#### OAKLAND NOTES

- **The Oakland Athletics** have won three straight games...are 11-4 in their last 15 home games...are now 12-24 (.333) when the opponent starts a left-handed pitcher...are 26-27 (.491) against American League West competition, their best mark against an AL division...are 7-7 this season against Los Angeles-AL...are 1-0 on this nine-game homestand against Los Angeles-AL (1-0), Seattle (three games) and Houston (three games).
- **Felix Doubront** is 1-0 with a 2.57 ERA (4 er in 14.0 ip) in three starts with the A's...is 2-1 with a 3.93 ERA (15 er in 34.1 ip) in six total starts this season...is 2-1 with a 4.12 ERA (9 er in 19.2 ip) in four career appearances (three starts) against the Los Angeles-AL.
- **Billy Burns** (1-for-5, r, k) has hit safely in each of his last nine games (14-for-37, .378) with nine runs scored over that span...has hit safely in each of his seven games against Los Angeles-AL (11-for-32, .344).
- **Mark Canha** (1-for-3, 2 r, hr, 4 rbi, bb, 2 k, sf) is batting .309 (29-for-94) with 10 doubles and 21 RBI in 25 games in August...hit the first home run of his career against a left-handed pitcher...recorded four RBI for the third time this season (last: Aug. 23 vs. Tampa Bay).
- **Josh Reddick** (1-for-2, 2 r, 2b, 2 bb) is 8-for-25 (.320) over his last seven games...is batting .313 (15-for-48) in 13 games against Los Angeles-AL.
- **Jake Smolinski** (1-for-4, 2b, 3 rbi, 3 k) is 5-for-19 (.263) in eight games since being recalled from Triple-A Nashville.
- **Danny Valencia** (2-for-4, r, 2 2b, 3 rbi) has hit safely in each of his last seven games (11-for-27, .407) and 17 of 20 (25-for-82, .305)...has hit safely in each of his five games against Los Angeles-AL this year (7-for-20, .350) and has an eight-game hitting streak against the Angels (11-for-32, .344)...has 17 RBI in 20 games with the A's...recorded his eighth multiple-hit game.

#### LOS ANGELES NOTES

- **The Los Angeles Angels** are 2-9 in the last 11 games and 11-26 over the last 37 games...are 10-19 in the month of August...are 3-17 in their last 20 road games...are 14-7 in the last 21 meetings with Oakland...are 2-5 on nine-game road trip to Detroit (2-1), Cleveland (0-3) and Oakland (0-1).
- **Angels starting pitchers** are 6-18 with a 5.52 ERA (125 er in 203.2 ip) in their last 37 games dating back to July 23.
- **Hector Santiago** had his 11-start unbeaten streak against American League West competition snapped...was 4-0 with a 1.59 ERA over that span...tossed 2.2 innings, his shortest outing of the season...is 3-1 with a 2.25 ERA (11 er in 44.0 ip) in eight career starts against Oakland...is 1-3 with a 6.00 ERA (10 er in 15.0 ip) in five career games (three starts) at O.co Coliseum.
- **Erik Aybar** (3-for-3, r, 2 rbi, sf) is batting .314 (70-for-223) in his last 61 games...is a .346 (88-for-254) career hitter at O.co Coliseum...recorded his 34th multiple-hit game.
- **C.J. Cron** (1-for-5, r, k) is batting .338 (27-for-80) with four doubles, four home runs and nine RBI over his last 23 games.
- **Albert Pujols** (2-for-4, r, rbi, bb) snapped an 0-for-10 hitless streak with an infield single in the top of the third inning...recorded his 32nd multiple-hit game.
- **Shane Victorino** (2-for-4, gidp) is 10-for-28 (.357) in his career at O.co Coliseum...recorded his sixth multiple-hit game of the season.
