OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics had their third walk-off win of the season...are 7-18 when the opponent starts a left-handed pitcher...are 10-22 in games decided by one run...are 25-26 against the Blue Jays dating back to 2009...are 3-2 on this six-game homestand against Minnesota (2-1) and Toronto (1-1).
- Bob Melvin won his 369th game as manager of the A's, which surpasses Ken Macha for third most in Oakland history...only Tony La Russa (798) and Art Howe (600) have more.
- A's starting pitchers have allowed one run or fewer in 25 of the last 52 games and are 23-17 with a 2.62 ERA (97 er in 332.2 ip) over that span, which dates back to May 23.
- Sonny Gray is 2-1 with a 3.95 ERA (18 er in 41.0 ip) over his last six starts... is 3-3 with a 2.84 ERA (20 er in 63.1 ip) in nine starts at home... is 7-2 with a 1.79 ERA (18 er in 90.2 ip) in 13 starts when pitching on four day's rest.
- Billy Burns (2-for-4, r, bb, sb) recorded his 20th stolen base of the season...is the eighth rookie in Oakland history with 20 or more stolen bases...recorded his team-best 28th multiple-hit game of the year...is batting .362 (51-for-141) at home compared to .257 (39-for-152) on the road.
- Ike Davis (1-for-1, rbi) recorded his fifth walk-off hit of his career with an rbi single in the 10th inning (last: July 1, 2014 vs. Arizona).
- Josh Phegley (2-for-4, rbi, k) is batting .319 (22-for-69) with 11 RBI against left-handed pitching...recorded his 11th multiple-hit game of the year.
- Jake Smolinski (1-for-3, r, rbi, sf, k) is 7-for-16 (.438) with five runs, one triple, two home runs and seven RBI in six games with the A's.
- Stephen Vogt (2-for-5, r, rbi) snapped an 0-for-6 hitless streak with an RBI single in the bottom of the fifth...recorded his 24th multiple-hit game of the year.

- The Toronto Blue Jays have lost 12 of the past 19 contests...are 20-29 on the road this season...have a Major League leading 508 runs...are 1-1 on this sixgame road trip to Oakland (1-1) and Seattle (three games).
- Felix Doubront is 1-0 with a 4.34 ERA (9 er in 18.2 ip) in four games (three starts) this season... is 1-2 with a 7.04 ERA (18 er in 23.0 ip) in five career starts against Oakland...did not pitch five complete innings for the second time in five career starts against the A's.
- Jose Bautista (1-for-4, bb) has reached base safely in 49 of his last 55 games.
- Josh Donaldson (2-for-4, rbi, bb, k) recorded his 34th multiple-hit game of the season.
- Kevin Pillar (1-for-5) is batting .333 (58-for-174) over his last 46 games...has hit safely in 26 of his last 34 contests.
- Jose Reyes (1-for-5, bb, k) has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 games and is batting .345 (20-for-58) over that span...is batting .294 (63-for-214) since returning from the disabled list on May 25.
- Danny Valencia (2-for-4, hr. 2 r. rbi, bb, k) recorded his 12th multiple-hit game of the season.
