### OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** have won six of the last eight games...are now 6-7 against the Angels this season...have won 10 of their last 14 day games after losing 13 of their first 14...have won eight of the last 12 home games after starting the year 6-16...went 3-2 on this five-game homestand against the San Diego Padres (1-1) and the Los Angeles Angels (2-1).
- The A's have scored 54 runs (6.75 runs per game) and have 23 doubles over the last eight games...are 39-for-100 (.390) with runners in scoring position over that stretch.
- Athletics starting pitchers are 6-2 with a 1.98 ERA (17 er in 77.1 ip) over the last 11 games...are 14-7 with a 2.11 ERA (43 er in 183.1 ip) over the last 28 games (beginning May 23) and have allowed one run or fewer 16 times over that stretch...have a 3.00 ERA (147 er in 440.2 ip) for the season.
- Scott Kazmir is 2-1 with a 1.93 ERA (6 er in 28 ip) over his last five starts... is 3-1 with a 1.27 ERA (6 er in 42.2 ip) this season in seven starts in Oakland... is 4-0 with a 1.09 ERA (5 er in 41.1 ip) in six starts against American League West competition.
- Tyler Clippard recorded his third save of more than three outs, and his second in as many days (also: May 5, 2015 at Minnesota).
- Billy Burns (1-for-4, rbi) extended his hitting streak to a career-high tying 12 games (20-for-53, .377) with an RBI single in the third inning...has recorded at least one hit in 24 of his last 25 (38-for-110, .345) contests.
- Brett Lawrie (2-for-4, 2b, rbi) is batting .365 (23-for-63) in the month of June.
- Stephen Vogt (1-for-3, r, bb) has now reached base safely in all 33 of his home games, which is tied for the longest season-opening streak in Oakland history (33, Rickey Henderson, 1993)...is batting .357 (35-for-98) at home.
- Ben Zobrist (1-for-4, r) is 11-for-27 (.407) with 12 runs, four doubles, two home runs and eight RBI over his last eight games... is a .300 (57-for-190) career hitter against Los Angeles.

#### LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels are 24-20 in their last 44 games...are 6-10 in their last 16 road games...are now 18-14 against American League West competition...went 2-3 on this five-game road trip to the Arizona Diamondbacks (1-1) and Oakland Athletics (1-2)...will return home to begin a nine-game homestand against the Houston Astros (three games), Seattle Mariners (three games) and New York Yankees (three games).
- Garrett Richards is 2-1 with a 2.25 ERA (5 er in 20 ip) over his last three starts... is 7-2 with a 2.66 ERA (18 er in 61 ip) in his last 10 starts in the month of June... is 2-4 with a 5.03 ERA (30 er in 53.2 ip) in 13 career games (nine starts) against the A's.
- Erick Aybar (1-for-4, k) has a career batting average of .339 (85-for-251) at the O.co Coliseum.
- Johnny Giavotella (0-for-4, bb, k) is batting .322 (28-for-87) over his last 26 games.
- Albert Pujols (1-for-3, hr, 2 rbi, r, bb) is batting .341 (29-for-85) with 13 home runs and 27 RBI in his last 23 games.
- Mike Trout (2-for-4, k) is batting .375 (21-for-56) with four home runs and 10 RBI over his last 14 contests...has scored 24 runs in his last 29 games.
