THE TWINS: The Twins began the post-All-Star break portion of their schedule with a win over the A's last night...tonight, they continue their six-game seven-day road trip with the second of three in Oakland...after the series finale tomorrow afternoon, the Twins will enjoy an off-day, then play three at Los Angeles-AL from Tuesday-Thursday...the Twins are 31-16 at home compared to 19-24 on the road...they are 4-3 in their last seven road games, looking for consecutive wins away from Minnesota for the first time since winning two straight in Boston June 3-4.

TWINS BEGIN SECOND HALF WITH A BANG: The Twins shutout the A's last night by a score of 5-0, marking their eighth shutout of an opponent this season and their second of the A's (also May 6 at Target Field, 13-0)...Ervin Santana earned his first win as a Twin, tossing 7.2 innings with five hits allowed, one walk and one strikeout...Brian Dozier and Trevor Plouffe accounted for all five of the Twins runs as Dozier hit his fifth leadoff homer of the season and Trevor Plouffe hit his second career grand slam.

• ELIAS SAYS: Santana's 1.93 career ERA at O.co Coliseum is the third-lowest among pitchers who have had at least 10 starts here, behind Pat Dobson (1.84) and Bret Saberhagen (1.89).

LEADING MAN: Brian Dozier's leadoff home run last night tied Dan Gladden for third on the Twins all-time leadoff homer list...below are Dozier's five this year and the Twins all-time ranks:

THIS IS 40: Torii Hunter is celebrating his 40th birthday today...he has played 11 career games on his birthday, hitting .256 (10-for-39) with three doubles, two home runs, six RBI, five walks and seven runs scored...last year on his birthday, he went 1-for-4 with a double and a run scored for the Tigers vs. Cleveland...his last home run on his birthday came in 2002 at Cleveland, off Ryan Drese; in fact Jacque Jones hit a leadoff homer in that same game...the last three Twins to play in their 40's were Jim Thome (40 in 2011), Ruben Sierra (40 in 2006) and Terry Mulholland (42 in 2005)...Hunter ranks in the top five in three categories among actives:

Additional Note: Hunter ranks sixth in doubles (491) and total bases (4,011), eighth in runs (1,273), extra-base hits (875) and RBI (1,359), 10th in home runs (345) and 18th in stolen bases (194).

WHAT'S ON THE LINE: A win tonight would give the Twins a five-game winning streak, which would tie their season-long, previously done twice: April 30-May 4 and May 23-27...a win would also match the Twins high-water mark this season of 11 games over .500, the other time being when they were 32-21 entering play of June 5.

ELITE EIGHT: The Twins have gone 7-1 in their last eight games, out-scoring opponents 48-24 in those eight and out-hitting them 77-67...in that span, batters have hit .287 (77-for-268) with a .357 on-base percentage, 6.0 runs-per-game, homering at least twice in a game four times in that span (12 total).

TWINS AND A'S: The Twins are now 4-1 against the A's this season, out-scoring them 33-14...they are looking to beat the A's for the fourth consecutive time, which would mark their longest winning streak against Oakland since winning five straight July 12, 2007-April 22, 2008...the last time they beat the A's in four straight in a *single season* was in 2003, when they won eight straight...last night's win secured the season series, marking the first time since going 6-3 against Oakland in 2010.

FAST 50: The Twins reached 50 wins in their 90th game last night, marking the 11th time in club history to reach 50 wins in their first 90...it is the fewest total number of games for the Twins to reach 50 since 2008...their most ever wins through 90 was 59 (31 losses) in 1970.

TORII, ALL ABOUT THOSE A'S: Torii Hunter is hitting .358 (39-for-109) with five doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 27 RBI and 19 runs scored in his last 27 games against the A's...in that same span he has 13 multi-hit games and seven multi-RBI games...among actives against Oakland, he ranks fourth in home runs (28), RBI (91), games (169) and at-bats (626).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Twins are seeking their 16th series win tonight, going 15-12-12...they have won each of their last two series', a three-game series win over Baltimore July 6-8 and a four-game series win over Detroit July 9-12...their last series win over Oakland came in a three-game sweep at Target Field May 28-30, 2012...their last series win at O.co Coliseum came in a two-game sweep May 18-19, 2011.

THE SKIPPER

Paul Molitor was named Twins Manager November 4, 2014 becoming the 13th Manager in club history and just the third since 1986 (Tom Kelly, Ron Gardenhire)...2015 marks his 15th minor league and major league professional coaching season...inducted into baseball HOF in 2004 and one of just six players in MLB history with 3,000 hits and 500 stolen bases...ranks ninth on baseball's all-time hit list amassing 3,319 in 21-year career from 1978-98...1974 graduate of Cretin High School in St. Paul, attended University of Minnesota from 1975-77 and played for Twins from 1996-98.

LAST TIME OUT: July 11 vs. Detroit, Hughes recorded his fourth win in his last four decisions, going 5.0 innings and giving up four runs on eight hits with no walks and three strikeouts in the Twins 9-5 victory...after allowing just two singles in the first three innings, Hughes gave up three runs in the fourth inning, highlighted by a James McCann two-run single, and another in the fifth inning on a Yoenis Cespedes double...here is another note on his outing:

- The four-game winning streak marks the fourth time Hughes has won four-or-more games in a row as a Twin, and the second this year...Hughes had a Twins-best six-game winning streak from April 20-June 1, 2014, the longest for any Twins starter the last two seasons.

FIRST HALF RECAP: In Hughes' first 11 starts, he had a 4.96 ERA (69.0 IP, 38 ER), 1.35 WHIP and four quality starts...however, over his final seven starts, a stretch that began June 8, Hughes went 4-1, 3.40 ERA (47.2 IP, 18 ER) with four walks, 25 strikeouts, 1.11 WHIP and five quality starts...in his career, Hughes has a 4.44 ERA (642.1 IP, 317 ER) in 120 appearances (107 starts) before the All-Star break compared to a 4.14 ERA (464.1 IP, 214 ER) in 112 appearances (75 starts) post All-Star break...more on Hughes' first half:

- In the fourth inning of his April 12th start at Chicago-AL, Hughes reached the 1,000.0 inning plateau, becoming the 14th AL right-hander since his rookie season (2007) to do so.
- Pitched his fourth career complete game April 24 at Seattle, but took the loss opposite Felix Hernandez after giving up two runs (both on solo home runs) in 8.0 innings.
- Recorded the win on his birthday, June 29, after allowing one run in 8.0 innings vs. Chicago-AL.
- Over a two start stretch, June 19 vs. the Cubs and June 24 vs. the White Sox, held right-handers to a .042 average (1-for-24).
- Posted a stretch of 27.1 innings, a span of 103 plate appearances, without a walk from June 14-30.

AGAINST THE ATHLETICS: Hughes will be making his 11th start and 14th appearance against the Athletics...he is 5-2-1 with a 4.52 ERA (61.2 IP, 31 ER), 28 walks and 52 strikeouts...his first three appearances came in relief in 2009, where he recorded one of his three career saves...he was the winner in his only start against them this season, May 4 at Target Field, going 6.0 innings and allowing five runs on nine hits with a season-high two walks and two strikeouts...he gave up five hits and four runs (Vogt grand slam) in the first inning, but he held the A's scoreless for the next four innings until Mark Canha hit a one-out home run in the sixth inning...he has gone 7.0-or-more innings, allowing two-or-less earned runs in three of his four starts in Oakland.

QUALITY CONSISTENCY: Hughes has tossed quality starts in five of his last seven starts after having just four in his first 11 starts...in 50 starts as a Twin, Hughes has 29 quality starts (58.0 percent)...the Twins have gone 21-8 in those games...the 29 quality starts since last season are the most on the staff in that time...in fact, Hughes has gone at least 6.0 innings in 26 of his last 29 starts, and in one of the three starts he failed to go 6.0 innings he left after 5.0 innings with a mild stain of his hip flexor...the Twins have gone 26-15 when Hughes has worked at least 6.0 innings over the last two seasons.

NO CAKE-WALK: Through 18 starts this year, Hughes has walked just 11 batters, tied with Bartolo Colon for the fewest in baseball with a minimum of 75.0 innings pitched...Hughes hasn't allowed a walk in eight of his starts, while allowing multiple walks just once (May 4 vs. OAK)...additionally, Hughes' 6.36 strikeout/walk ratio is the third best in the AL (Pineda - 8.54, Sale - 6.83), while his 0.85 walks-per-9.0 innings is the lowest in baseball...in 26 starts in his Twins career in which he hasn't allowed a walk, the Twins are 19-8 compared to being 11-12 when he issues a walk.

YARD WORK: Hughes allowed a home run to Victor Martinez in his last start, his 22nd allowed on the season, the most in the AL and trailing on Kyle Kendricks' 23 for the most in baseball...in fact, he gave up only 16 home runs last season and didn't give up his 16th until September 19...he has now surrendered a home run in 15 of his 18 starts this season, including one-or-more in each of his last seven...he has also given up a home run in 19 of his last 23 outings, a stretch in which he's surrendered 26 total...in addition to the 22 home runs this season, Hughes has allowed 28 doubles and two triples, totaling 52 extra-base hits allowed, tied with Kyle Kendricks for the second most in baseball, trailing James Shields (53)...the 135 total hits Hughes has allowed this year are second most in the majors, trailing Jeff Samardzija (137).

CAREER NOTES

- Made first career Opening Day start April 6 at Detroit (6.0-8-4-4-1-6)...eighth different Twins pitcher to start Opening Day in nine seasons (since 2007).
- Signed a five-year extension with Minnesota, covering the 2015-2019 seasons December 22, 2014.
- In his first season with the Twins, set the major league record for highest strikeout-to-walk ratio at 11.63...became the sixth pitcher in baseball history to reach 200.0 innings pitched and walk less than 20 batters in a single season.
- Spent seven seasons with New York-AL, 2007-13, going 56-50, 4.53 ERA (780.2 IP, 393 ER) with 245 walks and 656 strikeouts.
- Made his major league debut April 26, 2007 for the Yankees against Toronto...allowed four runs on seven hits in 4.1 innings in that start...was the youngest Yankees pitcher (20 years, 306 days) to debut since Jose Rijo on April 5, 1984 (18 years, 328 days).
- Spent three-plus seasons in the minors for New York before being called up...went 32-8, 2.36 ERA (344.0 IP, 90 ER) with 85 walks and 385 strikeouts in 68 games (65 starts) in the minors.
- Drafted by the Yankees in the first round (23rd overall) of the 2004 First-Year Player Draft.
- 2004 graduate of Foothill High School in Santa Ana, CA where he owns the school record for career wins (23) and ranks third in school history with 182 strikeouts...was primarily a third baseman until his sophomore year when he transferred to the mound.
