OAKLAND NOTES

- **The Oakland Athletics** have lost 10 of the last 14 games and are 7-12 (.368) since the All-Star Break...are 3-7 overall against Houston this year and 0-4 against them at the Coliseum...have committed 94 errors...are 3-5 on this season-long 11-game homestand against Cleveland (2-2), Baltimore (1-2), and Houston (0-1).
- **Aaron Brooks** is 1-0 with a 0.63 ERA (2 er in 14.1 ip) in two starts since the Athletics acquired him from Kansas City on July 28...joined Kevin Appier, Ron Darling and Rich Harden as the only Oakland pitchers with seven innings or more and one run allowed or fewer in each of his first two games with the team...set a career high with seven strikeouts (previous: 5, August 1 vs. Cleveland).
- **Fernando Abad** allowed his first run since July 8 at New York-AL...had gone 11 consecutive outings without giving up a run (11.2 ip, 5 h, 2 bb, 13 so).
- **Fernando Rodriguez** allowed his first home run as an Athletic...his 34.0 innings pitched entering tonight were second most among American Leaguers that had not allowed a home run.
- **Billy Burns** (0-for-5, rbi) committed his first error of the season (82 games) and the second of his career (previous: July 30, 2014 at Houston).
- **Brett Lawrie** (2-for-4, 2 r, hr, rbi) had his 27th multiple hit game of the season...is batting .343 (12-for-35) with two home runs and seven RBI in nine games against the Astros this season.
- **Eric Sogard** (1-for-3, 2b, bb) snapped his 52-game errorless streak as a second baseman with a second-inning miscue...he had not committed an error since May 8...extended his hitting streak to six games with a third-inning double and is 6-for-18 (.333) with four runs scored over that stretch.

HOUSTON NOTES

- **The Houston Astros** snapped their three-game losing streak...have won their last five games at the O.co Coliseum...lead the majors with 153 home runs...are 50-29 when hitting at least one homer...are 1-3 on this nine-game road trip to Texas (0-3), Oakland (1-0) and San Francisco (two games).
- **Scott Feldman** is 1-0 with a 3.55 ERA (5 er in 12.2 ip) in two starts against the Athletics this year...is 6-9 with a 5.63 ERA (80 er in 128.0 ip) in 29 career appearances (20 starts) against the Athletics...has a 3.65 ERA (10 er in 24.2 ip) in four starts since being activated from the 15-day Disabled List on July 18.
- **Jose Altuve** (3-for-5, 2 r, so, sb) is batting .364 (16-for-44) with one double, two home runs and five RBI in 10 games against the Athletics this year...has hit .343 (70-for-204) with 10 doubles, four home runs and 21 RBI in his career against Oakland... recorded his 33rd multiple hit game of the year and his seventh against the Athletics.
- **Carlos Correa** (2-for-4, r, hr, 2 rbi, bb) snapped his 0-for-11 streak with a first-inning single...is batting .319 (22-for-69) with four doubles, seven home runs and 17 RBI in 19 games since the All-Star Break.
- **Carlos Gomez** (1-for-4, r, 2 so) is hitting .290 (9-for-31) in seven games since the Astros acquired him from Milwaukee on July 30...has hit .377 (29-for-77) with seven doubles, four home runs and 14 RBI in 19 games against American League opponents this season.
- **Jed Lowrie** (1-for-3, r, 2b, 2 rbi, bb) extended his hitting streak to five games with a go-ahead RBI double in the 10th...is batting .353 (6-for-17) during the streak, which dates to August 1.
