#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics snapped their three-game winning streak...fell to 7-6 over the last 13 games and 7-13 over the last 20 contests...are 7-8 this season against the Angels...used their 21st reliever of the year, which ties the team record set in 1997...lost their 75th game, giving them the most losses since going 74-88 in 2011...are 1-1 on this nine-game homestand against Los Angeles-AL (1-1), Seattle (three games) and Houston (three games).
- The A's have homered in a season-high eight consecutive games (10 home runs total).
- Cody Martin made his Athletics debut and his first Major League start...was 2-3 with a 5.40 ERA (13 er in 21.2 ip) in 21 relief appearances earlier this season for the Atlanta Braves...set new career highs with 3.0 innings pitched (previous: 2.0, three times), five runs allowed (previous: 2, five times) and 56 pitches thrown (previous: 28, April 27, 2015 vs. Washington).
- Ryan Dull made his major league debut and struck out the first batter he faced (C.J. Cron).
- Dan Otero snapped a 23-inning scoreless streak against the Angels when Kole Calhoun homered to lead off the seventh inning...had not allowed a run against the Angels in 16 career appearances against them entering play (14 h, 3 bb, 17 so).
- Billy Butler (2-for-4) recorded his 25th multiple hit game of the year.
- Brett Lawrie (1-for-4, r, hr, rbi, 2 so) re-set his career high with his 14th home run of the year...the homer also snapped an 0-for-8 streak at the plate.
- Jason Pridie (0-for-3, bb, so) made his Athletics debut and his first Major League appearance since August 5, 2014 at Chicago-NL.
- Josh Reddick (1-for-4, so) is 9-for-29 (.310) over his last eight games...is batting .308 (16-for-52) in 14 games against the Angels.
- Marcus Semien (1-for-3, bb, 2 so) is batting .300 (27-for-90) with three home runs and 13 RBI in 26 games since August 1.

#### **LOS ANGELES NOTES**

- The Los Angeles Angels snapped a three-game losing streak at the O.co Coliseum and have won six of the last nine games against the A's...are 15-7 in the last 22 meetings with Oakland...improved to 3-9 in the last 12 games and 12-26 over the last 38 contests...won for just the fourth time in the last 21 road games...are 3-5 on this nine-game road trip to Detroit (2-1), Cleveland (0-3) and Oakland (1-1).
- Matt Shoemaker is 2-0 with a 0.63 ERA (1 er in 14.1 ip) in two starts since being recalled from Triple-A Salt Lake on August 27...is 2-2 with a 4.68 ERA (17 er in 32.2 ip) in seven career games (six starts) against the A's...3-0 with a 1.78 ERA (6 er in 30.1 ip) in five career September starts...has allowed 22 home runs this season, which account for 33 of the 66 total runs he has yielded in 2015.
- · Wesley Wright made his Angels debut and his first major league appearance since April 10, 2015 when he was pitching for Baltimore.
- Erick Aybar (1-for-4) is batting .311 (71-for-228) in 57 games since June 19...is a career .345 (89-for-258) hitter at the O.co Coliseum.
- Kole Calhoun (3-for-5, 2 r, hr, 2 rbi) recorded his 26th multiple hit game of the season and his eighth three-hit contest of the year...re-set his career high with his 21st home run of the season.
- David Freese (1-for-4, r) made his first appearance since July 22 after missing 36 games with a fractured right index finger he suffered on a hit-by-pitch.
- Carlos Perez (2-for-4, r) had his 11th multiple hit game of the season
- Taylor Featherston (1-for-4, r, so) made his first appearance since August 15 after missing 15 games with an upper-back strain.
