OAKLAND NOTES

- **The Oakland Athletics** recorded their 14th shutout of the season...have won three of their last four games...are 7-10 (.412) since the All-Star Break...are now 24-32 at home...are 88-47 against Baltimore dating back to 1999...are 3-3 on this season-long 11-game homestand against Cleveland (2-2), Baltimore (1-1), and Houston (four games).
- **Chris Bassitt** made his first career start against Baltimore...snapped a four-game losing streak...recorded a career-high seven strikeouts...has allowed three runs or fewer and is 1-4 with a 2.43 ERA (10 er in 37.0 ip) in six starts this season...is 1-2 with a 2.25 ERA (5 er in 20.0 ip) in three starts since being recalled from Triple-A Nashville...has issued 13 of his 14 walks to left-handed hitters.
- **Billy Burns** (1-for-2, rbi, bb, hbp) is batting .344 (56-for-163) in Oakland this season.
- **Billy Butler** (1-for-3, 2b, bb) recorded his first extra-base hit in his last 13 games with a double in the sixth inning...is a .307 (67-for-218) career hitter against Baltimore.
- **Coco Crisp** (1-for-3, bb) is batting .500 (3-for-7) after being reinstated from the 60-day disabled list yesterday...is a .289 (82-for-284) hitter against Baltimore.
- **Brett Lawrie** (1-for-3, 3b, rbi, k) drove in a run in the sixth with his second triple of the season (last: June 29, 2015 vs. Colorado).
- **Marcus Semien** (1-for-3, hr, 3 rbi, r, k) has hit two home runs in his last four games.
- **Eric Sogard** (1-for-3, 2 r, 2b, bb, k) snapped a streak of 26 consecutive games without an extra base hit with a double in the fifth inning (last: double, June 17 against San Diego)...drew his first intentional walk since June 3, 2013.
- **Stephen Vogt** (0-for-4, 3 k) is 19-for-112 (.170) over his last 29 games.

BALTIMORE NOTES

- **The Baltimore Orioles** have lost two of their last three games...are now 8-11 against American League West competition...are 1-1 on this nine game road trip to Oakland (1-1), Los Angeles-AL (three games) and Seattle (three games).
- **Miguel Gonzalez** is 2-3 with a 5.81 ERA (17 er in 26.1 ip) in his last five starts...0-1 with a 5.40 ERA (7 er in 11.2 ip) in three career appearances (two starts) against Oakland...is 7-8 with a 3.81 ERA (47 er in 111.0 ip) in 19 career games (18 starts) against American League West competition.
- **Chris Davis** (1-for-3, 2b, bb, k) is batting .275 (11-for-40) and has six home runs and 19 RBI over his last 11 games.
- **J.J. Hardy** (1-for-4) has hit safely in 40 of his last 51 games...is batting .266 (50-for-188) over that span.
- **Manny Machado** (1-for-4) has hit safely in 72 of his last 93 games...is batting .309 (112-for-363) over that span.
- **Jonathan Schoop** (2-for-4, 2b, k) had his 10th multiple hit contest of the year.
- **Matt Wieters** (1-for-4, k) snapped an 0-for-10 hitless streak with a single in the top of the ninth inning.
