OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won three of six since the All-Star Break...have also won five of the last eight but are 10-12 over the last 22 contests...are 25-27 against the Blue Jays dating back to 2009...went 3-3 on this six-game homestand against Minnesota (2-1) and Toronto (1-2)...start their first post-break road trip tomorrow, a five game trip to San Francisco (three games) and Los Angeles-NL (two games).
- Drew Pomeranz made his first start since May 18...in two seasons with the A's, is 1-1 with a 1.59 ERA (6 er in 34.0 ip) in 29 relief appearences, 6-6 with a 3.52 ERA (38 er in 97 ip) in 19 starts
- Billy Burns (2-for-4, 2b, rbi, so) has hit safely in each of the six games since the All-Star Break (10-for-26, .385)...is batting .366 (53-for-145) at home compared to .257 (39-for-152) on the road.
- Billy Butler (0-for-3, 2 so, gidp, hbp) is 0 for his last 12.
- Ike Davis (0-for-4, gidp) is now batting .203 (13-for-64) in 22 games since he was reinstated from the 15-day disabled list June 19.

- Kevin Pillar (1-for-4) is batting .331 (59-for-178) over his last 46 games...has hit safely in 27 of his last 35 contests.
