OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** are 7-10 over the last 17 games but are 27-21 since bottoming out at a season-high 16 games under .500 (14-30) at the conclusion of play on May 22...are 0-1 on this six-game homestand against Minnesota (0-1) and Toronto (three games).
- Sonny Gray allowed the first grand slam of his career...allowed a season high tying five earned runs (also June 19)...had his three game winning streak snapped...had a 2.78 ERA (11 er in 35.2 ip) in five starts over that span.
- Billy Burns (1 for 4, sb) snapped his 0-for-14 streak with a single in the eighth inning...is batting .358 (44-for-123) at home compared to .257 (39-for-152) on the road.
- Brett Lawrie (1 for 4) snapped his 0-for-14 streak with a single in the seventh inning...has a nine-game hitting streak against the Twins (14-for-39, .359)...is a .346 (28-for-81) career hitter against Minnesota.
- Stephen Vogt (1 for 4) is a .310 (13-for-42) career hitter against the Twins with four home runs and 14 RBI in 13 games...the only team he has more home runs against is the Angels (5).

- The **Minnesota Twins** are on a four-game winning streak ...are19-24 on the road compared to 31-16 at home...are 1-0 on this six-game road trip to Oakland (1-0) and Los Angeles-AL (three games).
- Ervin Santana earned his first win as a Twin...is 15-6 with a 2.03 ERA (42 er in 186 ip) in 27 starts in his career against the A's.
- Brian Dozier (1 for 4, 2 r, hr, rbi, bb, 2 so) hit his fifth leadoff home run of the season, the 12th of his career.
- Torii Hunter (2 for 5, so) is batting .358 (39-for-109) with 10 home runs and 27 RBI over his last 27 games against the A's.
- Trevor Plouffe (2 for 4, r, hr, 4 rbi) hit his second career grand slam, both this year (also May 3)...is batting .368 (14-for-38) over his last 10 games.
