#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics have lost two straight...are 7-7 over the last 14 games and 7-14 over the last 21 contests...are 7-9 this season against the Angels... are 1-2 on this nine-game homestand against Los Angeles-AL (1-2), Seattle (three games) and Houston (three games).
- The A's have homered in a season-high nine consecutive games (12 home runs total).
- Sonny Gray allowed six earned runs for the fourth time in his career (last: Sept. 2, 2014 at Seattle)...is 0-3 with a 4.32 ERA (12 er in 25.0 ip) over his last four starts...is 2-4 with a 3.00 ERA (21 er in 63.0 ip) in nine starts since the All-Star Break...has allowed six home runs in his last five starts.
- Billy Burns (0-for-5) had his eight-game hitting streak snapped...was 14-for-37 (.378) over that span.
- Billy Butler (2-for-4, 2b, k) hit his 300th career double in the fourth inning...recorded his 26th multiple-hit game of the season.
- Brett Lawrie (2-for-4, 2 r, 2b, hr, rbi) is batting .340 (16-for-47) with five home runs, nine RBI and 12 runs scored over his last 12 games...recorded his 35th multiple-hit game.
- Josh Phegley (1-for-3, r, hr, 2 rbi, k) has seven home runs and 24 RBI over his last 40 games.
- Danny Valencia (1-for-4, r, rbi, k) has hit safely in each of his last eight games (12-for-31, .387) and 18 of 21 (26-for-86, .302) since Aug. 3...has hit safely in each of his six games against Los Angeles-AL this year (8-for-24, .333) and has a nine-game hitting streak against the Angels (12-for-37, .324).
- Stephen Vogt (1-for-1, 3b) hit his third triple of the season (last: May 27 vs. Detroit).

#### **LOS ANGELES NOTES**

- The Los Angeles Angels are 4-9 over the last 13 games and 13-26 in the last 39 games...have won seven of the last 10 games against the A's...are 16-7 in the last 23 meetings with Oakland...are 5-17 in the last 22 road games...are 111-78 in the month of September since 2008...finished 4-5 on this nine-game road trip to Detroit (2-1), Cleveland (0-3) and Oakland (2-1).
- Andrew Heaney is 1-2 with a 4.62 ERA (20 er in 39.0 ip) over his last seven starts...made his first career start at O.co Coliseum...is 1-1 with a 4.85 ERA (7 er in 13.0 ip) in two career appearances against Oakland (last appearance against Oakland: June 29, 2014 with Miami).
- Kole Calhoun (3-for-4, 3 r, bb, k) recorded his 35th multiple-hit game of the season (ninth three-hit game of the year).
- C.J. Cron (1-for-4, 2b, 2 rbi) is batting .322 (28-for-87) with five doubles, four home runs and 12 RBI over his last 24 games.
- David Murphy (3-for-4, r, rbi) recorded his sixth multiple-hit game of the season (second three-hit game of the year).
- Albert Pujols (2-for-5, 2 r, hr, 3 rbi) hit his 555th home run of his career, which ties him with Manny Ramirez for 14th all-time...hit 35 home runs for the 10th time in his career...he is one of four players to have 10 seasons of 35 or more home runs in their first 15 seasons (12, Alex Rodriguez; 11, Mike Schmidt; 10, Willie Mays)...recorded his 33rd multiple-hit game of the season.
- Mike Trout (2-for-5, r, 2b) hit his 25th double of the season, joining Frank Robinson as the only MLB players to hit 25 doubles and 25 home runs in the same season four times before turning 24 years of age.
