OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won two straight games...are 20-17 against Cleveland dating back to 2011...are 6-9 (.400) since the All-Star Break...are 23-31 at home...are 6-12 in the last at-bat...are 4-6 in extra innings...are 2-2 on this season-long 11-game homestand against Cleveland (2-2), Baltimore (three games), and Houston (four games).
- A's starting pitchers have allowed one run or fewer in four of the last six games and are 2-1 with a 1.71 ERA (8 er in 42.0 ip) over that span.
- Sonny Gray is 2-0 with a 0.64 ERA (2 er in 28.0 ip) in four career starts against Cleveland...is 1-1 with a 2.48 ERA (8 er in 29.0 ip) in four starts since the All-Star Break...is 5-1 with a 0.97 (6 er in 55.2 ip) in eight starts during the day.
- Mark Canha (1-for-3, rbi) recorded his first career walk-off hit.
- Fernando Abad has not allowed a run in his last 10 appearances (10.2 ip).
- Billy Burns (1-for-3, rbi, bb) is batting .353 (55-for-156) in Oakland this season.
- Billy Butler (1-for-3, k) is 7-for-37 (.189) over his last 11 games.
- Josh Reddick (0-for-2) was removed from the game in the fifth inning with lower back tightness.
- Eric Sogard (1-for-3, r, bb, k) is batting .172 (5-for-29) since the All-Star Break.

CLEVELAND NOTES

- The Cleveland Indians have lost two straight games and 12 of their last 18...are now 28-24 on the road this season...have lost nine of their last 14 games at the O.co Coliseum and are 7-9 in Oakland since the start of the 2012 season...are 15-12 against American League West competition this season...are 2-2 on this seven game road trip against Oakland (2-2) and Los Angeles-AL (three games).
- Trevor Bauer made his first career start against Oakland...is 0-3 with a 4.91 ERA (14 er in 25.2 ip) in his last four starts...is 2-2 with a 3.16 ERA (11 er in 31.1 ip) in five starts this season against American League West competition...is 5-3 with a 2.35 ERA (17 er in 65 ip) in 10 road starts this season.
- Mike Aviles (1-for-4) snapped an 0-for-27 hitless streak with an infield single in the top of the 10th inning.
- Michael Bourn (0-for-3, bb, k) is 15-for-42 (.357) since the All-Star Break.
- Michael Brantley (1-for-3, bb, k) extended his hitting streak to seven games...has hit safely in 43 of his last 53 games...is batting .339 (20-for-59) since the All-Star Break.
- Lonnie Chisenhall (1-for-3, r, 2 bb, k) is 5-for-14 (.357) with one double, one home run and three runs since being recalled from Triple-A Columbus on July 30.
- Francisco Lindor (0-for-5, k) is 21-for-68 (.309) since the All-Star Break.
