OAKLAND NOTES

- **The Oakland Athletics** have lost four straight and seven of the last 10...are 4-11 against the Mariners this season...are 31-40 at home...are 42-49 against the Mariners over the last five years...have homered in a season-high 11 consecutive games (14 home runs total)...are 1-4 on this nine-game homestand against Los Angeles-AL (1-2), Seattle (0-2) and Houston (three games).
- **A's starting pitchers** are 2-13 with a 5.76 ERA (74 er in 115.2 ip) over the last 23 games dating back to Aug. 11...have tossed five innings or fewer in 12 of those games.
- **Jesse Chavez** is 1-3 with a 6.31 ERA (18 er in 25.2 ip) over his last five starts...is 5-6 with a 3.38 ERA (28 er in 74.2 ip) in 14 games at home...is 0-6 with a 4.99 ERA (27 er in 48.2 ip) in 16 career starts against the Mariners.
- **Billy Butler** (2-for-3, 2 rbi, k) is 12-for-23 (.522) over his last nine games...is a .318 (83-for-261) career hitter against Seattle...recorded his 27th multiple-hit game of the year.
- **Mark Canha** (1-for-4, r, hr, rbi, k) is batting .312 (29-for-93) with eight doubles, a triple, four home runs and 20 RBI over his last 23 games.
- **Brett Lawrie** (1-for-3, r, 2b, k) is batting .382 (21-for-55) with five home runs, 10 RBI and 14 runs scored over his last 14 games.
- **Josh Reddick** (0-for-1, k) left the game in the top of the third inning with an illness.
- **Danny Valencia** (0-for-4, 2 k) had his nine game hitting streak snapped...was 14-for-36 (.389) with nine runs scored, three doubles, two homers and 12 RBI over that span.
- **Stephen Vogt** (2-for-4, r) is 16-for-37 (.432) with three doubles, a triple and two home runs over his last 11 games...recorded his 31st multiple-hit game of the year.

SEATTLE NOTES

- **The Seattle Mariners** have won four straight and nine of the last 13 games...are 36-35 on the road this season...are 32-21 against the A's dating back to the start of 2013...have hit 50 home runs since Aug. 1...are 6-3 on this 10-game road trip to Chicago-AL (2-2), Houston (2-1) and Oakland (2-0)
- **Felix Hernandez** is 3-2 with a 6.03 ERA (21 er in 31.1 ip) in his last five starts...is 7-1 with a 2.60 ERA (23 er in 79.2 ip) in his last 11 starts against Oakland...is 22-8 with a 2.64 ERA (82 er in 279.1 ip) in 40 career starts against the A's...is 11-3 with a 2.76 ERA (45 er in 147.0 ip) in 21 career starts at O.co Coliseum.
- **Robinson Cano** (1-for-5, r, 2b, rbi, k) extended his hitting streak to seven games (11-for-31, .355)...is batting .333 (77-for-231) with 13 doubles, 10 home runs and 36 RBI over his last 56 games.
- **Ketel Marte** (2-for-3, r, bb, sac) recorded his 10th multiple-hit game of the season.
- **Brad Miller** (2-for-4, rbi, bb) extended his hitting streak to six games (9-for-22, .409)...is batting .309 (29-for-94) with 11 runs scored and 13 RBI over his last 31 games.
- **Logan Morrison** (1-for-5, r, hr, 3 rbi) has four home runs in his last nine games...is a career .316 (6-for-19) hitter against Jesse Chavez.
- **Shawn O'Malley** (2-for-2, 2 r, 2b, hr, rbi, 2 bb) hit the first home run of his career off Arnold Leon in the top of the fourth inning...recorded his second multiple-hit game.
- **Kyle Seager** (2-for-4, r, 2b, rbi, bb) extended his hitting streak to eight-games (17-for-34, .500)...is batting .450 (18-for-40) with nine runs scored, four doubles, five home runs and 12 RBI over his last 10 games...recorded his 36th multiple-hit game of the season.
- **Seth Smith** (3-for-4, 2 r, 2 2b, bb) snapped an 0-for-7 hitless streak with a single in the third inning...recorded his 15th multiple-hit game of the season (his third three-hit game of the year).
