#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics have lost nine of their last 11 games...are now 9-23 (.281) against the AL East competition...are 12-21 (.364) since the All-Star Break...are 95-61 (.609) all-time against Tampa Bay...are 2-2 on this five-game homestand against Los Angeles-NL (2-0) and Tampa Bay (0-2).
- A's pitchers allowed a home run for the 16th consecutive game (26 home runs total), which is the longest streak in Oakland history (previous: 15, August 6-21, 1987)...the only longer streak by an A's team since 1914 is a 17-game streak by the 1964 Kansas City A's from July 26-Aug. 14.
- Sonny Gray allowed three home runs in a game for the first time in his career...has allowed five home runs over his last three starts...is 2-1 with a 1.40 ERA (6 er in 38.2 ip) in his last five starts...is 4-3 with a 2.58 ERA (25 er in 87.1 ip) in 12 starts at home...is 7-4 with a 2.63 ERA (35 er in 119.2 ip) in 17 starts at night...is 2-1 with a 2.81 ERA (10 er in 32.0 ip) in five career starts against Tampa Bay.
- Mark Canha (2-for-4, r, 2b, hr, rbi) is 11-for-20 (.550) over his last four games and 18-for-42 (.429) with four doubles, two home runs and seven RBI over his last 11 games after going 6-for-44 (.136) with two RBI over his previous 17 contests.
- Brett Lawrie (3-for-4, 2 2b, 2 r) had his 32nd multiple hit game of the year and seventh three-hit game of the season.
- Josh Phegley (2-for-4, r, 2b, hr, 3 rbi) had his 14th multiple-hit game of the year...has six home runs and 21 RBI over his last 35 games.

#### TAMPA BAY NOTES

- The Tampa Bay Rays are now 11-8 in August...are 16-16 (.500) since the All-Star Break...are 31-30 (.508) on the road this season but are are 10-19 (.345) over their last 29 road games...are 14-6 (.700) in games started by Erasmo Ramirez...are 61-95 (.391) all-time against the A's... are 24-52 (.316) all-time at the O.co Coliseum...are 4-5 on 10-game road trip to Texas (0-3), Houston (2-2) and Oakland (2-0).
- · Rays starting pitchers had their streak of 21.0 scoreless innings pitched snapped by a Josh Phegley double in the second inning.
- Erasmo Ramirez is 2-0 with a 3.41 ERA (12 er in 31.2 ip) in his last five starts...is 5-1 with a 3.97 ERA (26 er in 59.0 ip) in 11 starts on the road...is 0-6 with a 5.24 ERA (26 er in 44.2 ip) in nine career appearances (eight starts) against Oakland.
- Asdrubal Cabrera (2-for-4, r, 2b, hr, 3 rbi) is batting .412 (35-for-85) in 22 games since returning from the disabled list on July 28.
- John Jaso (1-for-4, r, hr, rbi, k) snapped an 0-for-14 hitless streak with a home run in the third inning.
- Logan Forsythe (2-for-4, 2 r, 2b, hr, rbi) is batting .310 (36-for-116) in his last 31 road games since June 18.
- Desmond Jennings (1-for-4, 2b) is 11-for-32 (.344) in eight games since being reinstated from the 60-day disabled list on August 14.
- Evan Longoria (0-for-4, k) is batting .180 (16-for-89) in 25 games at O.co Coliseum...is hitless in his last eight at-bats.
