OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics snapped a three-game losing streak and won for just the second time in the last nine games...improved to 5-9 (.357) since the All-Star Break...are 22-31 at home...are batting .170 (31-for-182) with 15 runs scored in six games against Clevleand this year...have committed 91 errors, which is the most in the Majors...are 1-2 on this season-long 11-game homestand against Cleveland (1-2), Baltimore (three games), and Houston (four games).
- Aaron Brooks made his Athletics debut and his second career Major League start (previous: May 31, 2014 at Toronto)...earned his first career Major League win...had his longest outing of the season, including 18 appearances (17 starts) for Triple-A Omaha and two relief appearances for the Kansas City Royals (previous: 7, four times at Triple-A Omaha).
- Billy Butler (2-for-4, r, rbi, so) had his 23rd multiple hit game of the year.
- Ike Davis (1-for-4, 2b) is now batting .286 (32-for-112) at night compared to .169 (12-for-71) during the day.
- Sam Fuld (2-for-3, r, rbi, bb) had his ninth multiple hit game of the season.
- Max Muncy's (1-for-3, 2b) last four hits have been doubles and 10 of his 17 hits this season are for extra bases (eight doubles, two home runs).
- Josh Reddick's (0-for-4, so) fourth-inning strikeout was just his third in 48 at-bats since the All-Star Break...is hitless in his last 13 at-bats.
- Marcus Semien (1-for-2, 2 r, hr, rbi, bb) snapped a string of 17 consecutive games without an RBI, the longest of his career...hit his first home run since July 8 at New York-AL.
- Stephen Vogt (0-for-4, so) is hitless in his last 25 at-bats...is 17-for-103 (.165) with five RBI over his last 26 games.

CLEVELAND NOTES

Lonnie Chisenhall (5)

- The Cleveland Indians snapped their three-game winning streak...lost for just the fifth time in their last 15 road games...fell to 28-23 on the road this season...are 41-41 since May 1...have lost eight of their last 13 games at the O.co Coliseum and are 7-8 in Oakland since the start of the 2012 season...are 2-1 on this seven game road trip against Oakland (2-1) and Los Angeles-AL (three games).
- Cody Anderson made his first career start against the Athletics and his second career start against an American League West opponent...is 1-1 with a 3.23 ERA (9 er in 25.1 ip) in four road starts compared to 1-1 with a 3.60 ERA (8 er in 20.0 ip) in three starts at home...allowed just the second home run of his career to a right-handed batter compared to four allowed to left-handed hitters.
- Mike Aviles (0-for-3) is hitless in his last 24 at-bats.
- Michael Brantley (1-for-4, so) extended his hitting streak to six games...has hit safely in 42 of his last 52 games...is batting .339 (19-for-56) since the All-Star Break.
- Michael Bourn (1-for-3, 2 so) is 15-for-39 (.385) since the All-Star Break.
- Lonnie Chisenhall (1-for-4, r, hr, rbi, 2 so) is 4-for-11 (.364) with one double, one home run and two runs since being recalled from Triple-A Columbus on July 30.

- Francisco Lindor (1-for-4, so) is 21-for-63 (.333) since the All-Star Break.
- Carlos Santana (0-for-4, so) snapped his seven-game hitting streak...batted .280 (7-for-25) over that span.
