## OAKLAND NOTES

• The **Oakland Athletics** fell to 5-15 when facing a left-handed starter...lost for just the eighth time in their last 20 games...are now 23-16 since May 23...have committed 20 errors in the last 19 games and have 79 for the season...sold out the Coliseum for the second time this year...are 3-5 on this 10-game homestand against Kansas City (0-3), Colorado (2-1), and Seattle (1-1).

- A's starting pitchers are 20-12 with a 2.43 ERA (68 er in 252.1 ip) over the last 39 games (beginning May 23) and have allowed one run or fewer 20 times over that stretch...have a 3.04 ERA (172 er in 509.2 ip) for the season.
- Jesse Chavez is 2-3 with a 5.00 ERA (20 er in 36.0 ip) over his last six starts after going 2-5 with a 2.38 ERA over his first eight starts... is 3-3 with a 2.76 ERA (18 er in 58.2 ip) in 11 games at night compared to 1-5 with a 3.89 ERA (16 er in 37.0 ip) in seven games during the day.

• Evan Scribner allowed his eighth and ninth home runs of the year and now leads American League relievers.

- Billy Burns (2-for-5, 2b, rbi, so) is batting .331 (49-for-148) over his last 33 games...recorded his 23rd multiple hit contest of the season.
- Brett Lawrie (2-for-3, r, so) had his 22nd multiple hit game of the year.
- Josh Reddick (2-for-4, 2 r, so) recorded his team-best 24th multiple hit contest of the season.
- Stephen Vogt (1-for-4) is batting .338 (22-for-65) with four doubles, two home runs, 13 RBI and six multiple hit games over his last 17 games.

## SEATTLE NOTES

None

- The Seattle Mariners are 6-2 against the A's this season...have hit 17 home runs in the last 12 games (since June 20)...are 31-19 when hitting at least one homer...are 13-8 in their last 21 road games...are 4-3 on this nine-game road trip to Los Angeles-AL (1-2), San Diego (2-0) and Oakland (1-1).
- J.A. Happ snapped a four-start losing streak...earned his first win since May 9, also at Oakland...is 3-0 with a 2.01 ERA (7 er in 31.1 ip) in five career starts against the Athletics...has pitched at least six innings in 18 of his last 23 starts dating back to August 25, 2014.
- Robinson Cano (3-for-5, r, 2b, so) is batting .302 (19-for-63) with eight runs, five doubles, three home runs, eight RBI and two walks over his last 16 games... is 6-for-15 (.400) in his career against Jesse Chavez...recorded his 24th multiple hit game and his fifth three-hit contest of the season.
- Nelson Cruz (2-for-5, r, hr, 2 rbi) is 9-for-28 (.321) with four runs, three doubles, two home runs and six RBI over his last seven games...is batting .324 (48-for-148) on the road this season...is hitting .393 (11-for-28) with five runs, one double, three home runs and seven RBI in his last seven games against Oakland...is 5-for-11 with one double and two home runs in his career against Jesse Chavez...recorded his team-leading 28th multiple hit game of the year.
- Austin Jackson (1-for-5) has recorded at least one hit in 22 of his last 31 games...is batting .276 (34-for-123) with 11 runs, 10 extra-base hits and 11 RBI over that stretch.
- Brad Miller (2-for-4, r, 2b, hr, 2 rbi) is 10-for-24 (.417) with three runs, three doubles, two homers, five RBI and one walk on Seattle's current nine-game road trip.
