OAKLAND NOTES

 The Oakland Athletics have won four of the last six games, 13 of the last 20, and are 24-16 since May 23...have won 13 of the last 19 day games...moved to 3-6 this season against Seattle...are 27-19 on the 4th of July since moving to Oakland in 1968, including a 15-7 record in Oakland...are 4-5 on this 10-game homestand against Kansas City (0-3), Colorado (2-1), and Seattle (2-1).

- A's starting pitchers are 21-12 with a 2.36 ERA (68 er in 259.1 ip) over the last 40 games (beginning May 23) and have allowed one run or fewer 20 times over that stretch...have a 3.00 ERA (172 er in 516.2 ip) for the season.
- Kendall Graveman has won each of his last three starts...is 3-2 with a 1.25 ERA (5 er in 36.0 ip) over his last five starts...is 2-3 with a 4.67 ERA (18 er in 34.2 ip) in six starts at home...is 3-3 with a 4.23 ERA (18 er in 38.1 ip) in seven starts against American League West competition...is 2-3 with a 4.11 ERA (16 er in 35.0 ip) in six starts during the day.
- Billy Burns (2-for-4, 2 r, sb) is batting .336 (51-for-152) over his last 34 games...recorded his team-high tying 24th multiple-hit contest of the season.
- Brett Lawrie (2-for-3) recorded his 23rd mulitple-hit game of the season.
- Stephen Vogt (2-for-3, 2b, bb) is batting .353 (24-for-68) with five doubles, two home runs, 13 RBI and seven multiple hit games over his last 18 games... recorded his 21st multiple-hit game.
- Ben Zobrist (1-for-3, 2 rbi, sf) is 24-for-67 (.358) with 20 runs, seven doubles and 15 RBI over his last 20 games.

SEATTLE NOTES

- The Seattle Mariners are 6-3 against the A's this season...are 16-21 all time when playing on the 4th of July...are 13-9 in their last 22 road games...are 15-11 at O.co Coliseum since the start of 2013...are 4-4 on this nine-game road trip to Los Angeles-AL (1-2), San Diego (2-0) and Oakland (1-2).
- Felix Hernandez had his streak of 13 consecutive starts with at O.co Coliseum without recording a loss snapped...it was tied for the longest such streak by an opposing pitcher (also: Mike Flanagan, 1977-84)...is 10-3 with a 2.63 ERA (43 er in 147.0 ip) in 21 career starts in Oakland...is 1-3 with a 5.25 ERA (14 er in 28.0 ip) in his last five starts.
- David Rollins made his major league debut.
- Robinson Cano (1-for-3, k, bb) is batting .316 (18-for-57) with eight runs, five doubles and three home runs over his last 15 games.
- Nelson Cruz (1-for-4, k) is 10-for-32 (.313) with four runs, three doubles, two home runs and six RBI over his last seven games...is batting .322 (49-for-152) on the road this season...is hitting .375 (12-for-32) with five runs, one double, three home runs and seven RBI in his last seven games against Oakland.
 Austin Jackson (1-for-4, 2b) has hit safely in 23 of his last 32 contests...is batting .276 (35-for-127) over that span.
- Austin Jackson (1-101-4, 20) has hit safety in 23 of his last 32 contests...is batting .276 (35-101-127) over that span.
 Brad Miller (1-for-3) is 11-for-27 (.407) with three runs, three doubles, two homers and five RBI over the last eight games...is batting .362 (17-for-47) over the last 15 road games.
- Mark Trumbo (1-for-3) snapped an 0-for-16 streak with a single in the top of the fifth.
