• The Oakland Athletics are 3-7 this season against Seattle...went 4-6 on this 10-game homestand against Kansas City (0-3), Colorado (2-1), and Seattle (2-2)...leave following the game today for the for the final road trip before the break, a six-game trip to New York (three games) and Cleveland (three games). A's starting pitchers are 21-13 with a 2.42 ERA (70 er in 260.0 ip) over the last 40 games (beginning May 23)...have a 3.00 ERA (174 er in 522.1 ip) for the

season. Chris Bassitt is 0-2 with a 2.53 ERA (3 er in 10.2 ip) in two starts since he was recalled from Triple-A Nashville last Tuesday.

• Billy Burns (1-for-4) is batting .333 (52-for-156) over his last 34 games...leads Major League rookies in hits (78).

Sam Fuld (1-for-3, r, hr, rbi, gdip) snapped a 66 game homerless streak with a solo home run in the third innning.

Brett Lawrie (1-for-3) is now batting .359 (23-for-64) over his last 18 games.

Marcus Semien (1-for-3, so) is 15-for-40 (.375) with three home runs, seven RBI, and six runs, scored in nine career games against Seattle, all this year. Ben Zobrist (2-for-4, 2b) is 26-for-71 (.366) with 20 runs, eight doubles and 15 RBI over his last 20 games.

- The Seattle Mariners are 7-3 against the A's this season...are 14-9 in their last 23 road games...are 16-11 at O.co Coliseum since the start of 2013...went 5-4 on this nine-game road trip to Los Angeles-AL (1-2), San Diego (2-0) and Oakland (2-2)...begin a seven game homestand tomorrow against Detroit (three games) and Los Angeles-AL (four games).
- Mike Montgomery had his 20.0 inning scoreless streak snapped in the third innnig when he allowed a solo home run to Fuld...is now 3-0 with a 0.38 ERA (1 er in 23.2 ip) over his past three starts.
- Dustin Ackley (2-for-3) is batting .348 (8-for-23) against the A's this year
- Nelson Cruz (1-for-4, r, 2b,) is 11-for-36 (.306) with five runs, four doubles, two home runs and six RBI over his last seven games...is batting .321 (50-for-156) on the road this season...is hitting .361 (13-for-36) with five runs, one double, three home runs and seven RBI in his last eight games against Oakland.
- Seth Smith (1-for-2, bb, 2 rbi) had a two-run single in the sixth inning...is hitting .346 (9-for-26) against the A's this year.
