THE LATEST:Last night, TOR lost game #2 of their series at OAK, 4-3 in 10 innings to fall to **48-48**...Lost on a walk-off infield single by **Ike Davis** in the 10^{th} frame...It was the 4^{th} time TOR has lost in walk-off fashion this year (last: July 8 at CWS) & are now 8-11 when the game is decided in the final at bat...Fall to 3-4 in extra-inning games (2-3 on the road), having lost three of the last four of those affairs...Left 11 men on base & went 2-for-10 with RISP in the loss...Have lost 12 of their last **19** games, however, have outscored the opposition, **88-82** over that stretch...Are looking to win **back-to-back series** for the 1^{st} time since June 22-28 (2-1 at TB, 2-1 vs. TEX)...Are 14-18 since their 11-G win streak & are outscoring the opposition **152-129** (+23), despite the losing record...The pitching staff has allowed **3-ER or less** in **five** straight & in **nine** of their last **11** contests (**2.95** ERA, 32ER/97.2).

ABOUT LAST NIGHT:

- **Felix Doubront** lasted 4.2 IP (7H, 2ER) in his **3**rd start with TOR...The bullpen worked 5.0 IP (4H, 2BB, 6K) allowing just the one run in the 10th inning (Osuna-4th loss)...The bullpen has allowed just **3**-ER over their last **14.0** IP (**1.93** ERA).
- Danny Valencia went 2-for-4 & launched his 7th HR of the season, 5th vs. a RHP...Is batting .331 (40-121) with a .926 OPS as a starter this year (32-GS)...Russell Martin matched his season high with three hits (6th time) & has hit safely in seven of his last eight games (.323, 10-31, 5-RBI)...Jose Reyes went 1-for-4 with a BB & is batting .347 (26-75) with a .812 OPS over his last 17G.

PILLAR OF STRENGTH

Since June 1, Kevin Pillar is batting .335 (54-161) with 9-2B, 1-3B, 5-HR, 20-RBI & a .854 OPS (43-games)...Among the AL since that point, ranks 3rd in AVG & T-4th in hits...Among all OF, ranks T-2nd in defensive runs saved with 13 (K. Kiermaier leads with 24).

DID YOU KNOW?:

- TOR has homered in five straight games (9-HR) & rank 3rd in the ML this month with **25**-HR (DET/LAA-**28**)...No team has hit more HR in the month of **July** since **2010** than TOR-**183** (BAL $2^{nd} - 171$).
- TOR starters have allowed 2-ER or less in five straight & 11 of their last 13 outlings since July 5 (2.63 ERA, 24ER/82.0, 3HR)...Their 2.63 ERA over that span ranks 2nd in the AL (LAA leads at 2.12). That TOR leads the ML with a .295 AVG vs. LHP...Josh Donaldson ranks 6th in the AL with a .342 AVG & has hit more HR

The 20-HR are the most by any TOP-2P since 2013...The 20-HR are the most by any TOR-3B since Encarnacion had 20-HR in 2010...The last TOR-3B to hit more than 20-HR was Troy Glaus in 2006 (33-HR)...His 58-RBI as a 3B is the most by any TOR-3B since Troy Glaus had 61 in 2007.

TONIGHT'S START & HIGHLIGHTS:

- Will be making his 20th start of the season...Has recorded 6+ innings in 33 of his last 39 outings, dating back to June 14, 2014, however of the 6 outings with less than 6+IP, 5 have come in 2015...Is T-1st in the AL with 10 losses w/Kluber and Porcello.
- Did not factor in the decision in his last start vs. TB on July 18 despite recording his 10th quality start of the season...In fact, has recorded a QS in seven of his last nine outings (1-5, 3.49 ERA, 22-ER, 56.2 IP) while receiving just 3.1 R/G over that stretch...Has received 3.7 R/G for the entire season (19-GS, 70R).
- Comes into today with a 0-7 record on the road...Is the only MLB pitcher to have not won on the road with at least 6 decisions...Has lost four straight decisions overall and five of six over nine starts, even though he has allowed 3 or less in all but one of the nine...In his last five outings, Jays have scored nine total runs
- Won for the 1st time in his career when issuing at least 5-BB (11th time) on June 18 vs. NYM...Marked the 2nd time this year he has recorded at least 7.0 IP while allowing 1-ER...Only run came on HR (Duda), #200 allowed in career.
- Tossed his 1st CG of the season & 14th of his career vs. LAA on May 21... Was his 5th CG as a Blue Jay & 1st since July 3, 2014 at OAK (loss)... Was his 1st CG in a victory since June 26, 2013 at TB (shutout)...Prior to this start had lost his last three starts in which he recorded a complete game...Marked his 1st career CG at Rogers Centre...The eight runs he received in support was the most this year, previous most was four runs received at HOU on May 15...His 7-SO were a season high & the most since July 28, 2014 at BOS (10-SO).
- Failed to strike out a batter in two consecutive starts May 4-10 (1st time in his career) & in three of four outings from April 24-May 10...Went 16.0 IP without a strikeout.
- Since joining the Blue Jays has allowed 78 home runs, the most in MLB...Dan Haren in 2nd with 72...Has allowed just 17 stolen bases over that span.
- Became the 4th different Blue Jay pitcher to win a game at 40+ years of age with his win vs. NYY on May 4...Joins Darren Oliver (6x), Dan Plesac (1x) & Dave Stieb (1x) on that list.

VS. THE A's:

Has yet to win a game in Oakland in seven career appearances (five starts) despite a 2.92 ERA...In fact has allowed just 2 ER over his last 14 innings over his last two starts in Oakland earning a loss and a no-decision...Has tossed 7+IP in four of his last five overall vs. OAK.
