#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** are 4-14 (.222) when the opponent starts a left-handed pitcher compared to 31-31 (.500) when they start a right hander...are 1-4 on this 10-game homestand against Kansas City (0-3), Colorado (1-1), and Seattle (four games).
- Chris Bassitt** made his first start as an Athletic today...is 1-2 with a 3.48 ERA (13 er in 33.2 ip) in six career starting assignments compared to 0-0 with a 3.86 ERA (5 er in 11.2 ip) in six career relief appearances.
- Fernando Rodriguez** recorded a career high tying five strikeouts (third time, last: September 24, 2012).
- Billy Burns** (1-for-4, sb) has now hit safely in 29 of his last 31 games (46-for-139, .331) and 44 of 52 overall.
- Billy Butler** (1-for-3, rbi, ibb, so) is now 12-for-37 (.324) over his last 12 games...is 10-for-19 (.526) with six runs, two home runs and six RBI in six interleague games this year...has a .311 (121-for-389) career average against the National League with 16 home runs and 60 RBI in 123 games.
- Ben Zobrist** (2-for-3, r, 2b, bb) is 20-for-54 (.370) with 18 runs, six doubles, a triple, three home runs, 13 RBI, and 12 walks over his last 16 games.

#### COLORADO NOTES

- The **Colorado Rockies** snapped their three game losing streak...are 23-24 since snapping their season-long 11-game losing streak on May 14...are 2-3 on this 10-game road trip to San Francisco (1-2), Oakland (1-1), and Arizona (four games).
- Jorge De La Rosa** recorded four strikeouts and is one away from 1,000 in his career...is 3-1 with a 1.37 ERA (4 er in 26.1 ip) in four starts on the road compared to 2-2 with a 6.81 ERA in eight starts at home...the Rockies have won six of his past seven starts.
- Nolan Arenado** (1-for-4, so) extended his hitting streak to 17 games (24-for-66, .364)...it is now the longest active hitting streak in the majors...is batting .304 (34-for-112) with 12 home runs and 33 RBI in June...is batting .297 (43-for-145) with 15 homers and 37 RBI on the road compared to .287 (41-for-143) with nine home runs and 31 RBI at home.
- Charlie Blackmon** (1-for-4, rbi) has hit safely in 16 of his past 18 games (21-for-66, .318)...is batting .307 in June (35-for-114).
- Troy Tulowitzki** (1-for-4, so) has reached base in a career-best 29 consecutive games (previous: 27, July 14-August 10, 2011)...extended his hitting streak to 14 games (21-for-55, .382)...the hitting streak is an ongoing career high.
