestand against the San Diego Padres (1-1) and the Los Angeles Angels (1-1).

- The A's are batting .309 (80-for-259) with 51 runs scored over the last seven games (7.3 runs per game)...are 36-for-94 (.383) with runners in scoring position over that stretch...have out-scored the opposition 316-282 for the season.
- Athletics starting pitchers are 5-2 with a 2.06 ERA (16 er in 70.0 ip) over the last 10 games...are 13-7 with a 2.15 ERA (42 er in 176.0 ip) over the last 27 games (beginning May 23) and have allowed one run or fewer 15 times over that stretch...have a 3.03 ERA (146 er in 433.1 ip) for the season.
- Jesse Hahn is 4-1 with a 2.25 ERA (10 er in 40.0 ip) and .204 (30-for-147) opponents batting average over his last six starts...has allowed just three home runs in 84.2 innings...is 3-1 with a 1.53 ERA (6 er in 35.1 ip) and .167 (21-for-126) opponents batting average in five starts during the day...improved to 1-3 with a 4.35 (19 er in 39.1 ip) in seven starts against American League West competition.
- Billy Burns (2-for-5, k) extended his hitting streak to 11 games (19-for-49, .388) with a fifth-inning infield single...has recorded at least one hit in 23 of his last 24 (37-for-106, .349) contests...put together his 19th multiple hit game of the season.
- Brett Lawrie (1-for-4, r, 2b, rbi) is batting .356 (21-for-59) in the month of June.
- Josh Phegley (1-for-3, 2b, rbi, bb) is batting .327 (18-for-55) over his last 18 games after hitting .219 over his first 11 contests.
- Stephen Vogt (3-for-3, 2b, rbi, bb) has now reached base safely in all 32 of his home games, which is the second longest season-opening streak in Oakland history (33, Rickey Henderson, 1993)...recorded his 16th multiple hit game and his fifth three-hit contest of the season...is batting .358 (34-for-95) at home.

 The Los Angeles Angels are 24-19 in their last 43 games...are 6-9 in their last 15 road games...are 2-2 on this five-game road trip to the Arizona Diamondbacks (1-1) and Oakland Athletics (1-1).

- Jered Weaver is 0-4 with a 6.58 ERA (19 er in 26.0 ip) in his last four starts after going 4-0 with a 1.98 ERA (8 er in 36.1 ip) over his previous five starts...is now 10-5 with a 2.21 ERA (31 er in 126.0 ip) in 18 starts against the A's since 2011...is 6-7 with a 3.87 ERA (50 er in 116.1 ip) in 18 career starts at the O.co Coliseum.
- Erick Aybar (1-for-4, rbi) owns a career .340 (84-for-247) batting average at the O.co Coliseum.
- Johnny Giavotella (2-for-4) is batting .341 (28-for-82) over his last 25 games.
- Mike Trout (1-for-2, r, 2 bb) is batting .365 (19-for-52) with four home runs and 10 RBI over his last 13 contests...has scored 24 runs in his last 28 games.
