#### OAKLAND NOTES

- **The Oakland Athletics** have lost three straight and six of the last nine...fell to 12-26 when the opponent starts a left-handed pitcher...are 4-10 against the Mariners...have lost the season series with Seattle for the third consecutive year and for the fourth time in the last five years...have homered in a season-high 10 consecutive games (13 home runs total)...lead the majors with 105 errors for the season...are 1-3 on this nine-game homestand against Los Angeles-AL (1-2), Seattle (0-1) and Houston (three games).
- **Aaron Brooks** is 1-2 with a 6.66 ERA (18 er in 24.1 ip) and .299 (29-for-97) opponents batting average in his five starts...faced the Mariners for the first time in his career.
- **Billy Burns** (2-for-4, r, rbi, bb) is batting .341 (15-for-44) against Seattle this year...recorded his team-best 39th multiple hit contest of the season.
- **Mark Canha** (2-for-4, 2 r, bb, so) is batting .315 (28-for-89) over his last 22 games...put together his 20th multiple hit game of the year.
- **Brett Lawrie** (3-for-5, r, 2b, rbi) is batting .385 (20-for-52) with five home runs, 10 RBI and 13 runs scored over his last 13 games...had his 36th multiple hit game of the year and his eighth three-hit contest of the season.
- **Danny Valencia** (2-for-5, r, hr, 4 rbi, so) has a nine-game hitting streak (15-for-36, .417)...hit his third career grand slam and his first since September 25, 2010 at Detroit...joined Dave Kingman, Mark McGwire, Matt Stairs and Brandon Moss as the only cleanup hitters in Oakland history with a first-inning grand slam...recorded his 22nd multiple hit game of the year and his ninth since joining the A's.

#### SEATTLE NOTES

- **The Seattle Mariners** have won three straight and eight of the last 12 games...are batting .284 (257-for-904) with 132 runs, 57 doubles, three triples, 40 home runs and 128 RBI in 24 road games since July 21...have hit 48 home runs since August 1...scored six times in the third to set a new season-high for runs in an inning (previous: 4, four times, last: July 21 at Detroit)...are 5-3 on this 10-game road trip to Chicago-AL (2-2), Houston (2-1) and Oakland (1-0)
- **Edgar Olmos** made his second career major league start and is 0-0 with a 9.95 ERA (7 er in 6.1 ip)...made his first career start and his third career appearance against the A's...is 1-0 with a 5.68 ERA (4 er in 6.1 ip) in his career when facing the Athletics..
- **Franklin Gutierrez** (0-for-1, so) left the game in the second inning with tightness in his right groin.
- **Ketel Marte** (2-for-5, 2 r, 2b, 2 so) put together his ninth multiple hit game of the year.
- **Logan Morrison** (3-for-4, r, 2b, 2 rbi) recorded his 15th multiple hit contest of the season and his fourth three-hit game of the year.
- **Stefen Romero** (2-for-4, 2 r, hr, 3 rbi) hit his first home run of the season (last: June 3, 2014 at Atlanta)...had his first multiple hit game of the year.
- **Kyle Seager** (3-for-4, 3 r, 2b, hr, 3 rbi, bb) has a seven-game hitting streak and is 15-for-30 (.500) with eight runs scored, three doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI and three walks during the streak...had his 35th multiple hit game of the year and his eighth three-hit contest of the season.
