OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics saw their five-game home winning streak snapped...are now 11-23 when the opponent starts a left-handed pitcher...fell to 9-22 (.290) against American League East competition...have lost nine consecutive games against the AL East...allowed a home run for the 15th consecutive game, which ties the longest streak in Oakland history (previous: August 6-21, 1987)...are 2-1 on this five-game homestand against Los Angeles-NL (2-0) and Tampa Bay (0-1).
- A's starting pitchers have allowed two runs or fewer in 11 of the last 13 home games for a 1.85 ERA (18 er in 87.2 ip).
- Chris Bassitt is 1-3 with a 2.18 ERA (10 er in 41.1 ip) and .205 (30-for-146) opponents batting average in six starts since he was recalled from Triple-A Nashville on July 25 for his fourth stint with the A's...has tossed at least six innings and allowed six hits or fewer in each of those six starts...is 1-5 with a 2.31 ERA (15 er in 58.1 ip) and .214 (45-for-210) opponents batting average in his eight starting assignments.
- Mark Canha (1-for-4, so) is 16-for-38 (.421) with four doubles, one home run and six RBI over his last 10 games after going 6-for-44 (.136) with two RBI over his previous 17 contests.
- Coco Crisp (2-for-4, rbi) is 13-for-42 (.310) in 12 games since he was reinstated from the 60-day disabled list on August 3.
- Brett Lawrie (2-for-4) had his 31st multiple hit game of the year.
- Josh Phegley (2-for-4) recorded his 13th multiple hit contest of the season...is batting .306 (30-for-98) against left-handed pitching compared to .227 (17-for-75) against right-handers.
- Marcus Semien (1-for-4, so) is batting .322 (19-for-59) in August.

TAMPA BAY NOTES

- The Tampa Bay Rays improved to 10-8 in August and are batting .289 (188-for-651) as a team this month...are 15-16 since the All-Star Break...are 9-19 (.321) over their last 29 road games...are 60-95 (.387) all-time against the A's...have been between one game under .500 and one game over .500 for 61 days this season and for 36 of the last 44 days...are 23-52 (.307) all-time at the O.co Coliseum...are 3-5 on 10-game road trip to Texas (0-3), Houston (2-2) and Oakland (1-0).
- Rays starting pitchers have held the opposition scoreless 24 times this season and have allowed one run or fewer 53 times this year.
- **Drew Smyly** won for the first time since August 27, 2014 at Baltimore...he made seven starts between victories...snapped a string of seven consecutive starts in which he allowed at least one home run...is 5-9 (.357) with a 4.44 ERA (49 er in 99.1 ip) in 30 career appearances (15 starts) against the AL West.
- Asdrubal Cabrera (1-for-3, bb) snapped a string of 13 consecutive at-bats without a hit when he singled to lead off the fifth inning...is batting .407 (33-for-81) in 21 games since returning from the disabled list on July 28.
- **Desmond Jennings** (2-for-4, r, hr, 2 rbi) is 10-for-28 (.357) since he was reinstated from the 60-day disabled list on August 14...hit his first home run since August 8, 2014 at Chicago-AL.
- Grady Sizemore (2-for-3, 2b) recorded his 13th multiple hit game of the season and his eighth with the Rays...is batting .232 (23-for-99) in 31 games (24 starts) with the Rays, with 12 of his 23 hits going for extra bases (2 2b, 6 hr).
