OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics snapped their season-high seven-game losing streak...had their sixth walk-off hit of the year (previous: August 9 vs. Houston)...improved to 10-22 when the opponent starts a left-handed pitcher...have won four consecutive home games...are 11-19 since the All-Star Break...are 7-6 in interleague play... sold out the O.co Coliseum for the third time this season...are 1-0 on this five-game homestand against Los Angeles-NL (1-0) and Tampa Bay (three games).
- Felix Doubront made his first start as an Athletic and his fifth overall this season...is 1-1 with a 3.76 ERA (11 er in 26.1 ip) and .288 (30-for-104) opponents batting average in his five starts compared to 0-0 with a 4.15 ERA (6 er in 13.0 ip) and .255 (13-for-51) opponents average in three relief appearances...is now 5-2 with a 3.86 ERA (23 er in 53.2 ip) in 10 career interleague appearances, including eight starts.
- · Billy Butler (1-for-4, 2b, rbi, bb) had his first walk-off hit of the season and the third of his career (previous: home run, July 18, 2012 vs. Seattle).
- Mark Canha (4-for-5, 3 r, 2 2b, 2 rbi) recorded his first career four-hit game and his 15th multiple hit contest of the year...is 12-for-30 (.400) with six RBI over his last seven games after going 6-for-44 (.136) with two RBI over his previous 17 contests.
- Josh Reddick (2-for-2, bb) is 7-for-11 (.636) in three games this year against the Dodgers...had his 29th multiple hit contest of the season.
- Danny Valencia (2-for-5, r, so) is 14-for-47 (.298) with three doubles, four home runs and nine RBI in 11 games with the A's...has hit safely in 10 of those contests...is 8-for-20 (.400) in six career games against the Dodgers...is 12-for-29 (.414) with five doubles, one home run and six RBI in 10 interleague games this year...has a .342 (53-for-155) career average in interleague play...recorded his 17th multiple hit game of the year.

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Dodgers saw their three-game winning streak snapped...are 8-5 in interleague play...fell to 2-13 all-time at the O.co Coliseum...lead the National League with 147 home runs...are 0-1 on this eight-game road trip to Oakland (0-1), Houston (three games) and Cincinnati (three games).
- Clayton Kershaw is 5-0 with a 0.82 ERA (5 er in 55.0 ip) over his last seven starts...has 65 strikeouts compared to five walks over that span...has not lost since May 27 at Miami...leads the National League with 212 strikeouts...is 0-0 with with a 0.87 ERA (2 er in 20.2 ip) in three career starts against the A's.
- A.J. Ellis (1-for-1, 2 r, hr, 3 rbi, 4 bb) has reached base in 16 of his last 17 games with at least one plate appearance...is batting .313 (15-for-48) with three doubles, three home runs, eight RBI and 13 walks since June 12...walked four times in a game for the third time in his career (previous: July 29, 2012 at San Francisco).
- Andre Ethier (1-for-2, r) extended his hitting streak to a season-high seven games with a pinch-hit single in the eighth...is batting .471 (8-for-17) during the streak.
- Adrian Gonzalez (1-for-4, bb, so) has reached base safely in 18 of his last 21 games...is batting .317 (33-for-104) with a .400 OBP (48-for-120), four doubles, six home runs and 18 RBI in 27 games since the All-Star Break...has reached base safely in 16 of his last 17 games against Oakland.
- Kike Hernandez (2-for-5, 2 so) extended his hitting streak to a career-best five games (previous: 4, July 11-14, 2014)...has reached base safely in 13 consecutive games...is batting .413 (19-for-46) with three doubles, three home runs and eight RBI over his last 16 games...is 9-for-28 (.321) in eight career games against the A's.
- Yasiel Puig (1-for-3, bb) has hit safely in six of his last seven games...has batted .333 (8-for-24) with a triple, two home runs and six RBI over that stretch...exited the game in the top of the eighth inning with right-hamstring tightness.
