#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** have won three of the last four, 12 of the last 18, and are 23-15 dating back to May 23...are 5-14 this season when facing a left-handed pitcher...have out-scored the opposition 364-312 for a run differential of +52...are 3-4 on this 10-game homestand against Kansas City (0-3), Colorado (2-1), and Seattle (1-0).
- A's** starting pitchers are 20-11 with a 2.34 ERA (64 er in 246.0 ip) over the last 38 games (beginning May 23) and have allowed one run or fewer 20 times over that stretch...have a 3.00 ERA (168 er in 503.1 ip) for the season.
- Oakland** has 16 doubles in the last seven games.
- Scott Kazmir** did not allow a hit until Franklin Gutierrez led off the fifth inning with a double...it is the fourth time in his career that he has gone at least eight innings with only two hits allowed (last: June 11, 2015 vs. Texas)...is 3-2 with a 1.88 ERA (9 er in 43.0 ip) over his last seven starts...is 5-0 with a 0.91 ERA (5 er in 49.1 ip) in seven starts against American League West opponents this season...is 4-2 with a 1.38 ERA (9 er in 58.2 ip) in nine starts this season in Oakland...has recorded at least six strikeouts in each of his last five starts.
- Mark Canha** (1-for-3, 3b, rbi) recorded his first career triple in the seventh inning.
- Billy Butler** (1-for-3, r, bb) is 15-for-43 (.349) over his last 14 games.
- Josh Phegley** (1-for-4, 2b, 2 rbi, k) is batting .307 (23-for-75) over his last 24 games...is hitting .333 (18-for-53) against left-handed pitchers.
- Marcus Semien** (1-for-3, hr, rbi, r) snapped a career-high 45-game homerless streak with a solo homer in the fifth inning (previous: 26, April 24-Sept. 9, 2014)...last homered on May 12 against Boston.
- Ben Zobrist** (1-for-3, r, bb, k) is 23-for-60 (.383) with 20 runs, seven doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, and 14 walks over his last 18 games.

- The **Seattle Mariners** are 9-9 in the last 18 games...are 12-8 in their last 20 road contests...are 5-2 against the A's this season...are 3-3 on this nine-game road trip to Los Angeles-AL (1-2), San Diego (2-0) and Oakland (0-1).
- Roenis Elias** is 1-3 with a 8.55 ERA (19 er in 20.0 ip) over his last four starts...is 4-6 with a 3.96 ERA (39 er in 88.2 ip) in 16 career starts against American League West competition.
- Robinson Cano** (0-for-4, k) is batting .276 (16-for-58) over his last 15 games.
- Nelson Cruz** (0-for-3, 2 k) is 7-for-23 (.304) over his last six games...is batting .322 (46-for-143) on the road this season...is 20-for-54 (.370) against left-handed pitchers this season.
- Franklin Gutierrez** (2-for-3, 2b) is 9-for-21 (.429) in his career against Scott Kazmir.
