## OAKLAND ATHLETICS (51-66) VS. BALTIMORE ORIOLES (58-56)

SATURDAY, AUGUST 15, 2015 - CAMDEN YARDS - 7:05 P.M. EDT RHP CHRIS BASSITT (1-4, 2.48) VS. RHP MIGUEL GONZALEZ (9-8, 4.45) CSNCA - A'S RADIO NETWORK (95.7 FM THE GAME)

ABOUT THE A'S: Have lost four straight games to start the road trip after winning each of the final three games on the last homestand...are now 7-14 (.33) over the last 21 games and are 51-66 (.436) for the season, which is the worst record in the American League...have spent 91 of the last 95 days in sole possession of last place in the AL West (dating back to May 8)...the 91 days alone in last are second most by an A's team over the last 17 years (162 in 2009)...went 14-30 (.318) over the first 44 games through May 22, 20-11 (.645) over a 31-game stretch from May 23 to June 25, and are 17-25 (.405) since then...have spent six days in sole possession of first, three days tied for first, five days in second, three days tied for second, two days in third, five days tied for third, nine days in fourth, three days tied for fourth and 91 days in fifth.

STARTING PITCHING: A's starting pitchers have allowed 19 runs in the first four games of the trip (17 er in 17.1 ip, 8.83 ERA) after allowing 19 runs in 11 games on the last homestand (2.19 ERA)...starters have a 3.19 ERA for the season, which is second lowest in the majors (St. Louis, 2.78)...in the designated hitter era, the lowest ERAs by an American League starting pitching staff are 2.98 (Oakland, 1974), 3.08 (New York, 1978) and 3.16 (Oakland and New York, 1981)...lead the AL in fewest home runs (57) and most innings pitched (708.1) and are fourth in complete games (5).

PITCHING: The A's are second in the American League and rank sixth in the majors with a 3.50 ERA...lead the AL and are tied for second in the majors with 14 shutouts...also lead the AL in opponents slugging percentage (.364), have allowed the third fewest home runs (99) and are third in opponents batting average (.239)...are second in on-base percentage (.299) and fewest extra base hits (282).

OFFENSE: The A's are hitting .231 (324-for-1401) with 135 runs scored over the last 42 games (3.21 runs per game) dating back to June 26...hit .261 and averaged 4.55 runs per game over their first 75 contests...for the season, the A's are tied for the fewest home runs in the American League (91), rank third in fewest strikeouts (779) and doubles (205), and fourth in stolen base percentage (65-for-86, 75.6%) and triples (28)...lead the AL and are tied for second in the majors in infield hits (121)...are last in the majors with 11 sacrifice hits.

**DEFENSIVE DOINGS:** The A's have committed 96 errors, which is the most in the majors...Marcus Semien has 30 and Brett Lawrie 20, which rank first and second in the American League...the 50 errors are the most by two teammates since Carlos Guillen (28) and Brandon Inge (22) combined for 50 for the 2006 Detroit Tigers...the last time two teammates had more than 50 errors was in 2000 for the Anaheim Angels, who had 52 from  $\,$ Troy Glaus (33) and Adam Kennedy (19)...this marks the first time the A's have two players with 20 or more errors since 1983 (Phillips 30, Almon 20)...the A's 96 errors have led to 49 unearned runs, which is second most in the majors (San Diego, 53)... A's outfielders have 17 assists, which are tied for the fewest in the AL.

**ONE AND TWO-RUN GAMES:** The A's are 13-26 (.333) in one-run games, which is the tied for the worst record in the majors (Toronto, 12-24)...the Oakland record for lowest winning percentage in one-run games is .381 in 1980...the 26 losses are the most in the majors and second most by an A's team over the last 28 years (had 28 last year)...the 39 games are tied for third most in the American League...13 of the A's last 19 games have been decided by two runs or fewer and the A's are 21-41 (.339) in those games for the season, which is the second worst record in the majors (Miami, 18-37. .327).

OTHER CLOSE CALLS: The A's are 4-9 (.308) in extra inning games, which is the fourth worst record in the American League...are tied for second in most extra-inning games (13)...are 7-15 in games decided in the last at bat...the last at bat wins are second fewest in the majors and the losses are tied for second most in the AL...have four walk-off wins in their last 16 home games after collecting just one over their first 45 home contests.

SINCE THE ALL-STAR BREAK: The A's are 10-16 (.385) since the All-Star Break, which is the third worst record in the American League...are batting .232 (205-for-882) with 86 runs scored (3.31 runs per game)  $\ldots$  have scored the second fewest runs in the majors, have hit the third fewest home runs (17), and have the fourth lowest batting average.

HOME AND AWAY: The A's are 0-4 on their final road trip to the Eastern time zone, a seven-game trip to Toronto (0-3) and Baltimore (four games)...now have a five-game road losing streak, which is tied for the season high of five (May 6-10 and June 5-13)...have also lost eight of the last nine road games and 11 of the last 14...are 24-32 (.429) on the road and 27-34 (.443) at home...have the third worst home record in the American League...went 6-5 on the last homestand against Cleveland (2-2), Baltimore (1-2) and Houston (3-1)...won the final three games of the homestand, which matches the A's longest home winning streak of the season (June 10-17)...return home following the game Monday for a fivegame homestand against Los Angeles-NL (two games) and Tampa Bay (three games)...have a 2.96 ERA (185 er in 561.0 ip) at home compared to 4.12 (220 er in 480.1 ip) on the road.

IT'S NOT ALL RIGHT: Last night, Brad Mills became the first left-handed pitcher to start a game for the A's since Drew Pomeranz started against Toronto July 23...ended a string of 19 consecutive games started by righthanded pitchers, which was the longest such streak by an A's team since July 21-Oct. 2, 1999 when they did it in 68 straight contests.

WINS AND LOSSES: The A's are 9-18 (.333) against American League East teams, which is the worst record by any team against the AL East. have lost 13 of their last 16 games against AL East competition...are 9-21 (.300) when the opponent starts a left-handed pitcher, which is the second worst record in the majors (Colorado, 5-20)...are 19-26 (.422) in day games, which is the second worst record in the AL (Chicago, 20-28, .417).

THIS AND THAT: The A's are batting .324 (33-for-102) with five home runs and 87 RBI with the bases loaded...lead the majors in plate appearances with the bases loaded (119), rank third in RBI and tied for third in grand slams...A's pinch hitters are batting .188 (16-for-85) but have 15 walks... have the fourth lowest pinch-batting average in the AL but lead the league and are tied for sixth in the majors in walks...rank second in the AL in pinch plate appearances (102)...the A's are the only team in the majors without a rain delay.

**THE DISABLED LIST:** The A's have four players on the disabled list (Doolittle, Hahn, Ladendorf, Parker)...all but Hahn are on the 60-day DL...Doolittle and Ladendorf are on rehab assignments...the four players on the DL are a season low...have used the DL a total of 18 times, which matches the season total from last year...have not had fewer than two players on the DL since the end of the 2006 season when they had just one

A's vs. ORIOLES: The A's are 1-3 against MLB BEST RECORDS VS. Baltimore after losing two of three in Oakland earlier this month...won the season series last year, 4-2...won two of three in both Baltimore and Oakland...it was their sixth season series win in the last seven years and the A's are now 14-1-1 in season series dating back to 1999...are 89-49 (.645) over that span... since moving to Oakland in 1968, the A's are 256-255 against the Orioles...that breaks

down to 128-132 in Oakland and 128-123 in Baltimore...are 61-49 at Camden Yards...all-time, the A's are 992-935 against the Orioles/Browns/Brewers...of the other seven original AL franchises, the Orioles are the only team the A's have a winning record against.

Billy Burns leads Major League rookies in stolen bases (23) and multiple hit games (33)...tops American League rookies in hits (109) and total bases (139) and is second in batting average (.296)... Marcus Semien extended his hitting streak to a career-high nine games yesterday...is 14-for-31 (.452) during the streak...**Coco Crisp** recorded three doubles vesterday for the third time in his career.

#### THIS DATE IN A'S HISTORY

In 1907 Chief Bender wins his 11th consecutive decision in the A's 4-2 win over Cleveland...in 1976 Joe Rudi collects his 1000th hit as an Oakland Athletic in the A's 8-7 win against Boston...in 1980 Rick Langford pitches a six-hitter as the A's defeat Seattle 11-3...it is his club record ninth consecutive complete game victory...the win comes in the midst of a club record 22 consecutive complete games...in 2009 Adam Kennedy is a perfect 5 for 5 in the A's 8-1 loss to Chicago.

### **TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: Chris Bassitt (1-4, 2.48 ERA)**

**BRIEFLY:** Was recalled from Triple-A Nashville July 25 for his fourth stint with the A's this year and is 1-2 with a 2.03 ERA (6 er in 26.2 ip) in four starts since his return...was called up for the first time April 23 and logged a 3.38 ERA and .135 opponents batting average in five relief appearances before being optioned May 10...returned June 30 to make two starts for an ill Sonny Gray...lost both of the starts 2-1 and allowed just three runs in 10.2 innings (2.53 ERA)...was sent back to Nashville following his start July 5...returned July 11 when Jesse Hahn went on the DL and had a no decision that day at Cleveland (2 er in 6.1 ip, 2.84 ERA)...was optioned back to Nashville the next day with the All-Star Break approaching.

**RUN SUPPORT:** Received one run of support in his last start, the fifth time in his seven starts he received support of one run or fewer...his season run support average as a starter is 2.27 (11 rs in 43.2 ip)...has 21 runs of support in 12 career starting assignments (72.1 ip, 2.61 RSA).

**STARTING AND RELIEVING:** Is 1-4 with a 2.27 ERA (11 er in 43.2 ip) and .228 (36-for-158) opponents batting average in his seven starting assignments compared to 0-0 with a 3.38 ERA and .135 opponents batting average in his five relief appearances...has walked seven batters in 43.2 innings as a starter (1.44 per nine innings), nine in 10.2 innings in relief (7.59)...all five of his relief appearances came during his first stint

**OPPONENTS BATTING:** Has held left-handed hitters to a .184 (21-for-114) batting average but has issued 14 of his 16 walks to lefties for a .290 on-base percentage...has yielded a .179 (7-for-39) average with runners in scoring position...opponents are batting .208 (11-for-53) with a .250 on-base percentage when leading off an inning...has a .174 (27-for-155) opponents batting average the first two times through the lineup and .350 (14-for-40) the third time...the opponents number five hitter is 2-for-22 (.091).

**INNING BY INNING:** Has a 3.86 ERA (3 er in 7.0 ip) and .269 (7-for-26) opponents batting average in the first inning, a 0.64 ERA (2 er in 28.1 ip) and .177 (17-for-96) opponents average in innings two through five and a 4.74 ERA (10 er in 19.0 ip) and .233 (17-for-73) opponents average from the sixth inning on.

LOSING STREAK SNAPPED: Tossed seven shutout innings Aug. 4 against Baltimore to snap a four-game losing streak that spanned five starts from June 30 to July 30 (3.00 ERA)...tossed at least five innings and allowed three runs or fewer in each start to become the sixth pitcher in Oakland history to toss at least five innings and allow three runs or fewer in five consecutive games without recording a win (last: Vin Mazzaro, Aug. 3-26, 2010)...is the only one of those six pitchers with four losses during their streak

**IN RELIEF:** Yielded at least one run in three of his five outings and walked two batters or more four times...allowed 1-of-2 (50.0%) inherited runners to score...first batters faced were 0-for-3 with a walk and hit by pitch... tossed 4.1 innings in his first outing April 25 against Houston.

**FIRST START:** He was the losing pitcher in the A's 2-1 loss to Colorado June 30 in Oakland...retired each of the first 10 batters he faced before allowing back-to-back singles to Tulowitzki and Arenado in the fourth inning...allowed his only run in the fifth inning on a RBI single by Blackmon... was relieved by Rodriguez to start the sixth inning with the A's trailing 1-0.

**SECOND START:** He lost his second consecutive 2-1 game July 5 against Seattle...the A's scored a run in the third inning and he blanked the Mariners on three hits and a walk over the first five innings...retired the first two batters in the sixth before hitting Cano and allowing a double to Cruz... Smith then followed with a two-run single.

THIRD START: He had a no decision in the A's 5-4 win at Cleveland July 11...the A's scored a run in the first and he shutout the Indians on three hits and a hit batter over the first five innings...allowed a RBI single to Brantley in the sixth but the A's scored once in the seventh to take a 2-1 lead...allowed a RBI single to Perez in the bottom of the seventh and left after 6.1 innings with the scored tied 2-2.

**FOURTH START:** He was the losing pitcher in the A's 2-1 loss at San Francisco July 25...allowed a solo home run to Bumgarner in the third inning but the A's came back to tie the game in the fourth...allowed a RBI single to Duffy in the sixth inning for the loss.

**FIFTH START:** He was the losing pitcher in the A's 3-1 loss to Cleveland last Thursday in Oakland...allowed three runs in the first inning on an error and a two-run home run by Santana...then retired 18 of the final 21 batters he faced, blanking the Indians on two hits and a walk over his final six innings...Carrasco tossed a two-hitter for Cleveland.

**SIXTH START:** He combined with Rodriguez and Abad on a seven-hit shutout in the A's 5-0 win over Baltimore Aug. 4 in Oakland for his first win as an Athletic...tossed seven innings and allowed five of the hits while walking two...allowed four base runners to advance into scoring position.

**LAST START:** He had a no decision in the A's 5-4 win over Houston last Sunday in Oakland...struck out a career-high 10 batters and tossed a career-high 112 pitches in 6.2 innings...shut out the Astros on one hit and one walk over the first five innings to extend his scoreless streak to a career-high 18.0 innings...had a 1-0 lead when he allowed a two-out RBI double to Correa in the sixth...left with the scored tied at 1-1

WITH NASHVILLE: Was 2-7 with a 3.65 ERA and .230 opponents batting average in 13 games, including 10 starts, in his Triple-A debut with Nashville...allowed just one home run in 69.0 innings and that came to the third batter he faced in his first start...has a 68.0-inning, 282-batters faced Triple-A homerless streak...struck out 70 batters in 69.0 innings and issued 19 walks (2.48 per nine innings) for a strikeout-to-walk ratio of 3.68...his .230 opponents batting average included a .228 (23-for-101) mark against left-handed hitters compared to .231 (36-for-156) against right-handers... opponents hit .195 with the bases empty, .282 with runners on...went 2-3 with a 2.27 ERA in seven games at home compared to 0-4 with a 6.04 ERA in five games on the road...the Sounds were 4-6 (.400) in his starting assignments...tossed more than six innings in just two of his starts.
