OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** won for just the second time in the last six games...however, have won 11 of the last 17 games...are 5-2 in interleague play...improved to 15-13 all-time against the Rockies, including 9-5 in Oakland and 6-8 in Denver...have out-scored the opposition 360-312 for a run differential of +48...are 2-4 on this 10-game homestand against Kansas City (0-3), Colorado (2-1), and Seattle (four games).
- A's starting pitchers are 19-11 with a 2.42 ERA (64 er in 238.0 ip) over the last 37 games (beginning May 23) and have allowed one run or fewer 19 times
 over that stretch...have a 3.05 ERA (168 er in 495.1 ip) for the season.
- Oakland has committed 18 errors in the last 17 games and has 77 for the season.
- Jesse Hahn is 5-2 with a 2.42 ERA (14 er in 52.0 ip) and a .222 (43-for-194) opponents batting average over his last eight starts...is 4-1 with a 1.52 ERA (7 er in 41.1 ip) and a .169 (25-for-148) opponents batting average in six starts during the day compared to 2-5 with a 4.72 ERA (29 er in 55.1 ip) and a .284 (63-for-222) opponents batting average in 10 starts at night.
- Billy Burns (2-for-4, 2 r, 2b, 3b, bb, so) has now hit safely in 30 of his last 32 games (48-for-143, .336) and 45 of 53 overall...recorded his 22nd multiple hit game of the year.
- Billy Butler (2-for-3, r, 3b, rbi, bb, so) hit his first triple since August 9, 2012 at Baltimore...is 14-for-40 (.350) over his last 13 games...is 12-for-22 (.545) with seven runs, a triple, two home runs and seven RBI in seven interleague games this year...has a .314 (123-for-392) career average against the National League with 16 home runs and 61 RBI in 124 games...recorded his 19th multiple hit game of the year.
- Ben Zobrist (2-for-3, r, 2b, bb) is 22-for-57 (.386) with 19 runs, seven doubles, a triple, three home runs, 13 RBI, and 13 walks over his last 17 games...had
 his 13th multiple hit contest of the season.

COLORADO NOTES

- The Colorado Rockies fell to 1-4 in the last five games and 5-5 in the last 10...are 23-25 since snapping their season-long 11-game losing streak on May 14...are 2-4 on this 10-game road trip to San Francisco (1-2), Oakland (1-2), and Arizona (four games).
- Chad Bettis made his first career appearance against the A's...is 2-3 with a 4.82 ERA (15 er in 28.0 ip) over his last five starts compared to 2-0 with a 2.70 ERA (10 er in 33.1 ip) over his first five starts...is 2-5 with a 4.50 ERA (31 er in 62.0 ip) on the road compared to 3-3 with a 6.16 ERA (47 er in 68.2 ip) at home.
- Nolan Arenado's (0-for-4) 17-game hitting streak was snapped...hit .364 (24-for-66) during the streak, which was the longest active hitting streak in the majors...is batting .289 (43-for-149) with 15 homers and 37 RBI on the road compared to .287 (41-for-143) with nine home runs and 31 RBI at home.
- · Carlos Gonzalez (2-for-4, 2b) is batting .301 (34-for-113) since May 27...recorded his 14th multiple hit game of the season.
- Ben Paulsen (1-for-3, r, 2b) is batting .292 (35-for-120) since being recalled from Triple-A Albuquerque on May 19.
