OAKLAND NOTES

- **The Oakland Athletics** are 8-12 (.400) since the All-Star Break...are 4-5 on this season-long 11-game homestand against Cleveland (2-2), Baltimore (1-2), and Houston (1-1).
- **Sonny Gray** threw his third complete game of the season...has compiled a 1.13 ERA (4 er in 32.0 ip) and .193 (21-for-109) opponents batting average over his last four starts...is 4-3 with a 2.50 ERA (22 er in 79.1 ip) in 11 starts at home compared to 8-1 with a 1.64 ERA (15 er in 82.1 ip) in 12 starts on the road.
- **Billy Burns** (2-for-3, rbi, sf) recorded his 28th infield hit in the first inning, which is first in the American League.
- **Brett Lawrie** (0-for-3, hbp) is 4-for-27 (.148) on the homestand and is batting .198 (16-for-81) over his last 22 games.
- **Josh Phegley** (2-for-4, 2b, rbi, roe) is batting .321 (26-for-81) against left handed pitching compared to .217 (15-for-69) against right-handers.
- **Marcus Semien** (3-for-4, gidp) is 9-for-22 (.410) with two home runs and six RBI over his last seven games...had two home runs and seven RBI over his previous 68 games.

HOUSTON NOTES

- **The Houston Astros** are 1-4 on this nine-game road trip to Texas (0-3), Oakland (1-1) and San Francisco (two games).
- **Dallas Keuchel** is 3-6 with a 2.45 ERA (20 er in 73.1 ip) on the road compared to 10-0 with a 1.26 ERA (12 er in 85.2 ip) at home...has gone at least 6.0 innings in 34 consecutive starts which is the longest active streak in the majors.
- **Jose Altuve** (1-for-4) is batting .354 (17-for-48) with one double, two home runs and five RBI in 10 games against the Athletics this year...has hit .341 (71-for-208) with 10 doubles, four home runs and 21 RBI in his career against Oakland...has hit safely in 18 straight games at O.co Coliseum.
- **Evan Gattis** (0-for-3) is batting .105 (2-for-19) on the Astros current nine-game road trip.
