OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics snapped a two-game losing streak...tied their season high for runs in an inning with seven in the seventh (third time, last: 8th inning, June 17 vs. San Diego)...improved to 13-21 (.364) since the All-Star Break...are now 10-23 (.303) against the AL East competition...are 96-61 (.609) all-time against Tampa Bay...finished 3-2 on this five-game homestand against Los Angeles-NL (2-0) and Tampa Bay (1-2).
- A's pitchers had a 2.74 ERA (14 er in 46.0 ip) and .189 (30-for-159) opponents batting average on the homestand after compiling a 6.93 ERA and .304 opponents batting average on the last road trip...snapped a streak of 16 consecutive games allowing one or more home runs (26 home runs total), which was the longest streak in Oakland history (previous: 15, August 6-21, 1987)...the only longer streak by an A's team since 1914 is a 17-game streak by the 1964 Kansas City A's from July 26-Aug. 14.
- Kendali Graveman has not allowed a run in two starts against Tampa Bay this season (0 r in 12.0 ip)...held the opposing team scoreless for the fifth time in 21 starts this year...has walked two batters or fewer in 16 of his 21 starts...is 5-7 with a 3.35 ERA (37 er in 99.1 ip) and .264 (102-for-386) opponents batting average in 17 starts since his return from Triple-A Nashville on May 23.
- Sean Doolittle made his second appearance of the season and his first since being reinstated from the 60-day disabled list yesterday...had not pitched since May 27 against Detroit.
- Billy Burns (3-for-4, 2 r, 3b) snapped an 0-for-10 hitless streak with his fourth-inning triple...it was his team-best eighth triple of the year...recorded his team-best 35th multiple hit game of the year and his eighth three-hit contest of the season...his 35 multiple hit games lead all American League rookies.
- Mark Canha (2-for-4, r, 3b, 4 rbi) is 13-for-24 (.542) with five multiple hit games over his last six contests and 20-for-46 (.435) with four doubles, one triple, two home runs and 11 RBI over his last 12 games...had his 18th multiple hit game of the year.
- Brett Lawrie (1-for-3, r, rbi) is batting .379 (11-for-29) over his last seven games.
- Stephen Vogt (2-for-4, 2b) had his 27th multiple hit game of the year.

TAMPA BAY NOTES

- The Tampa Bay Rays snapped their three game winning streak and a stretch of five consecutive one-run games...fell to 11-9 in August and to 16-17 (.485) since the All-Star Break...are 31-31 (.500) on the road this season but are are 10-20 (.333) over the last 30 road games...fell to 24-53 (.312) all-time at the O.co Coliseum...finished 4-6 on 10-game road trip to Texas (0-3), Houston (2-2) and Oakland (2-1).
- Jake Odorizzi...is 2-1 with a 3.83 ERA (22 er in 51.2 ip) in nine starts since returning from the 15-day disabled list on July 11...has made six consecutive starts of at least six innings pitched and no more than one walk...is 1-1 with a 1.26 ERA (5 er in 35.2 ip) in six starts against American League West competition...has received two runs of support or fewer 15 times in his 21 starts.
- Asdrubal Cabrera (1-for-4, r) is batting .404 (36-for-89) in 23 games since returning from the disabled list on July 28.
- Brandon Guyer (2-for-3, 2b, bb) is 10-for-20 (.500) with four runs and two doubles over his last nine games.
- Rene Rivera (1-for-3, rbi) is batting .277 (18-for-65) in 23 games since July 3 compared to .163 in his 68 previous games.
- Grady Sizemore (2-for-4) recorded his 14th multiple hit contest of the year and his ninth since joining the Rays...is batting .313 (63-for-201) in 53 career games against Oakland and .305 (29-for-95) in 25 career games at the O.co Coliseum.
