OAKLAND NOTES

• The Oakland Athletics have lost four of the last six games and eight of the last 11...are 6-10 (.375) since the All-Star Break...fell to 23-32 at home...are batting .223 (235-for-1054) with 100 runs scored over the last 32 games (3.12 runs per game)...have scored two runs or fewer in 17 of those contests...have committed a Major League leading 92 errors...are 2-3 on this season-long 11-game homestand against Cleveland (2-2), Baltimore (0-1), and Houston (four games).

• Jesse Chavez is 3-6 with a 5.68 ERA (37 er in 58.2 ip) and .311 (75-for-241) opponents batting average over his last 11 starts after going 2-5 with a 2.38 ERA and .221 opponents batting average over his first eight starts...is 5-11 with a 4.11 ERA (51 er in 111.2 ip) in his 19 starting assignments...has received two runs of support or fewer in 13 of his 19 starts.

- Felix Doubront made his Athletics debut after going 1-1 with a 4.76 ERA (12 er in 22.2 ip) in five appearances (four starts) for the Toronto Blue Jays this year...faced the Athletics on July 22 at the Coliseum and allowed three runs (two earned) in 4.2 innings pitched...turned in the second-longest relief appearance of his career (longest: May 8, 2013, 5.1 ip vs. Minnesota).
- Billy Burns (0-for-4, so) is 5-for-32 (.156) over his last 10 games, which has dropped his average to .295.
- Billy Butler (0-for-4, 2 so) is 7-for-42 (.167) with no extra-base hits over his last 12 games.
- Coco Crisp (2-for-4, r) had his first multiple hit game of the year...doubled his hit total for the year after being reinstated from the 60-day disabled list today... was 2-for-45 (.044) in 13 games, including 11 starts (all in left field) entering play.
- Eric Sogard (1-for-3, r) has not committed an error since May 8 and has a 51-game errorless streak as a second baseman.
- Stephen Vogt (2-for-4, 2 2b, rbi) snapped his 0-for-28 hitless streak with a sixth-inning double...it was the second-longest hitless streak of his career...began his career with an 0-for-32 streak from April 26, 2012 to June 28, 2013...is 19-for-108 (.176) over his last 28 games...recorded his 25th multiple hit game of the year.

- The Baltimore Orioles have won eight of their last 10 games...improved to 8-10 against American League West competition...have a .283 (213-for-753) batting average with runners in scoring position...are 46-27 when hitting at least one home run and 39-11 when outhitting the opponent...are 1-0 on this nine game road trip to Oakland (1-0), Los Angeles-AL (three games) and Seattle (three games).
- Buck Showalter recorded his 1313th career victory as a manager, tying him with Hall of Famer Ned Hanlon for 31st all-time.
- Tyler Wilson made his first career appearance against the Athletics...set a new career-high with 7.2 innings pitched (previous: May 28, 6.0 ip vs. Chicago-AL)... has not allowed more than two runs in any of his seven Major League appearances (two starts).
- Chris Davis (1-for-5, r, hr, 3 rbi, 2 so) has homered five times in his last seven games...surpassed the 26 home runs and 72 RBI he had last season in 24 fewer games this year (127 games played last season).
- J.J. Hardy (2-for-5, r, so) recorded his 12th multiple hit game of the year...has at least one hit in 16 of his last 17 games.
- Adam Jones (3-for-5, r, 2b, rbi) had his 32nd multiple hit contest of the year and his seventh three-hit game of the season.
- Caleb Joseph (2-for-4, r, 2b, hr, 3 rbi) recorded his 13th multiple hit game of the year...homered and drove in three for the second consecutive game...the Orioles improved to 35-5 when he has at least one RBI and to 17-2 when he records at least two RBI.
- Jonathan Schoop (3-for-4, 2 r, 2b, so) had his ninth multiple hit contest of the year and his first three-hit game of the season.
- Matt Wieters (0-for-5, 2 so) had his six-game hitting streak snapped.
