



# BALTIMORE ORIOLES GAME NOTES

Baltimore Orioles (54-51) at Oakland Athletics (47-60)

RHP Miguel Gonzalez (9-7, 4.28) vs. RHP Chris Bassitt (0-4, 3.10)



**JUST A LITTLE CRUSH:** 1B Chris Davis hit a home run and drove in three runs in the Orioles 9-2 win over the Athletics on Monday...Davis has six home runs and 19 runs batted in over his last 10 games...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the last Oriole to do so was also Davis, in his first 10 games of the 2013 season...Over the last 30 seasons, the only other players to do so for the Orioles were Albert Belle in June 2000 and Cal Ripken, Jr. in May/June 1996...Only one other player has had a 10-game span of this type in 2015 – Colorado's Carlos Gonzalez with eight homers and 19 RBI from July 11-27.

**CATCH THIS:** CA Caleb Joseph tied his career high on Monday at Oakland by notching three RBI...It marked the third time this season and the fifth time in his career that Joseph has collected three RBI...Joseph went 2-for-4 with a home run on the night...The Orioles improved to 35-5 when Joseph logs at least one RBI in his career and 17-2 when he records at least two RBI.

**START ME UP:** Since the 2014 All-Star break, tonight's starter RHP Miguel Gonzalez is 15-11 and owns a 3.46 ERA (69 ER/179.1 IP)...He has held opponents to a .245 batting average over that span...His 3.46 ERA in that time ranks 16th among qualifying AL starters.

**VS. OAKLAND:** The Orioles and Athletics play the second game of seven matchups between the two clubs this season...The Orioles lead the season series, 1-0...The A's will visit Camden Yards for a four-game series, August 14-17...The A's won the season series, 4-2, in 2014...The O's went 1-2 at Oriole Park and 1-2 at O.co Coliseum last year...Baltimore trails Oakland in the all-time series, 253-255, with the Orioles trailing 122-128 at home and leading 131-127 at Oakland.

**WHAT A LONG, STRANGE TRIP IT'S BEEN:** On Sunday, the Orioles completed a seven-game homestand with series against Atlanta (3-0) and Detroit (2-2)...Prior to the homestand, the O's finished a 10-day, nine-game road trip which included series wins at Detroit (2-1) and Tampa Bay (2-1)...In between series wins, the O's were swept in a three-game series at Yankee Stadium...Today, the Birds begin another 10-day, nine-game road trip with stops at Oakland (1-0), Los Angeles-AL (three games) and Seattle (three games).

**PACK 'EM IN:** Saturday night's attendance of 45,968 marked the seventh sellout of the season at Camden Yards...In 2014, the Orioles had eight home sellouts and drew a total of 2,458,970 at Oriole Park, the largest attendance figure since 2005 (2,624,740).

**TRADE WINDS:** On July 31, Major League Baseball's non-waiver trade deadline, the Orioles acquired OF Gerardo Parra from the Milwaukee Brewers in exchange for minor league RHP Zach Davies and designated RHP Bud Norris for assignment...RHP Mychal Givens was recalled from Double-A Bowie...OF Junior Lake was acquired from the Chicago Cubs in exchange for RHP Tommy Hunter...RHP Mike Wright was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk...Parra reported to the club and INF Chris Parmelee was designated for assignment.

**MAKE NO MISTAKE:** The Orioles have committed the fewest number of errors in the majors (41)...The Los Angeles Dodgers are the next-closest team with 44 and the nearest AL teams is the Detroit Tigers at 52...The Orioles lead the majors with a .989 team fielding percentage.

**HAPPY TO ASSIST:** The Orioles lead the Major Leagues with 31 outfield assists...Adam Jones has nine outfield assists, Travis Snider has five...According to FanGraphs, Orioles outfielders rank third in the American League with 17 defensive runs saved (DRS).

**OH, WHAT A RELIEF IT IS:** Since April 29, the Orioles bullpen leads the majors with a 2.36 ERA (67 ER/255.1 IP)...In that same time, Baltimore relievers have held opponents to a .224 clip, fifth in the majors...This season, Orioles relievers rank fourth in the majors and third in the AL with a 2.80 ERA (100 ER/321.2 IP)...Their .229 opponents' batting average ranks sixth in the majors...RHP Darren O'Day ranks tied for fifth in the majors among relief pitchers with a 1.35 ERA (6 ER/40.0 IP).

**RISP-Y BUSINESS:** The Orioles .283 team batting average with runners in scoring position ranks fourth in the majors this season...Baltimore trails San Francisco (.293), Colorado (.292), and Toronto (.288)...INF/OF Jimmy Paredes leads the team ranks seventh in the American League with a .356 (21-for-59) average with RISP.

**SAVING THE DAY:** LHP Zach Britton collected his 27<sup>th</sup> save of the season on Friday vs. Detroit...He ranks tied for seventh among Major League relievers and tied for second in the American League...Britton owns a 1.71 ERA (8 ER/42.0 IP) with 48 strikeouts and has held opposing hitters to a .204 average this season.

**IN GOOD COMPANY:** With a home run on Friday, OF Adam Jones hit his 183<sup>rd</sup> home run as an Oriole...With that homer, Jones passed OF Ken Singleton for sole possession of seventh place on the Orioles all-time home run list...OF Brady Anderson ranks sixth with 209 home runs...SS J.J. Hardy is seven home runs shy of 100 long balls with Baltimore...A total of 23 players have notched at least 100 homers for the Orioles.

**THIS DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY:** On this date in 1975, LF Don Baylor went 5-for-5 and scored four runs in a 12-8 win at Boston...Baylor notched four singles and a two-run homer while 3B Brooks Robinson had his first four-RBI game in exactly one year, and the last of his career.

**A GRAND ENTRANCE:** With his start in left field on Saturday against the Detroit Tigers, OF Gerardo Parra became the 1000<sup>th</sup> player to appear in a game for the Orioles since the team moved to Baltimore in 1954...RHP Jason Garcia, 2B Rey Navarro, RHP Mike Wright, RHP Tyler Wilson, RHP Oliver Drake and RHP Mychal Givens made their Major League debuts this season...RHP Chaz Roe, CA Ryan Lavarney, LHP Cesar Cabral and INF/OF Chris Parmelee also made their Orioles debuts this season.

**DISABLED LIST:** Two Orioles are currently on the 15-day disabled list...INF/OF Steve Pearce (retroactive to July 19 with a left oblique strain) and RHP Mike Wright (August 1 with a left calf strain) are currently on the 15-day DL...RHP Jason Garcia is currently on the 60-day DL (retroactive to May 11 with right shoulder tendinitis).

**THE SKIPPER:** Buck Showalter (1313) has tied Ned Hanlon-HOF (1313) for 31<sup>st</sup> on the all-time managerial wins list...He trails Chuck Tanner (1352) for 30<sup>th</sup> all-time...His 431 wins as O's manager are third-most in club history, trailing Earl Weaver (1480) and Paul Richards (517) on the club's all-time list...Showalter recently won his third Manager of the Year award (1994, 2004, 2014) and is in his sixth season as O's manager.

**QUICK HITS:** Making his 20<sup>th</sup> start of the season...Made his MLB debut May 29, 2012 at Toronto...Notched first major league win in his first MLB start July 6, 2012 at Los Angeles (AL)...Missed 2008 with a torn meniscus and 2009 after "Tommy John" surgery...Attended Mission (CA) CC...Had his first child, **Leah**, on June 18, 2013.

**CAREER VS. OAKLAND:** Is 0-0 with a 5.68 ERA (6.1IP, 4ER) in two career appearances (one start) against the Oakland Athletics...Last started against the A's on April 28, 2013 at the O.co Coliseum (ND, 5.1IP, 7H, 4ER, 2BB, 4K).

**AGAINST THE AL WEST:** Gonzalez has gone 7-7 with a 3.75 ERA (105.2IP, 44ER) and 11 Quality Starts in 18 career games (17 starts) vs. the American League West...This season, he is 1-2 with a 6.50 ERA (18.0IP, 13ER) in three outings against AL West opponents despite striking out 17.

**LAST START:** Suffered the loss, July 30 vs. Detroit at Oriole Park (3.1IP, 10H, 5ER, BB, K)...Surrendered a career-high 10 hits for the second time this season (also, May 24 at Miami)...Recorded 3.1 innings of work, tied for the second shortest start of his career (also, April 4, 2014 at Detroit) behind a 2.2 inning outing on July 25, 2012 vs. Tampa Bay.

**LIGHTS OUT:** Gonzalez owns a 3.95 ERA (84.1IP, 37ER) in 14 night starts and a 5.40 ERA (25.0IP, 15ER) in five day starts this season...In his career, he has posted a 3.56 ERA (379.0IP, 150ER) in night contests and a 3.74 ERA (166.0IP, 69ER) during day games.

**START ME UP:** Since the 2014 All-Star break, Gonzalez is 15-11 and owns a 3.46 ERA (179.1IP, 69ER)...He has held opponents to a .245 batting average over that span...His 3.46 ERA in that time ranks 16<sup>th</sup> among qualifying AL starters.

**ON THE ROAD:** Is 6-4 with a 3.97 ERA (56.2IP, 25ER) in 10 road starts this season...**Has gone 4-0 with a 3.04 ERA (23.2IP, 8ER) over his last four road starts this season, allowing two runs or fewer in three of the four outings...**In his 48 career road starts, he is 22-16 with a 3.56 ERA (286.0IP, 113ER) and 29 Quality Starts...The Birds are 26-22 in those 48 games.

**MINIMIZE THE DAMAGE:** Has surrendered 18 home runs this season (11 of which have been solo home runs)...Of the 80 homers he has allowed in the majors, 58 have been solo shots...Six were leadoff homers, 15 have come on the first pitch of an at-bat, and 27 have come within the first two innings.

**DL STINT:** Was placed on the 15-day disabled list, June 11 (retroactive to June 10), with a right groin strain...Made one start on a Major League rehab assignment, June 20 with Double-A Bowie (W, 5.0IP, 4H, 2ER, BB, 4K).

**MAGIC 8.0IP BALL:** After logging 8.0 or more innings pitched for the sixth time in his career on May 29 vs. Tampa Bay, Gonzalez is now 3-0 with a 0.92 ERA (49.0IP, 45ER) when surpassing the 8.0IP threshold, not factoring in the decision in three of those six outings...Four of those six starts have come within the last two seasons, including his first career complete game, September 3, 2014 vs. Cincinnati (see YOU COMPLETE ME below).

**SIT THEM DOWN:** On April 14 vs. New York (AL), Gonzalez recorded a career-high 10 strikeouts, **a 2015 season-high by an Orioles pitcher**...Gonzalez had struck out nine twice in his career prior to the April 14 start (last, June 27, 2013 vs. Cleveland).

**BLANKED:** After turning in 7.2 scoreless innings in his May 2 start against the Rays at Tropicana Field, it marked his second career start of 7.2 or more innings pitched without allowing a run...His only other such start was his first career complete game when he blanked the Cincinnati Reds, September 3, 2014 at OPACY over 9.0 innings...He became the third Orioles pitcher since 2012 to log such a start against an AL East opponent (also, **Bud Norris** on June 9, 2014 vs. Boston; 8.0IP, 3H, 6K and **Jake Arrieta** on May 2, 2012 at Yankee Stadium; 8.0IP, 5H, 9K).

**NO-DECISION:** Prior to his April 24 start vs. Boston in which he did not factor in the decision, Gonzalez had earned a decision in all 12 of his starts from August 2, 2014-April 19, 2015 (last ND was July 27, 2014 at Seattle), going 7-5 in that span and posting a 2.31 ERA (74.0IP, 19ER) with seven Quality Starts.

**AT ORIOLE PARK:** Is 3-3 with a 4.61 ERA (52.2IP, 27ER) in nine starts at Oriole Park this season...His loss on June 30 vs. Texas was his first home loss since September 21, 2014 vs. Boston...In his 40 career home starts, he is 17-12 with a 3.76 ERA (244.0IP, 102ER) and the Orioles are 25-15 in those games...As a reliever at home, he has a 2.45 ERA (7.1IP, 2ER) in three appearances...In 43 total appearances, is 17-12 with a 3.72 ERA (251.1IP, 104ER).

**YOU COMPLETE ME:** On September 3, 2014 vs. Cincinnati, Gonzalez logged his first career complete game shutout, allowing just four hits over a career-high 9.0 innings...He struck out a 2014 season-high eight batters and tossed a career-high 117 pitches (83 strikes).
