THE LATEST:

◆ Last night, TOR lost **game #2** of their series at OAK, 4-3 in **10** innings to fall to **48-48**...Lost on a walk-off infield single by **Ike Davis** in the 10th frame...It was the **4th** time TOR has lost in walk-off fashion this year (last: **July 8** at CWS) & are now **8-11** when the game is decided in the final at bat...Fall to **3-4** in extra-inning games (**2-3** on the road), having lost **three** of the last **four** of those affairs...Left **11** men on base & went **2-for-10** with RISP in the loss...Have lost **12** of their last **19** games, however, have outscored the opposition, **88-82** over that stretch...Are looking to win **back-to-back series** for the 1st time since **June 22-28** (2-1 at TB, 2-1 vs. TEX)...Are **14-18** since their 11-G win streak & are outscoring the opposition **152-129 (+23)**, despite the losing record...The pitching staff has allowed **3-ER or less** in **five** straight & in **nine** of their last 11 contests (**2.95** ERA, 32ER/97.2).

ABOUT LAST NIGHT:

◆ **Felix Doubront** lasted 4.2 IP (7H, 2ER) in his 3rd start with TOR...The bullpen worked 5.0 IP (4H, 2BB, 6K) allowing just the one run in the 10th inning (Osuna-4th loss)...The bullpen has allowed just 3-ER over their last 14.0 IP (1.93 ERA).
 ◆ **Danny Valencia** went 2-for-4 & launched his 7th HR of the season, 5th vs. a RHP...Is batting **.331** (40-121) with a **.926** OPS as a starter this year (32-GS)...**Russell Martin** matched his season high with **three** hits (6th time) & has hit safely in **seven** of his last **eight** games (**.323**, 10-31, 5-RBI)...**Jose Reyes** went 1-for-4 with a BB & is batting **.347** (26-75) with a **.812** OPS over his last **17G**.

PILLAR OF STRENGTH:

◆ Since **June 1**, **Kevin Pillar** is batting **.335** (54-161) with **9-2B**, **1-3B**, **5-HR**, **20-RBI** & a **.854** OPS (43-games)...Among the **AL** since that point, ranks **3rd** in AVG & **T-4th** in hits...Among all **OF**, ranks **T-2nd** in defensive runs saved with **13** (**K. Kiermaier** leads with 24).

DID YOU KNOW?:

◆ TOR has homered in **five** straight games (9-HR) & rank **3rd** in the ML this month with **25-HR** (DET/LAA-28)...No team has hit more HR in the month of **July** since **2010** than TOR-**183** (BAL 2nd - 171).
 ◆ TOR starters have allowed **2-ER or less** in **five** straight & **11** of their last **13** outings since **July 5** (**2.63** ERA, 24ER/82.0, 3HR)...Their **2.63** ERA over that span ranks **2nd** in the AL (LAA leads at **2.12**).
 ◆ That TOR **leads the ML** with a **.295** AVG vs. LHP...**Josh Donaldson** ranks **6th** in the AL with a **.342** AVG & has hit more HR vs. LHP than any player since **2013** (31-HR).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN:

◆ Today, TOR continues a 6-game road trip with the **finale** of a 3-game set at **OAK**...Following this series, conclude the trip with a 3-game set at **SEA (43-52)**...Are **20-29** on the road, having lost **11** of their last **17** games...Despite the **6-11** record, TOR has pitched to a **3.57** ERA (60ER/151.1)...Have lost their last **three** completed series (**4-8** record over span) on the road, **2nd** time this year...Are looking to avoid losing **four straight series on the road** for the 1st time since **June 17-July 13, 2014 (0-3** at NYY, **1-2** at CIN, **0-4** at OAK, **1-2** at LAA & **1-2** at TB)...Have lost **four** of their last **five** completed series, going **14-18** over that stretch...Of their **20** victories, all but **two** have been with TOR scoring **five runs or more**.

BLUE JAYS vs. ATHLETICS:

◆ **All-Time:183-212...All-Time, O.CO Coliseum: 94-105...2015: 1-1**
 ◆ The Jays snapped **4-game** losing skid with Tuesday night's victory...It was their longest losing skid since **2007-2008 (5-games)**...Overall, TOR has dropped **9** of their last **16** meetings since **2013**...Prior to that win, had lost **four** straight in OAK (4G sweep in last series-2014), most consecutive losses in that park since **1997-1998**...TOR have lost **13** of their last **21** games at OAK since **2010**.
 ◆ **Jose Reyes** has hit safely in **13** of his **14** games, batting **.310** (18-58) with **6-SB** over that span.

RUNNING AWAY WITH IT:

◆ Have scored a **ML leading 508** runs, **77** more runs than DET who are **2nd** (**431**)...Are averaging **5.29** runs/game while DET are the next closest at **4.59**, a **0.70** R/G difference...Have the **2nd** best run differential in the ML at **+94** (STL+104)...Have recorded **37**, **4+** run innings, **19**, **5+** run innings & **10**, **6+** run innings this year...TOR has had **16**, **10+** run games this year which is their most since **2003** (19).
 ◆ Became the quickest team in the ML to **500** runs (**95th** game) since BOS did it in **94** games in **2011**...It's the **4th** time that the Jays are the **1st** **MLB team to 500 runs** in a season (**1986, 2003, 2012**)...It was the fastest by TOR to **500** runs since the **2006** campaign (**94th** game).

◆ **Jose Bautista** ranks **2nd** on the club & **T-7th** in the AL with **20-HR** this season...Has hit **13** of those HR since **June 1** which ranks **4th** in the AL (**J.D. Martinez/Albert Pujols** lead with **18**)...Has **223** career HR as a Blue Jay which is **T-2nd** with **Vernon Wells** on the all-time club list...In fact, is just the **3rd** Jay to hit **20+** HR in **six** consecutive seasons joining **Carlos Delgado (9)** & **Joe Carter (7)** on that list.
 ◆ **Edwin Encarnacion** is **1-HR** shy of becoming the **6th** Blue Jay in club history to have at least **five** seasons of **20+** HR in a season.

◆ Among the AL, **Josh Donaldson** ranks **2nd** in TB (**199**), **3rd** in XBH (**46**), hits (**109**), **T-3rd** in multi-hit games (**34**), **4th** in RBI (**64**), **T-5th** in 2B (**24**), **6th** in HR (**22**), **7th** in SLG (**.534**) & **10th** in OPS (**.888**)...Ranks **3rd** in the ML in WAR (**4.8**) - **Bryce Harper** is **1st** (**6.9**) & **Mike Trout** ranks **2nd** (**6.2**)...**20** of his **22-HR** have come as a 3B (**T-3rd** in ML)...No **3B** in the ML has hit more HR than Josh (**71**) since **2013**...The **20-HR** are the most by any **TOR-3B** since **Encarnacion** had **20-HR** in **2010**...The last **TOR-3B** to hit more than **20-HR** was **Troy Glaus** in **2006 (33-HR)**...His **58-RBI** as a **3B** is the **most** by any **TOR-3B** since **Troy Glaus** had **61** in **2007**.

TONIGHT'S START & HIGHLIGHTS:

- ★ Will be making his 20th start of the season...Has recorded 6+ innings in 33 of his last 39 outings, dating back to June 14, 2014, however of the 6 outings with less than 6+IP, 5 have come in 2015...Is T-1st in the AL with 10 losses w/Kluber and Porcello.
- ★ Did not factor in the decision in his last start vs. TB on July 18 despite recording his 10th quality start of the season...In fact, has recorded a QS in seven of his last nine outings (1-5, 3.49 ERA, 22-ER, 56.2 IP) while receiving just 3.1 R/G over that stretch...Has received 3.7 R/G for the entire season (19-GS, 70R).
- ★ Comes into today with a 0-7 record on the road...Is the only MLB pitcher to have not won on the road with at least 6 decisions...Has lost four straight decisions overall and five of six over nine starts, even though he has allowed 3 or less in all but one of the nine...In his last five outings, Jays have scored nine total runs
- ★ Won for the 1st time in his career when issuing at least 5-BB (11th time) on June 18 vs. NYM...Marked the 2nd time this year he has recorded at least 7.0 IP while allowing 1-ER...Only run came on HR (Duda), #200 allowed in career.
- ★ Tossed his 1st CG of the season & 14th of his career vs. LAA on May 21... Was his 5th CG as a Blue Jay & 1st since July 3, 2014 at OAK (loss)... Was his 1st CG in a victory since June 26, 2013 at TB (shutout)...Prior to this start had lost his last three starts in which he recorded a complete game...Marked his 1st career CG at Rogers Centre...The eight runs he received in support was the most this year, previous most was four runs received at HOU on May 15...His 7-SO were a season high & the most since July 28, 2014 at BOS (10-SO).
- ★ Failed to strike out a batter in two consecutive starts May 4-10 (1st time in his career) & in three of four outings from April 24-May 10...Went 16.0 IP without a strikeout.
- ★ Since joining the Blue Jays has allowed 78 home runs, the most in MLB...Dan Haren in 2nd with 72...Has allowed just 17 stolen bases over that span.
- ★ Became the 4th different Blue Jay pitcher to win a game at 40+ years of age with his win vs. NYY on May 4...Joins Darren Oliver (6x), Dan Plesac (1x) & Dave Stieb (1x) on that list.

VS. THE A's:

- ★ Has yet to win a game in Oakland in seven career appearances (five starts) despite a 2.92 ERA...In fact has allowed just 2 ER over his last 14 innings over his last two starts in Oakland earning a loss and a no-decision...Has tossed 7+IP in four of his last five overall vs. OAK.

CAREER NOTES:

- ★ Became the 10th pitcher since 1900 to record consecutive one-hitters (June 12, 2012 at TB and June 18, 2012 vs. BAL).
- ★ Won his 1st career Gold Glove in 2013 after posting a .962 fielding percentage, beating out teammate Mark Buehrle.
