OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics were held to a season-low one hit... are now 10-25 in one-run games... have lost seven of the last eight games and are 4-9 since the All-Star Break...finished 10-14 in the month of July...it is the first time they finished July with a losing record since 2009 (12-14)...have committed 90 errors... are 0-2 on their season-long 11 game homestand against Cleveland (0-2), Baltimore (three games), and Houston (four games).
- Kendall Graveman is 0-3 with a 6.63 ERA (14 er in 19.0 ip) over his last four starts...is 5-5 with a 2.94 ERA (26 er in 79.2 ip) since his return to the A's on May 23...is 2-4 with a 4.63 ERA (24 er in 46.2 ip) in eight starts at home.
- Billy Burns (0-for-4, 2 k) is batting .353 (54-for-153) at home compared to .250 (42-for-168) on the road.
- Josh Reddick (0-for-4) is 13-for-37 (.351) with five doubles, two home runs and seven RBI over his last 11 games...is batting .295 (23-for-78) in July.
- Eric Sogard (1-for-3) is batting .167 (7-for-42) in 16 games in July.
- Stephen Vogt (0-for-3) is 0 for his last 21.

- The Cleveland Indians have won three consecutive games...are 28-22 on the road this season...15-9 in games played against American League West compeition...are 13-13 in July...are 2-0 on their seven game road trip against Oakland (2-0) and Los Angeles-AL (three games).
- Danny Salazar is 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 er in 16.2 ip) in his career against Oakland...2-2 with a 1.53 ERA (5 er in 29.1 ip) over his last four starts...is 5-2 with a 2.95 ERA (19 er in 58.0 ip) in nine starts on the road this season.
- Mike Aviles (0-for-4, k) is 0 for his last 21.
- Michael Brantley (1-for-4) extended his hitting streak to five games...has hit safely in 41 of his last 51 games...is batting .346 (18-for-52) since the All-Star
- Michael Bourn (1-for-3, 2b, rbi, bb, sb) is 14-for-36 (.389) since the All-Star Break.
- Lonnie Chisenhall (3-for-4, r, sb) recorded his third three-hit game of the season...it is his eighth multi-hit game of the season...recorded his first stolen base since Sep. 28, 2014 against Tampa Bay.
- Francisco Lindor (1-for-3, bb, k) is 20-for-59 (.339) since the All-Star Break.
- Carlos Santana (1-for-4, k) extended his hitting streak to seven games...is batting .280 (7-for-25) over that span.
